


Installing the Samson Conspiracy™ Editor (Windows Only)

1. Download the editor and move it from your Downloads folder to a folder of your choice. You will see the .zip file below, right-click and select **Extract all**



Make sure **show extracted files when complete** is checked. Follow the prompts.


Select a Destination and Extract Files

Files will be extracted to this folder:



2. You will now be shown the **Samson-Conspiracy™** folder. Right-click to open



3. After opening, scroll down to the file below and right-click, select **Send to the Desktop** (create shortcut)



The shortcut icon below will be created on your desktop, simply click this icon to open the Conspiracy™ editor in the future



How to use the Samson Conspiracy™ Editor

The Samson Conspiracy™ Editor allows users to freely assign every knob, fader, button and pad as quickly and easily as possible. **Always update your Conspiracy™ to the latest firmware before using. The current firmware version will be displayed in the LCD when the unit is first connected.**

Note: Unless using Windows 10, you cannot have the editor and your audio software open at the same time. This is not an issue on the Mac version.

When you first connect the Conspiracy™ and open the editor, the editor should display the same preset name as the unit, if not, click the **Upload** button.

When you change presets, you'll want to click **Upload** to re-establish communication between the editor and your Conspiracy™. The Conspiracy™ and editor should now be showing the same preset name in their displays.

Choose either the **Select Single** or **Select Multi** buttons to start assigning controllers. When you choose a controller for assignment you can right-click to have a quick drop-down contextual menu of assignment options made available.

Select Single: allows users to select an individual controller for assignment

Select Multi: allows users to select multiple controllers for assignment. In Windows, left-click and drag to highlight the controllers you wish to assign. On a Mac simply click and drag to highlight multiple controllers.

Save Settings: saves the Preset you are currently working on

Load Settings: loads a Preset from your computer into the editor

Download*: Downloads the current Preset into the Conspiracy™

Upload*: Uploads the current Preset from the Conspiracy™ to editor

Update: Allows users to load a Conspiracy™ firmware update when available

*When you select Upload/Download the Conspiracy™ LCD should light up. If you are not seeing the LCD light up and it appears that you are not seeing any changes, disconnect and re-connect the Conspiracy™ and close and re-open the editor. This should fix any communication issues.
