#### FOOTBALL HOSTS HOMETOWN HEROES DAY

"> Auburn (1-0) hosts the San Jose' State Spartans (1-0) on Saturday, September 10, at Jordan-Hare Stadium in Auburn, Ala. ESPNU will televise the 6:30 p.m. CT non-conference matchup.

It's Hometown Heroes and First Responders Appreciation Day. Recently retired Auburn track and field coach Ralph Spry will be recognized for his 25 years with the Tigers.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- >> Auburn leads the all-time series with San Jose' State by a 2-0 advantage. Auburn was a 59-13 winner over the Spartans in 2014 and the Tigers were 35-21 victors in the 2015 matchup; both games were played at Jordan-Hare Stadium.
- Auburn holds a 5-0 all-time record against teams currently in the Mountain West Conference: Fresno State (1-0), San Jose' State (2-0), Utah State (1-0) and Wyoming (1-0). All those games were played in Auburn.

Coach Bryan Harsin won three Mountain West championships and six MW division titles during his tenure as head coach at Boise State.

#### **IN SEPTEMBER**

Auburn is 182-59-5 (.750) all-time in the month of September; the Tigers are 116-22-1 (.838) all-time at home in September, and 66-37-4 (.632) away from Auburn in that month. Since 1970, the Tigers have had a winning record in the month of September in 45 of 52 seasons. The Tigers are 7-0 all-time in games played on September 10; all of those have been home games.

#### KICKOFF COVERAGE

- » Auburn's 2022 campaign is its 130th season of college football. The Tigers have 789 wins alltime, 13th-most among FBS schools
- » Auburn and Arkansas are the only teams to have five AP preseason Top 25 teams on the 2022 schedule. The Tigers will face Georgia (3), Ole Miss (21), Arkansas (19), Texas A&M (6) and Alabama (1)
- Auburn opens with five consecutive home games at Jordan-Hare Stadium for the first time since the 2016 season
- Preseason all-SEC Tigers as selected by the league's coaches include Derick Hall and Tank Bigsby (first team), Colby Wooden and Oscar Chapman (second team) and Anders Carlson (third team)

- Auburn has won 16 straight home games against non-conference opponents dating back to the 2016 season
- Coach Bryan Harsin had a 3-1 record against San Jose' State during his tenure as Boise State head coach
- The 87-minute weather delay in the Mercer game was Auburn's first interrupted game since the 2018 Southern Miss contest
- Team captains for the 2022 season are defensive lineman Derick Hall, linebacker Owen Pappoe and tight end John Samuel Shenker. An additional game captain per game will also be selected.

Pappoe, also a 2021 captain, is just the fourth two-time captain in Auburn annals, along with Reese Dismukes (2013-14), Gusty Yearout (1966-67) and Curtis Kuykendall (1944-45)

#### THE GRADUATES

» On the 2022 Auburn roster, 17 players have already received bachelor's degrees: Marcus Bragg (Western Kentucky), Nick Brahms; Marquis Burks; Zach Calzada (Texas A&M); Anders Carlson; Brandon Council (Akron); Luke Deal; Alec Jackson; Shedrick Jackson; Morris Joseph Jr. (Memphis); Eku Leota (Northwestern); Barton Lester; Jacob Quattlebaum; John Samuel Shenker; Kameron Stutts; Austin Troxell; and Kilian Zierer.

#### **COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA**

>> Kicker Anders Carlson and center Nick Brahms earned 2021 CoSIDA first team Academic All-America honors, only the second time that Auburn has had two first-team honorees in the prestigious program, which recognizes the nation's top student-athletes. LB Gregg Carr and K/P Matt Hawkins were both first-team honorees in 1984. Carlson, a 2020 first team Academic All-American, is just the second two-time honoree in Auburn history, along with Hawkins (1984-85). Carlson graduated in December, 2020, with a 3.92 GPA in professional flight management and has since completed his MBA. Brahms graduated in December, 2020, with a 3.89 GPA in professional flight management and also completed his MBA.

