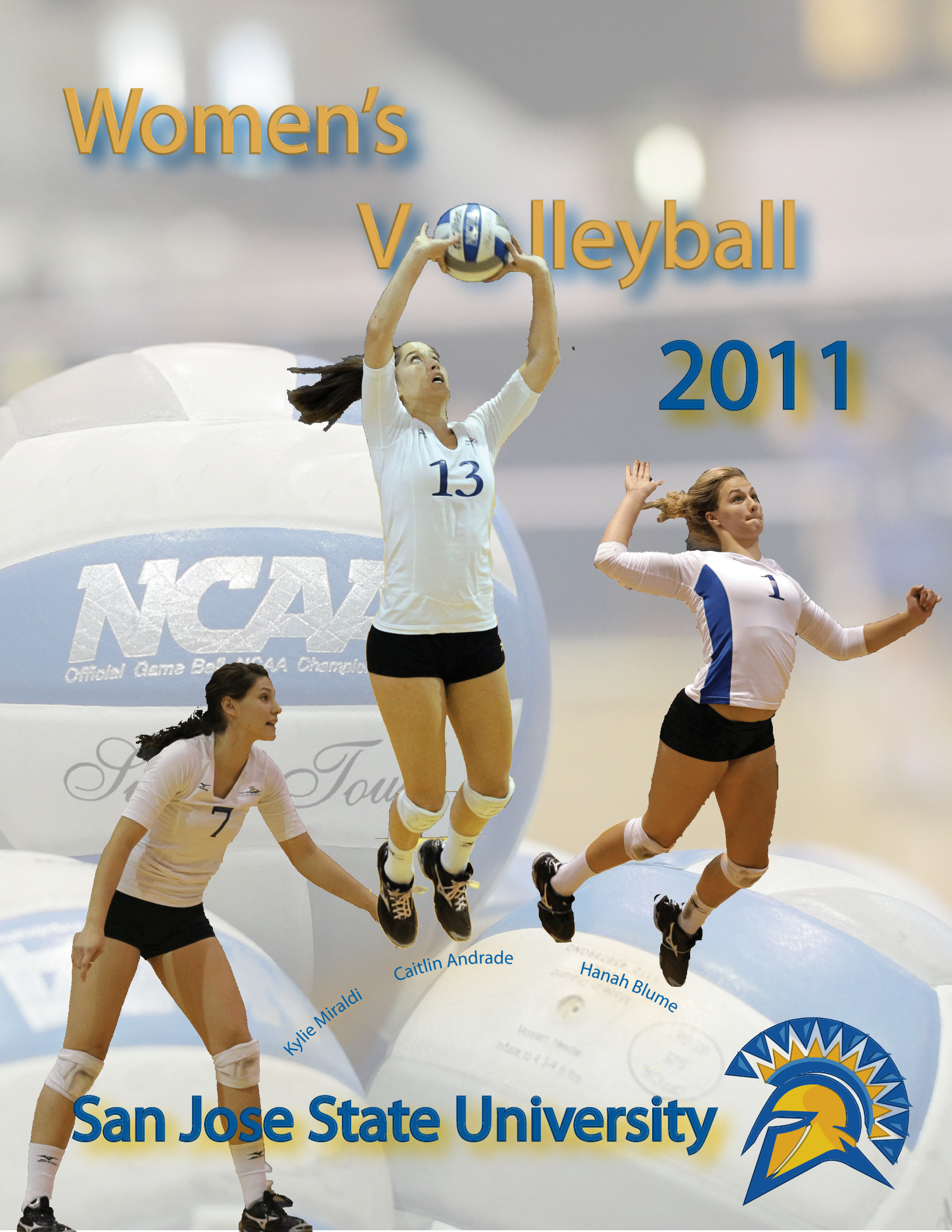

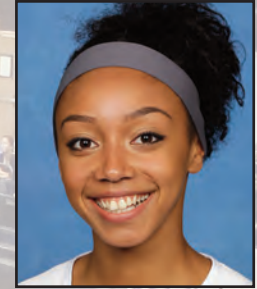

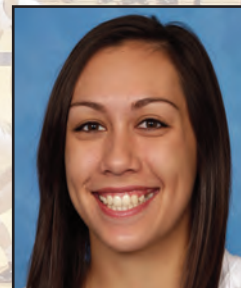

# Spartan Volleyball Coaches



San Jose State head coach Oscar Crespo begins his fifth season as head coach at his alma mater. A 1990 graduate, Crespo was named program's sixth head coach in March of 2007.

In rebuilding the Spartan program, Crespo enters the 2011 season with his entire starting lineup in tact and a core of freshman poised to help San Jose State advance to the next level.

Crespo's teams have shown success and growth over the past four years. In his first two seasons, Crespo led the Spartans to the semifinal match of the WAC Tournament in each year. Crespo recorded his first collegiate win with a 3-0 sweep of Grambling State on August 24, 2007.

The Spartans won two tournaments during Crespo's first season - ASU/ Bancorp South Classic and the UVU/La Quinta Inn & Suites Invitational. San Jose State defeated Pacific-10 foe Arizona State, 3-1. The team also got a jolt in its final non-conference match of the year as a 5.6 earthquake shook Spartan Gym in game two against Pacific on October 30, forcing the cancellation of the match.

In four years, seven Spartan players have received either first or second team All-WAC recognition, while four were named to the all-freshman team.

Rooted in fundamentals, Crespo believes in the well-rounded student-athlete. He wants each member of his team to be a successful student in the classroom and a solid athlete on the court.

During his four years, 15 players have earned 30 Academic All-WAC honors. The team had the highest combined team grade-point average for the 2009-10 Fall and Spring semesters at San Jose State, winning the Order of Spartan Team GPA Award and the Athletics Board's Best Academic Performance Award.

Prior to accepting the Spartan position, Crespo spent seven years as a member of the University of Nevada volleyball coaching staff. From 2000-01, he was the Wolf Pack's assistant head coach before being promoted to associate head coach prior to the start of the 2002 season.

