Prime redevelopment opportunity located in the heart of downtown Baton Rouge. This assemblage is comprised of two interconnected buildings totaling 73,808 sf, and an adjacent 7,685-sf surface parking lot fronting Third Street. The property is offered for sale at \$6,250,000.00.

This property is well suited for a variety of uses. The exteriors of the buildings are in good condition, while the interiors are partially gutted and construction ready

for a new vision. The parking lot is income producing but is also prime for development.

The location is two blocks from the Mississippi River and only five blocks from the State Capitol building. Surrounded by offices, restaurants, and historic sites, this is a vibrant downtown location.



PROPERTY DETAIL

ABOUT THE PROPERTY

- » 263 3rd Street is a 43,324-sf, 7-story, multi-tenant office building.
- » Known also as the State National Life Building, it was built in phases in 1916 and 1923 and is one of the first three office buildings in downtown Baton Rouge



- » The exterior of the building is in average condition while the interior is in poor condition due to being partially gutted and in overall disrepair throughout most of the building. The first floor is currently partially used as a convenience store in average to good condition.
- » The building is attached to the adjacent building at 224 Florida Street. There is an elevated two-story connector to get to 224 Florida Street from the subject.
- » The site contains 9,187 sf or 0.21



- acres with 74.28' of frontage on 3rd Street and 125' on Florida Street.
- This building is eligible for a variety of tax credits and incentives, and Part 1 of the Federal Historic Rehabilitation Tax credit process is already complete. Other tax credits and incentives that are available to the building include: 5-year PILOT program, New Market Tax Credit, State Commercial Historic Tax Credit, and Tax Increment Financing.



ABOUT THE PROPERTY

- » 224 Florida Street is a 30,484-sf, 3-story, multi-tenant office building.
- » The exterior of the building is in average condition while the interior is in poor condition due to being partially gutted and in overall disrepair. Overall, the improvements are considered to be in fair condition.
- » The building is attached to the adjacent building at 263 3rd Street. There is an elevated two-story connector to get to 263 3rd Street from the subject.
- » The site contains 10,645 sf or 0.24 acres with 67' of frontage on Florida Street.

- » Located on 3rd St between Florida Street and Convention Street. (Parcel is described as Lot 10-A-1, Block 2 by the East Baton Rouge Assessor.)

- The site is currently used as a surface parking lot with 23 spaces.