#### **SEC HONOR ROLLS**

There were 43 Auburn representatives on the SEC Academic Honor Roll for the 2021 season, including current team members John Reese Bellew, Tank Bigsby, Jackson Billigs, Nick Brahms, Anders Carlson, Oscar Chapman, Sammy Cohen, Luke Deal, Brandon Frazier, Tyler Fromm, Reed Hughes, Alec Jackson, Tate Johnson, Keiondre Jones, Barton Lester, Jake Levant, Trey Lindsey, Trent Mason, Evan McGuire, Marshall Meyers, Tommy Nesmith, Sawyer Pate, Jacob Quattlebaum, John Samuel Shenker, Wesley Steiner, Zykeivous Walker, Jeremiah Wright and Kilian Zierer.

Team members had a 3.0 GPA for the previous school year or a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher. These student-athlete leaders are also recognized as Academic Top Tigers.

» Auburn football had six representatives on the SEC First-Year Academic Honor Roll, recognizing freshmen and transfer student-athletes with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher. Current team members honored included Cort Bradley, Jarquez Hunter, Donovan Kaufman, Kyle Vaccarella and Garrison Walker.

#### **AD HONOR ROLL**

» Undergraduate student-athletes earn a spot on the AD Honor Roll with a combined 3.50 GPA or higher for the school year. Football had 17 players honored in 2021-22, including current team members John Reese Bellew, Jackson Billings, Cort Bradley, Oscar Chapman, Brandon Frazier, Tyler Fromm, Reed Hughes, Jarquez Hunter, Jackson Kelly, Jake Levant, Evan McGuire, Marshall Meyers, Tommy Nesmith and Kyle Vaccarella.

#### **TOTAL OFFENSE**

Auburn has scored in 118 consecutive games, the second-longest streak in school history. The Tigers are averaging 31.95 ppg (3,771 total points) during that stretch. Auburn was last shut out by No. 2 Alabama 49-0 in Tuscaloosa in 2012.

The longest streak of not being shut out in program history is 149 games, beginning with a 55-16 victory over Richmond on Oct. 4, 1980, in Doug Barfield's final season as the Tigers' head coach and lasting until the final game of Pat Dye's 12-year tenure as Auburn head coach when the Tigers lost 17-0 to No. 2 Alabama in the 1992 Iron Bowl.

Junior tailback Tank Bigsby got his 2022 campaign off to a productive start with 147 rushing yards and a pair of rushing touchdowns in the season opener against Mercer. His 39-yard score was the longest rushing TD of his career.

The 48th player in Auburn history to rush for more than 1,000 career yards, he ranks 18th with 2,080 career yards and 17 career scores. Bigsby's 10 career 100-yard rushing games are tied for 12th in program history.

With 1,099 yards last season, Bigsby became Auburn's first 1,000-yard rusher since Kerryon Johnson in 2017. Bigsby rushed for 100 yards+ in the first three games of the 2021 campaign.

He ranks third among Auburn rushers in yards gained through their sophomore season: Michael Dyer (2,355/2010-11); Bo Jackson (2,042/1982-83); Tank Bigsby (1,933/2020-21).

In 2020, Bigsby, the SEC Freshman of the Year, was eighth in the SEC in all-purpose average (122.4/gm, third among FBS freshmen); his

834 rushing yards ranked second among all FBS freshmen. Bigsby was the first Tiger to average 6.0 yards per carry since James Bostic in 1993.

Jarquez Hunter opened his sophomore campaign by rushing for three touchdowns on only eight carries against Mercer. It was Hunter's first career game with multiple rushing touchdowns. Hunter's three rushing scores against the Bears matched his total in 13 games as a freshman.

He is the first Auburn player to rush for three touchdowns since JaTarvious Whitlow did so against Mississippi State in 2019.

Hunter (3 rushing TDs vs. Mercer) and Bigsby (2 rushing TDs vs. Mercer) are the first Auburn teammates to rush for multiple touchdowns in the same game since Whitlow and Joey Gatewood each rushed for a pair of scores against Kent State in 2019.

Hunter ranked ninth among Auburn freshman rushers for a season with 597 yards as a true freshman during 2021.

