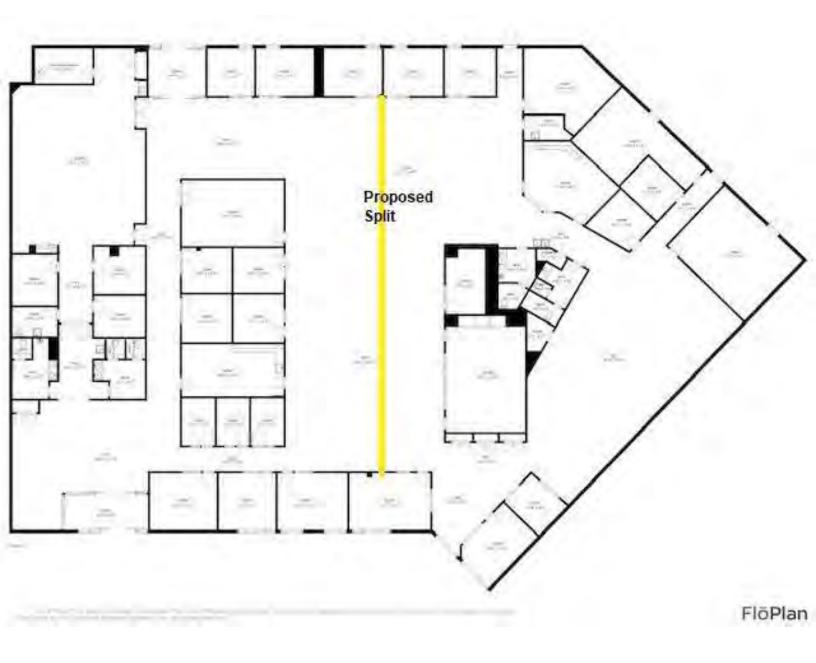








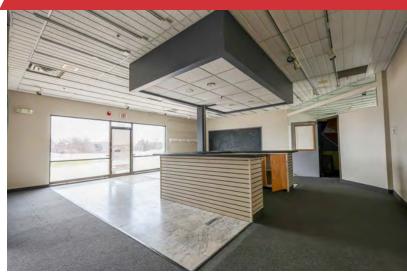
# Floor Plans Suite 4500





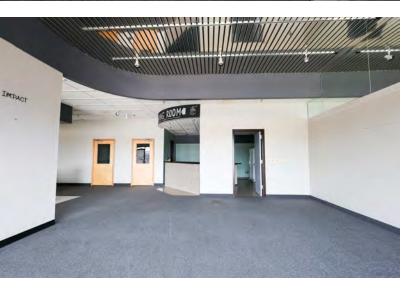

