Currently, 56.2% of the 98,933 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.2%, renter occupied; and 9.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 93,468 housing units in the area - 58.8% owner occupied, 34.2% renter occupied, and 7.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.56%. Median home value in the area is \$206,060, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.44% annually to \$232,403.

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
