The five-year projection for the population in the area is 89,123 representing a change of 0.73% annually from 2024 to 2029. Currently, the population is 49.1% male and 50.9% female.

The median age in this area is 40.1, compared to U.S. median age of 39.3.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 50.1 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 37,217, a change of 1.02% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.39, compared to 2.41 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 22,556 in the specified area.

Households by Income			

Current median household income is \$70,536 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$81,115 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$100,064 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$114,118 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$40,860 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$47,255 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 65.7% of the 37,973 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 27.5%, renter occupied; and 6.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 35,563 housing units in the area and 6.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.55%. Median home value in the area is \$244,201, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.60% annually to \$291,447.

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
