Precautions:

- Store in original container, tightly closed in a safe place away from foodstuffs. Avoid all contact by mouth. Wash hands and exposed skin before meals, smoking and after any contact.

Directions: Rats: Place two 28 gram blox at intervals of 4 to 6 metres apart in bait stations. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until signs of rat activity have ceased.

Mice: Place one 28 gram blox at intervals of 2 to 3 metres apart in bait stations. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until signs of mice activity have ceased.