His primary areas of focus at Nevada were athlete training and development; opponent scouting and evaluation; recruiting; setter

development; drill development and individual and team skill evaluation; development of defensive and offensive systems, and statistical analysis of individual and team play.

His recruiting expertise helped the Pack sign the 23rd-ranked volleyball recruiting class for 2006 according to PrepVolleyball.com. Crespo was instrumental in Nevada's recent success of participating in four of the last five NCAA Tournaments.

A member of the American Volleyball Coaches Association, USA Volleyball, and the Northern California Volleyball Association, Crespo is an accomplished coach with international experience. He spent the spring of 2002 coaching a USA College All-Star team in France, Holland and Belgium.

In the spring of 2007, Crespo was an assistant coach for the USA Volleyball Federation/Bring It Promotions (Senior) Select Team.

The USA/BIP team, which included former Spartans Jennifer Senfleben and Jessie Shull, traveled to Argentina to play the Argentinean National team as well as top club teams around Buenos Aires.

Crespo's vast coaching experience also includes stints at the University of California (1995-98), Saint Mary's College (1993-94) and De Anza College.

Crespo received a bachelor's degree in art history from San Jose State and was a member of the men's club volleyball team. Crespo and his wife, Lisa Ice-Crespo, a three-time All-American volleyball player at San Jose State, reside in Los Gatos with their three children: Ryan, Rachel and Karly Nicole.

# Spartan Volleyball Coaches



Former San Jose State player Jeanine Haldi begins her sixth season as the Spartans first assistant coach.

Haldi serves as recruiting coordinator and is responsible for athlete training and development, opponent scouting and defensive system analysis. Her duties also include team travel, summer camp coordinator, program compliance, and team academics.

