Organization

Restorative Partners, Inc. (RP) is a nonprofit organization that transforms lives impacted by crime through healing services and relationships. Volunteer Description

The Respite House Manager provides overnight time off to our House Managers and works closely with Restorative Partner's Housing Team, especially the Housing Coordinator, to assure that the house is running smoothly and residents are following the rules, maintaining sobriety and meeting curfew. This job requires a commitment of 2-4 nights per month.

Key Responsibilities:

- Interact with and provide assistance to all residents
- Provide overnight and general supervision of house residents, especially during resident blackout period
- Provide support for residents in recovery as needed.
- Communicate daily with House Coordinator concerning the residents
- Conduct bed checks and compliance with curfew
- Complete paperwork as needed
- Report any needs, concerns or incidents to the House Coordinator

Requirements:

- Valid Driver's License and Insurance
- At least one year clean and sober with a thorough understanding of the recovery process including step work, sponsors, meeting schedules, locations and attendance, if applicable
- Understands the basic principles of a restorative justice approach to the criminal justice system.

- Attend at least 2 recovery meetings (NA or AA) per week, if applicable
- Not currently on Probation or Parole
- Not currently a client of SLO County Drug & Alcohol Services
- Ability to pass a background check including a Live Scan