Hunter rushed for 147 yards on just eight carries against Alabama State, the highlight being a 94-yard touchdown run, the longest run in Auburn history; the previous long was 92 yards by Ralph O'Gwynn vs. Loyola in 1936. That recordsetting run tied for seventh longest in the nation that season.

Hunter was SEC freshman of the week for his 65 yards rushing with the gamewinning touchdown against LSU.

- » Against Akron, Hunter rushed for 110 yards and a nine-yard touchdown. He was the first Auburn freshman to rush for 100 yards in a season opener since Onterio McCalebb (148 yds vs. Louisiana Tech in 2009). The last Auburn freshman to rush for 100 yards in a season opener before McCalebb? It was Bo Jackson vs. Wake Forest in 1982.
- Tight end John Samuel Shenker is seventh in career catches by an Auburn tight end with 50, and he is fifth in career tight end receiving yardage at 596.

Shenker's 33 catches during the 2021 campaign set an Auburn record for receptions by a tight end in a season. His 413 receiving yards also set an Auburn season record for tight ends.

» Shenker's 102-yard production on five catches at LSU last season was the first 100-yard game by an Auburn tight end since 1994 (Andy Fuller, 115 yards vs. Florida).

Shenker had five catches in a game four times last season (vs. Akron for 38 yards, at Penn State for 62 yards, vs. Houston in Birmingham Bowl for 54 yards). He had four receptions for 50 yards at Texas A&M.

" Junior Ja'Varrius Johnson led Auburn with 117 yards on four receptions in the Tigers' season-opening win over Mercer. It was Johnson's second career 100-yard receiving game (107 yards vs. Mississippi State in 2021).

Johnson's 117 receiving yards are the most by an Auburn player since Anthony Schwartz finished with 123 yards and a TD on four catches against LSU in 2020. The last Auburn receiver with a 100-yard game was Shedrick Jackson (111) last season at South Carolina.

#### FOR THE DEFENSE

- » Auburn has held its opponents without a rushing touchdown in six straight games dating back through the 2021 season, the longest such streak for the Tigers since not allowing a rushing score in eight straight games during the middle of the 2016 campaign.
- » Auburn is 63-27 when it forces a turnover since the start of the 2013 season and 38-10 when it forces multiple turnovers over that span, compared to just 12-15 when it fails to force a turnover.

The Tigers lost only 11 turnovers last season in 898 plays: seven fumbles and four interceptions. That tied for 10th nationally.

Auburn's total of four interceptions thrown last season tied for sixth among all FBS teams.

- Linebacker Cam Riley's 16 tackles against Mercer were a career high for the junior; he led the team in tackles for the first time in his career. Riley had the most tackles by an Auburn player since Zakoby McClain had 17 tackles against Texas A&M in 2020.
- Career double-figure tackle games at Auburn :

Auburn was fourth in the SEC and ranked 17th nationally in tackles for a loss, recording 96 last season (7.39/gm).

Derick Hall (12.5), Eku Leota (10.0), Smoke Monday (9.0), Colby Wooden (8.5), Zakoby McClain (8.0), T.D. Moultry (7.5) and Marcus Harris (6.0) led the Tigers individually; 23 different Auburn defenders had a hand in at least one TFL last season.

Current players with 100 career tackles at Auburn; Morris Joseph Jr. had 117 total tackles in three seasons at Memphis:

Owen Pappoe (169) Colby Wooden (110)

Senior Derick Hall has 13.5 career sacks, all in his last 20 games dating back to the middle of the 2020 season. Hall's 12.5 sacks the last two seasons tied for fourth in the SEC over that period.

Hall and Eku Leota, who registered 7.0 sacks in 2021, join Alabama's Will Anderson and Dallas Turner as the only returning SEC teammates after each recorded at least 7.0 sacks in 2021.

Hall has 18.5 career tackles for loss and 91 career tackles overall.

