Currently, 68.7% of the 10,988 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 25.0%, renter occupied; and 6.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 10,137 housing units in the area - 65.2% owner occupied, 28.5% renter occupied, and 6.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.65%. Median home value in the area is \$149,501, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.64% annually to \$162,130.
