

NATCHEZ TRACE CENTURY RIDE CELEBRATING 25 YEARS

The Natchez Trace Century Ride is one of the largest spring cycling events in Mississippi. Wheels will roll again this year on May 4, 2024 in Ridgeland, Mississippi. With approximately 1,000 riders, the bike ride starts and ends in Ridgeland.

The Natchez Trace Century Ride has something to offer for all types of cyclists and provides riders the unique opportunity to ride a portion of the Natchez Trace Parkway. A few of the beautiful scenery opportunities on the

ride include riding around the Ross Barnett Reservoir, under a canopy of pine trees, and along-side cypress trees and lily pads.

With a choice of distances from 8, 25, 50, 62 and 100 miles with mild to moderate elevation, this is a nice ride for all ages and abilities. There will be plenty of support with "energy" stops providing food, restrooms, and refreshments every 10 – 18 miles. SAG vehicles are located on the course throughout the day to assist or provide service to riders.

Celebrate with friends and fellow riders as you cross the finish line. Receive a medal, enjoy a post ride meal, and relax under the tent with a view of the Barnett Reservoir.