- Auburn is fifth among FBS teams allowing just 61 rushing TD since the start of the 2016 season; the Tigers have allowed only 175 total TD during that 79-game span (2.21 per game).
- » Auburn's defense has allowed only 24 first-quarter touchdowns in its last 67 games.
- >> The Tigers had nine interceptions for the 2021 season as a team. Career interceptions by current Auburn players: **Nehemiah Pritchett (2)**

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS**

- Senior preseason All-America kicker Anders Carlson returns to action after suffering a season-ending knee injury at the end of the 2021 Mississippi State game.
- Carlson, a 2020 Lou Groza Award semifinalist, ranks third in Auburn career scoring with 358 points.

He ranked ninth in the SEC in scoring at 7.7 points per game last season and was fifth in the league with 1.40 field goals made per game.

A 2020 second team All-American, Carlson is fourth in career PAT made (157) at Auburn and is second in career field goals made (67). He needs 19 made PATs to crack the SEC's career top 10.

He was 14-21 on field goal attempts and 35-36 on PAT in 2021. Carlson has made 36 of his last 39 field goal attempts dating back to late in 2019, including a career-long string of 16 consecutive FG makes to start the 2021 season.

- » Carlson, whose older brother Daniel (a three-time Lou Groza Award finalist) holds the season scoring record with the NFL's Las Vegas Raiders, has five career FG of at least 50 yards:
  - 53 Washington (2018)
  - 53 Liberty (2018)
  - 52 Alabama (2019)
  - 50 Tennessee (2020)
  - 50 Northwestern (2020)
- >> Carlson has nine career games with at least three field goals:

2021: Georgia State

2020: Arkansas, South Carolina,

Tennessee, Mississippi State;

**2019:** Alabama:

2018: Washington, Mississippi St., Liberty

- Carlson ranks second in career field goals made (67); he's among five AU kickers to make 15+ FG in multiple seasons:
  - Anders Carlson (2018, 2019, 2020)
    Daniel Carlson (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017)
    Wes Byrum (2007, 2009, 2010)
    Jim Von Wyl (1990, 1991)
    Win Lyle (1987, 1989)
- » With 832 combined career kicking points, the Carlsons (Daniel and Anders) are the all-time leaders in the most points scored by a duo of brothers who kicked for the same college, passing Kris and Drew Brown at Nebraska (743 points from 1995-98, 2014-17).
- >> Punter Oscar Chapman earned preseason all-SEC recognition from a number of sources.

Second among SEC punting leaders last season, Chapman had a then-career-high seven punts at Texas A&M. His four punts inside the 20 against the Aggies were also a career high.

His 63-yard punt in the third quarter was the third-longest of the Aussie's career. With his 65-yarder vs. Ole Miss, it marked the first time that Chapman recorded 60+ yard punts in back-to-back games in his career.

- Auburn ranked third in the SEC in net punting (41.79) and 20th nationally in that stat in 2021. Oscar Chapman was second in the SEC with a 44.1-yard punting average, 30th nationally.
- » Auburn continues the longest FBS current span of games (167) without having a punt blocked; Auburn last had a punt blocked vs. Mississippi State in 2009.
- » Barton Lester blocked a punt against Alabama State, Auburn's first of three blocked kicks last season. Lester also returned a blocked Georgia State punt for a score.

Colby Wooden blocked an Alabama State field goal attempt; it was recovered by Nehemiah Pritchett for a 80-yard return and his first career score. It was Auburn's first blocked field goal for a touchdown since Neiko Thorpe vs. Kentucky in 2009 (69 yards).

Auburn has seven field goal blocks and nine punt blocks since the start of 2016.

#### N.O.T. GOING TO LOSE

Auburn is 25-1 since the start of the 2013 season in games when scoring a nonoffensive touchdown, the latest being Marcus Harris' recovery of a fumble in the endzone at Arkansas last season.

Before the 2020 Outback Bowl, Auburn had won 21 straight games when the Tigers scored a non-offensive touchdown (NOT). During that string, the Tigers scored 24 non-offensive touchdowns, including three kickoffs, five punts (2 blocked), four fumbles, 11 interception returns and one missed field goal.