For her academic efforts with the Spartan team, Haldi was awarded 2010 San Jose State Assistant Coach of the Year for Academics. She spearheaded the program for individual academic plans and strategies resulting in the highest team grade-point average for 2010.

Haldi played for San Jose State 1999-2002 and finished her four year career with 982 digs, currently sixth all time. Considered the first libero in Spartan history as the position was instituted her senior year, Haldi led the 2001 and 2002 team in digs and played in two NCAA tournaments (2000, 2001) including the 2001 upset of Santa Clara as an opposite and contributed eight block assists in the win.

During the 05-06 school year, Haldi worked in the San Jose State Athletics Department as a compliance assistant while completing her master's degree in Sport Management from the University of San Francisco.

Haldi has coached at the junior college, high school and club level. She currently coaches for Vision Volleyball Club of Los Gatos.

Haldi is a member of the American Volleyball Coaches Association, USA Volleyball, and Northern California Volleyball Association. A three-time Scholar-Athlete, Haldi graduated from San Jose State in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology and Sport Management. She received her master's degree from the University of San Francisco in May 2006. Haldi currently resides in Los Gatos.



Nik Rao begins his third season as a member of the Spartan volleyball coaching staff. He handles all video responsibilities for the team including video exchange.

Rao played five years on the UC Davis men's club team. He was a five-year captain on the team and a three-time Defensive Player of Year honoree. He was also a student assistant for the women's program for the 2008 season. Rao has coached the San Jose State men's club.

Rao received a bachelor of arts degree in psychology from UC Davis in 2009.



Annie Feller begins her fourth season as a member of the Spartan coaching staff.

Feller was the head coach at Santa Clara from 1993-98, where she had four winning seasons and made three NCAA tournament appearances. She recorded two 20-win seasons (1993, 22; 1998, 20). Her 1993 team won the West Coast Conference title.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons (1990-92), Feller took over the head coaching duties for the 1993 season. Her first team won its second straight WCC title and earned a spot in AVCA Top 25 poll for the first time in school history.

Prior to her Santa Clara stint, Feller was an assistant coach at Hawaii as a member of Dave Shoji's coaching staff.

An All-American at UC Riverside, Feller led her team to the 1986 NCAA Division II National Championship and was Reebok's Division II Player of the Year. A three-time CCAA first team pick, she was a 1986 Broderick Award nominee and UC Riverside's Female Athlete of the Year twice. Feller was a 1993 inductee into the UC Riverside Hall of Fame.

Feller graduated from UC Riverside in 1987 with a bachelor of arts degree in psychology. She received a master of arts degree in education administration from Santa Clara in 1994.

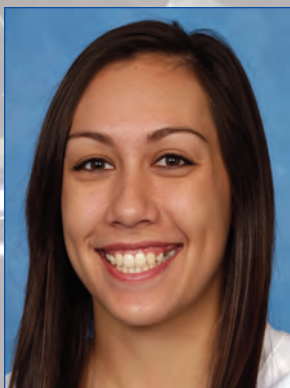

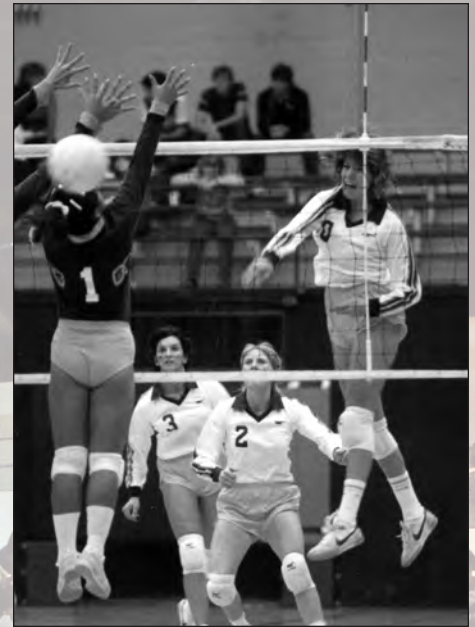
