School Street, Ridgeland, MS 39157, or can be submitted through the online plan review provider at www.centralbidding.com. All bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work shall consist essentially of the following items:

The replacement of 21 high mast lighting assembly fixtures along I-55 with LED, and the replacement of 12 low mast lighting assembly fixtures along Old Agency Road west of I-55 with LED. Also included in the project scope is the installation of three (3) pan-tilt-zoom cameras, and if awarded, the integration of the three (3) cameras into the city's traffic management center.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The City of Ridgeland, Madison County, hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

The following questions/requests for clarification were presented by a planholder in writing. This Notice to Bidders No. 7210 is part of Addendum No. 2 for the above referenced project, and is to be incorporated into the Contract Documents. Responses to the questions/requests for clarification are provided below:

1. Question/Comment:

I noticed that Supplement to Notice to Bidders No. 5605 LPA has no percentage for the DBE goal.

Response: *This comment is addressed in the replacement Supplement to Notice to Bidders No. 5605 LPA contained in this Addendum No. 2.*

2. Question/Comment:

907-637-D002 Does this line Item have to be bored or can it be open cut? Can Sch 40 PVC be used in lieu of HDPE?

Response: *All conduit installed under existing pavement, asphalt, or concrete shall be bored to avoid impacting existing site conditions. All conduit installed in soil may be trenched, if trenching does not impact existing pavement and does not require the closure of an existing road.*

3. Question/Comment:

907-683-G2001 What is the new power cable supposed to be for this line item?

Response: *The new power cable shall be capable of replacing the power connection for the existing high mast lighting circuit and provide a separate power connection for the new camera circuit. Existing power cable is assumed to be MDOT standard SO cable, Contractor to verify prior to purchase. The new conductor shall be a similar SO cable sized with the high mast lighting circuit matching existing, and the conductors for the camera connection matching the camera circuit. Additional payment shall not be provided if the size does not match MDOT standard.*

4. Question/Comment:

What size inline fuses are need for the Low mast lights?

Response: *The existing fuses are assumed to be MDOT standard, 5A fuses for connection to the internal #10 AWG THWN conductors. Contractor shall verify size of fuses prior to purchase. Additional payment shall not be provided if the size does not match MDOT standard.*

5. Question/Comment:
907-683-G2001 Do the Pullies need to be replaced also?

Response: *The existing pullies are assumed to be in operation and acceptable condition. The replacement of the existing lowering device is to provide new internal conductors for the connection of the existing high mast lighting circuit and the new camera circuit. Any additional equipment required to replace the internal conductors shall be paid for under this pay item. Any existing equipment that is operational and does not need to be replaced for this work may remain in place.*

6. Question/Comment:
907-683-G2001 What size steel wire is needed?

Response: *The existing steel wire is assumed to be the MDOT standard 3-3/16" diameter, 7x19 stainless steel aircraft cables. The contractor shall verify size prior to purchase. Additional payment shall not be provided if the size does not match MDOT standard.*

7. Question/Comment:
I have been through the Plans and Specs and I don't see what the material and Color the existing poles are and there is no Spec on the material or color for the proposed pole arms?

Response: *The existing high mast and low mast light poles are assumed to be MDOT standard grey. The contractor shall verify existing pole colors prior to purchase, and shall submit the proposed color of the new equipment to the client and engineer for verification.*

8. Question/Comment:
What size power cable is needed for 907-683-G2001?

Response: *The new power cable shall be capable of replacing the power connection for the existing high mast lighting circuit and provide a separate power connection for the new camera circuit. Existing power cable is assumed to be MDOT standard SO cable, contractor to verify prior to purchase. The new conductor shall be a similar SO cable sized with the high mast lighting circuit matching existing, and the conductors for the camera connection matching the camera circuit. Additional payment shall not be provided if the size does not match MDOT standard.*

9. Question/Comment:
Fixture Type A "Holophane Series" MGLED-P4-40k-FT, Is the stated 50,000 lumens going to be enough light to reach the ground?

Response: *The Type A light fixture shall be utilized for replacing the existing low mast light poles for the roundabout. The Type B light fixture shall be utilized for replacing the existing high mast lighting.*

On the basis of the Specifications, Special Provisions, Notice(s) to Bidders, and Plans, I (we) propose to furnish all necessary machinery, tools, apparatus and other means of construction and do all the work and furnish all the materials in the manner specified. I (We) understand that the quantities mentioned herein are approximate only and are subject to either increase or decrease, and hereby propose to perform any increased or decreased quantities of work at the unit prices bid, in accordance with the above.

I (We) acknowledge that this proposal will be found irregular and/or non-responsive unless a certified check, cashier's check, or Proposal Guaranty Bond in the amount as required in the Advertisement (or, by law) is submitted electronically with the proposal or is delivered to the office of CITY OF RIDGELAND located at 100 W. SCHOOL ST., RIDGELAND prior to the bid opening time specified in the advertisement.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS: Alternate and Optional Items on Bid Schedule.

1. Two or more items entered opposite a single unit quantity WITHOUT DEFINITE DESIGNATION AS "ALTERNATE ITEMS" are considered as "OPTIONAL ITEMS". Bidders may or may not indicate on bids the Optional Item proposed to be furnished or performed WITHOUT PREJUDICE IN REGARD TO IRREGULARITY OF BIDS.