#### **RANKINGS**

- Auburn is 116-172-6 all-time facing ranked opponents. The Tigers are 54-45-2 at home against ranked teams, 29-74-2 on the road and 33-53-2 on a neutral field.
- Auburn is 56-104-3 all-time against AP top 10 teams (27-29-2 at home, 29-75-1 away from Auburn).
- >> The Tigers are 92-137-5 all-time facing ranked SEC opponents (44-36-2 at home, 29-66-2 away, 19-35-1 neutral). Ranked Auburn teams vs. ranked SEC teams are 60-55-3 overall (30-11-1 at home, 19-34-1 at the opponent's home, 11-10-1 on a neutral field).
- Auburn's record as a ranked team all-time is 334-126-6. Ranked Auburn teams at home are 191-34-2; away from Auburn, ranked Tiger squads are 142-91-4 all-time.

When a ranked Auburn team faces a ranked opponent, the Tigers' all-time record is 82-80-4 (37-14-1 at home, 22-43-1 away and 23-23-2 on a neutral field).

#### FROM THE MERCER GAME

- In the season opener vs. Mercer, 18 players saw their first action in an Auburn uniform. That included seven true freshmen and two redshirt freshmen.
- » Robby Ashford's 49-yard rush in the first quarter was the longest by an Auburn quarter-back since an 80-yard rush by John Franklin III against ULM in 2016.
- y Junior college transfer Keionte Scott is the first Auburn newcomer to record five tackles in a season opener since Owen Pappoe recorded five tackles against Oregon in 2019.

- >> There are 17 players on the Auburn roster who have already earned their bachelor's degrees, second best in the SEC behind South Carolina (20).
- » Auburn is now 101-27-2 (.787) all-time in season openers. The Tigers have won 14 of their past 16 openers dating back to the 2006 season; last season, Auburn defeated Akron 60-10 in the season opener at Jordan-Hare Stadium.

Auburn is 55-8-1 (.867) in season openers at home, 16-5-1 (.750) in openers on the road and 30-14 (.682) in openers at neutral-site locations. Auburn's total of 101 season-opening victories is behind only Alabama (103) and tied with Arkansas (101) for the most among current SEC schools.

The Tigers are 104-16-3 (.858) all-time in home openers; there were no games played in Auburn in 1892, 1893, 1894, 1895, 1897, 1937 and 1938. Although Jordan-Hare Stadium opened in 1939, the Tigers did not open a season there until 1951; since then, Auburn is 69-12-2 at the stadium in home openers.

The Tigers have won 15 of their last 16 home openers, the only loss coming to eventual national champion Clemson in 2016 by a 19-13 score.

Auburn is 57-15 (.792) in 72 season openers against non-conference opponents since the inception of the SEC in 1933.

Coach Bryan Harsin is 9-1 in season openers (2-0 at Auburn, 6-1 at Boise State, 1-0 at Arkansas State).

» In all-time SEC play, Auburn holds a 333-262-18 mark back through 1933. In SEC games played in Auburn, the Tigers are 142-64-6 all-time; away from Auburn, the Tigers are 191-197-12 overall.

In non-conference play, Auburn's all-time regular season record since 1933 is 258-70-6 (.781). Auburn has won 16 straight home games against non-conference opponents dating back to the 2016 season.

#### **2022 AUBURN FOOTBALL**

- >> The Tigers have 789 total victories since 1892, 13th among the all-time winningest FBS football programs. All-time, 32 FBS programs have posted more than 700 wins.
- Among teams that played at least 10 games last season, Auburn (0.82) was one of just six teams averaging fewer than 1.0 turnovers lost per game; others were Texas A&M, Texas, BYU, Notre Dame and Alabama.
- On the current Auburn roster, 40 players have at least one college start to their credit, 23 on offense and 17 on defense.

Seven Tigers have started 20 or more collegiate games: Brandon Council 39 (24 at Akron), Owen Pappoe 30, John Samuel Shenker 28. Colby Wooden 25 and Keiondre Iones 20. Derick Hall 20 and Nehemiah Pritchett 20 games.

