Dear Mr. Morales,

Attached to this letter is an invoice for a review carried out by Comite Resources of a wetland delineation report prepared in 2016 about Frank Bonifay's properties located on either side of Alligator Bayou. Delineation maps and data sheets were verified with a site visit made on October 13, 2023. There are two areas that are considered jurisdictional wetlands (in red on the attached map) and are regulated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). These areas will require permitting and or remediation if altered. All other areas are considered upland or closed ponds that are not considered contributing to the waters of U.S. and therefore not regulated by the USACE.

The two areas considered jurisdictional wetlands are essentially ditches draining into Frog Bayou. The first, (Area 1 on the map), is a drainage ditch along Alligator Bayou Rd. that has free connection to Frog Bayou and contributes stormwater during rain events. The second, (Area 2 on the map) is an abandoned pump uptake ditch that does not appear to drain any uplands but has free connection to the bayou and fills during rain events. Both areas meet the criteria set forth by the 1987 USACE Wetland Delineation Manual as jurisdictional wetlands.