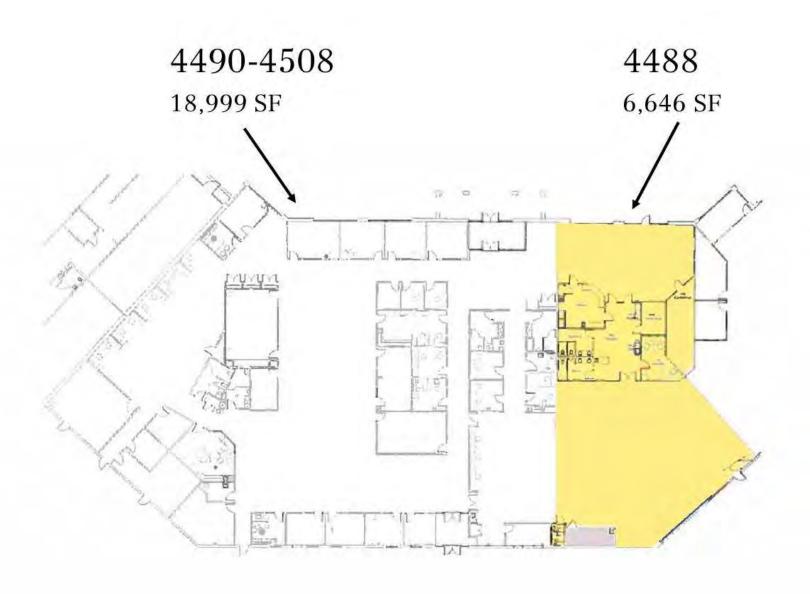

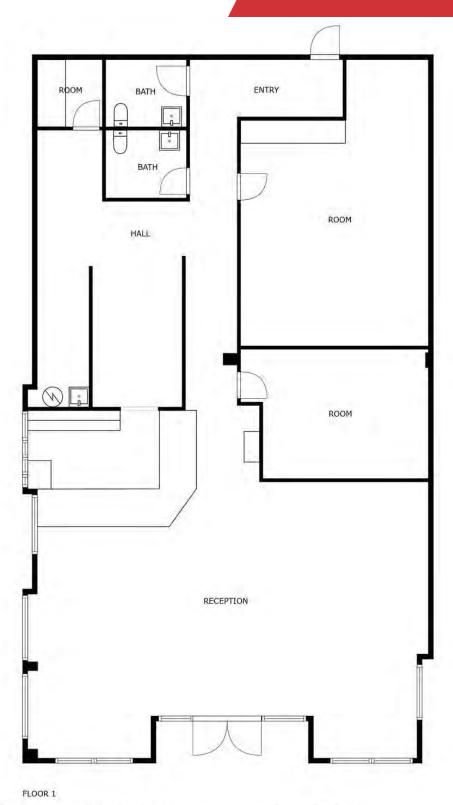

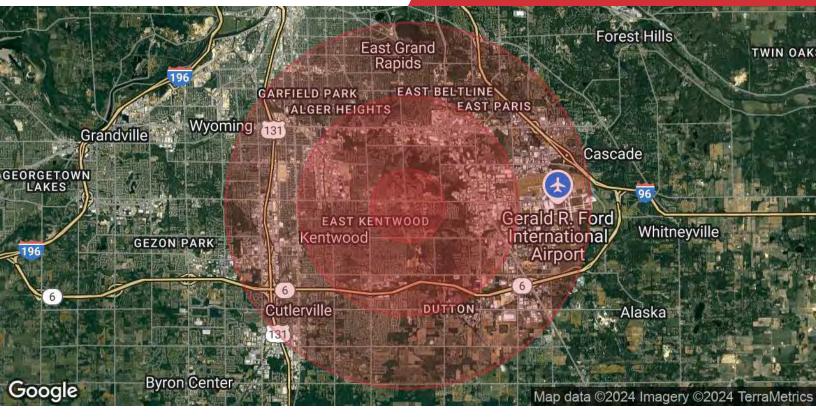


# Retailer Map

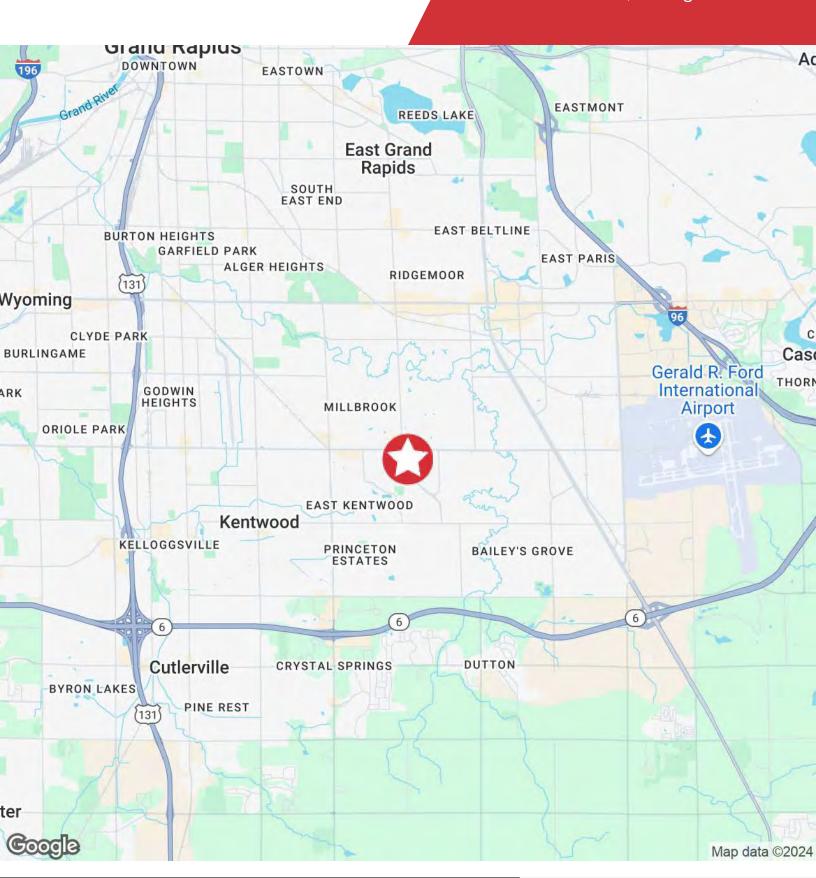