- Pregame honorees this Saturday include Coach Ralph Spry, who retired last spring after 25 years as head coach of Auburn's track and field programs.
- Next up, the Tigers host Penn State September 17 in a 2:30 p.m. contest at Jordan-Hare Stadium that will be televised by CBS.

San Iose' State hosts Western Michigan on Saturday, September 24, in a 9:30 p.m. CT game.

#### THE LAST TIME VS. SAN JOSE' STATE **AUBURN 35; SJSU 21**

>> Peyton Barber ran through and, when necessary, over San Jose' State with a five-touchdown performance that included a throwback Bo Over the Top score and a 35-21 Auburn victory on a homecoming.

Barber scored on runs of 2, 2, 5, 1 and, just to finish it off, 36 yards on a blue-collar overcast day in Jordan-Hare Stadium. Barber was happy enough to play that brand of tough-minded

It was Barber's first multi-touchdown day, and he made sure he got it with two touchdown runs in the first quarter, another in the second and a 1-yard up-and-over-the-top, a la Bo Jackson, in the third quarter.

San Jose' State's Tyler Ervin, who rushed for 300 yards the previous week, gained more than 160 yards. His 2-yard TD run with 5:38 remaining kept the game close at 28-21 with 5:38 remaining, but Barber had one more touchdown left in him.

It was a running-kind-of-day. Auburn quarterback Sean White threw two passes in the second half.

Auburn improved to 3-2 and has won an off week before traveling to Kentucky for a Thursday night game on Oct. 15. San Jose' State fell to 2-3.

Barber had rushed for more than 100 yards in three of Auburn's first four games. Make it four out of five.

It was Peyton Over the Top for Barber's fourth touchdown, a 1-yard leap that gave Auburn a little breathing room, and a 28-14 lead with 4:37 left in the third quarter.

Auburn gave San Jose State's defense something new to think about in the first half when running back Kerryon Johnson took three direct snaps from center, gaining 14 yards in the process. San Jose' State showed it would take risks, going for it on fourth down three times in the first half.

The chess game played out, but it was the running of Barber and his three first-half touchdowns that had Auburn on the go in the first half. White's steady 5-of-8 passing for 103 first-half yards helped the cause as well, but this day belonged to the running game.

Barber scored in the first half on runs of 2, 2 and 5 yards, the last giving Auburn a 21-7 lead with 38 seconds left in the first half.

Barber also scored the first touchdown of the game. San Jose' State answered with an 18-yard touchdown pass from Joe Gray to Tyler Winston. But Barber made it 14-7 Auburn with 2:32 left in the first quarter.

- >> Bryan Harsin was named the 28th head football coach in Auburn's 127-year history on December 22, 2020. Harsin spent the previous seven seasons as head coach at Boise State, where he compiled a 69-19 record while winning three Mountain West Conference titles.
- >> A former Boise State quarterback, assistant coach and offensive coordinator, Harsin is 83-31 overall as a head coach including one season at Arkansas State and has directed his programs to bowl games each season.
- >> His impressive resume at Boise saw him lead the Broncos to five 10-win seasons, seven consecutive bowl appearances and six MWC West Division Championships.
- >> In his BSU debut season Harsin led his alma mater back to where it rose to national prominence. Boise State went 12-2 in 2014, winning its first outright Mountain West Championship and capping the campaign with a 38-30 victory over Arizona in the 2014 VIZIO Fiesta Bowl.
- >> The only alumnus to lead the Broncos as head coach in the history of Boise State, Harsin has won conference championships as a student-athlete, assistant coach and head coach.
- >> Boise State also captured MW titles in 2017 and 2019, giving Harsin three in six seasons. In 2017, the Broncos capped the championship campaign with a 38-28 victory over Oregon in the Las Vegas Bowl. The Broncos concluded the year at 11-3 overall and ranked No. 22 in both the Associated Press and Coaches Polls.
- >> For his efforts in 2014, Harsin was named a finalist for the Paul "Bear Bryant" National Coach of the Year Award, the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year Award and the Dodd Trophy, given annually by the Bobby Dodd National Coach of the Year Foundation. He was also named the nation's top first-year head coach by the Football Writers Association of America.
- >> Harsin earned his first head coaching opportunity at Arkansas State in 2013, which claimed a share of the Sun Belt Conference championship and a berth in the GoDaddy.com Bowl that season.

Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium, the nation's 12th-largest on-campus stadium with a capacity of 87,451, is in its 81st year as home to the Auburn Tigers.

On football Saturdays in Auburn, Jordan-Hare Stadium becomes Alabama's sixth-largest city. More than 75,000 season tickets have been sold to Auburn home games in each of the last 24 years.

The stadium is named for Ralph "Shug" Jordan, Auburn's all-time winningest football coach, and Clifford Leroy Hare, a member of Auburn's first football team, president of the old Southern Conference and long-time chairman of Auburn's Faculty Athletic Committee.

Legendary coach Pat Dye has also had his name forever attached to Jordan-Hare Stadium, as the turf officially became known as Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium prior to the 2005 Iron Bowl. Dye, who served as coach and athletics director at Auburn (1981-92) and was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame (2005), led Auburn to a 99-39-4 record and four SEC titles in his 12 seasons on the Plains.

What is now Jordan-Hare Stadium was dedicated November 30, 1939, at the Auburn-Florida game. Babe McGehee, who passed away in 2005, scored the first touchdown in what was then called "Auburn Stadium," by catching a pass from Dick McGowen. McGowen, who later coached at Auburn under Jordan, kicked the extra point and Auburn tied Florida, 7-7.

That first stadium held 7,500 seats and consisted of what is now the bottom part of the lower west stands. When the stadium was renamed "Cliff Hare Stadium" in 1949, 14,000 seats—the present lower east stands—had been added, raising capacity to 21,500.

Jordan became head coach in 1951 and the stadium underwent three major expansions in 15 years. More than 40,000 seats, virtually half of the stadium's present capacity, were added while Jordan was the coach.

Cliff Hare Stadium became Jordan-Hare Stadium in 1973. It was the first stadium in the country to be named for an active coach.a

Overall, Auburn has played 431 games in Jordan-Hare Stadium, winning 339, losing 88 and tying seven for a winning percentage of .789 against some of the best teams in college football.

After lightning delayed Auburn's season opener for 90 minutes in the third quarter, Tank Bigsby provided his own lightning strike, racing 39 yards for a touchdown on the first play after the game resumed

Generating explosive plays on the ground and in the air, Auburn kicked off the 2022 season by defeating Mercer 42-16 Saturday at Jordan-Hare Stadium.

The big-play Tigers produced seven plays of 20 yards or more.

Auburn scored touchdowns on four of its first five drives with Jarquez Hunter scoring the season's first points on a 19-yard run on the Tigers' first drive.

Auburn gained 88 yards in two plays on its second possession on a 49-yard run by quarterback Robby Ashford and a 39-yard pass from T.J. Finley to Ja'Varrius Johnson. Auburn made it 14-0 on Finley's 2-yard touchdown pass to John Samuel

Hunter's 2-yard touchdown put the Tigers on top 21-0 early in the second quarter with 84,562 in attendance. Bigsby, who led Auburn with 147 rushing yards on 16 carries, scored on a 2-yard touchdown run to give Auburn a 28-0 lead with 5:04 remaining in the first half.

Mercer capitalized on an Auburn interception to score on a 5-yard touchdown pass with 20 seconds left in the half.

Derick Hall recorded a third-down sack to force a punt in the third quarter. Ashford threw a 56-yard pass to Johnson to

set up Hunter's third touchdown, a 1-yarder that gave Auburn a 35-7 lea'd before lightning within eight miles of Pat Dye Field

delayed the game late in the third quarter.

The Bears added nine fourth-quarter points on a field goal and a touchdown with 25 seconds remaining.

Linebacker Cam Riley led Auburn with a career-high 15 tackles, exceeding his 2021 season total of 14.

Johnson made four receptions for 117 yards, averaging 29.3 yards per catch.
Ashford, a redshirt freshman, produced 168 yards of total offense, completing 4-of-7 passes for 100 yards while rushing for 68 yards on six carries.
