SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL FACT SHEET (Game #4)

Upcoming game: San José State at Iowa State
Saturday, September 24, 2016,

San José State record: 1-2. The Spartans lost to Utah, 34-17, on September 17, at home in CEFCU Stadium, home of the Spartans.

Iowa State record: 0-3, 0-1 Big 12. The Cyclones lost their conference opener at TCU, 41-20, on September 17.

San José State head coach Ron Caragher: In his fourth season as the San José State head coach. Has a record of 16-24 with the Spartans. Overall, he is in his 10th season as a college head coach and has a 60-46 record. Caragher's first six seasons as a head coach were at the University of San Diego. He is 0-0 as a head coach against Iowa State.

Iowa State head coach Matt Campbell: In his first season at Iowa State. Has a record of 0-3 with the Cyclones. Overall, he is in his fifth season as a major college head coach and has a record of 35-18. He is 0-0 as a head coach against San José State.

Series history: Iowa State leads the series, 3-0. The teams are facing each other for the first time since September 20, 1980 when Iowa State posted a 27-6 win in Jack Trice Stadium. The teams played a home-and-home series in 1958 and 1959. Iowa State won its home game, 55-0, on November 14, 1959.

Possibly a 2-2 September: A win at Iowa State would give San Jose State its second consecutive 2-2 win-loss record for September. Last year, the Spartans defeated New Hampshire and Fresno State at home and lost at Air Force and Oregon State.

Final regular season non-conference game: Iowa State is San José State's last regular season non-conference opponent in 2016. The Spartans seek their first non-conference win against a Football Subdivision (FBS) opponent since defeating BYU, 20-14, in San Jose on November 17, 2012. Since then, San Jose State is 0-11 in regular-season non-conference games against FBS opponents. The Spartans do have bowl wins over Bowling Green in the 2012 Military Bowl and Georgia State in the 2015 AutoNation Cure Bowl.

Aiming for a regular season non-conference road win: San Jose State has the opportunity to win its first non-conference road game in four years on September 24 at Iowa State. The Spartans' last non-conference road victory was a 12-0 triumph at Navy on September 29, 2012. Since then, San Jose State lost twice at Auburn (2014 & 2015) and Minnesota (2013 & 2014) and once at Tulsa (2016), Oregon State (2015), and #5-Stanford (2013).

San Jose State vs. Big 12 opponents: Iowa State is San Jose State's first Big 12 Conference opponent since the 2007 game at Kansas State. The Spartans are 1-10 against Big 12 (Big 8 Conference) members. San Jose State's one win against a Big Eight Conference opponent was a 16-0 triumph over Kansas State on September 28, 1963 in San Jose.

Play-by-Play Radio Coverage: KLIV (1590 AM, San José) originates San José State football broadcasts. Justin Allegri calls the play-by-play. Kevin Richardson provides commentary. Air time for the KLIV broadcast is 8:30 a.m. (PT).

San José State in top-10 for turnovers gained: For the second week in a row, San Jose State ranks in the top-10 for turnovers gained. The Spartans' eight turnovers gained is tied for sixth among Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) schools. Despite not gaining any turnovers at Tulsa, San José State gained six turnovers in the Portland State win and two in the loss to Utah.

A +6 turnover margin vs. Portland State: The Portland State win marked the first time since September 27, 2008 at Hawai'i that San Jose State completed a game with a +6 turnover margin. In the 20-17 win at Hawai'i, the Spartans came away with four interceptions and two fumble recoveries.

Opponents converting turnovers into points: Though San José State is +0.67 in turnover margin after three games, its opponents are making the most of a Spartan giveaway this season. San Jose State's six turnovers (three interceptions and three fumbles) resulted in 34 opponent points in the first three games.

The Spartans' eight turnovers gained produced 17 points in three games.

Promising pass rush: San José State has eight quarterback sacks after three games. The Spartans began the season with four quarterback sacks in the Tulsa game. A year ago, the Spartans did not get their eighth sack until the ninth game of the season.

Linebacker **Frank Ginda** is tied for 18th nationally with a 1.00/game average. He has quarterback sack in each of the first three games. Last year's team leader was defensive end **Eugene Taylor** who finished the season with 3.0 sacks.

Long-play producers: San José State has 11 plays of 30 or more yards this season. Six of them, five on offense and an interception return, occurred in the Portland State win.

Opponents generating long plays, too: San José State's first three opponents also produced 11 plays of 30 or more yards on five runs and six pass plays this season. There were four each in the Tulsa and Utah losses and three in the Portland State win.

The early return is long: Through three games and 51 pass receptions, San Jose State has two wide receivers with a 20.0 or more yards catch average. **Justin Holmes** leads the group with a 24.8 average. **Tre Hartley**, who is second on the team with 10 receptions, is has a 20.7 yards per catch average

Freeman reaches 100: Billy Freeman, listed on the John Mackey Award preseason watch list, became the 28th San Jose State player and second this season to reach the 100-reception threshold in a career. Freeman enters the Iowa State game with 100 receptions after catching two passes against Utah on September 17. He is just the third San Jose State tight end with 100 or more career receptions.

In the season opener at Tulsa, wide receiver **Tim Crawley** caught his 100th pass as a San Jose State player.

Crawford at 100%: Placekicker **Bryce Crawford** is one of 15 in the Football Bowl Subdivision to make each of his kick scoring attempts based on at least 1.00 field goals made per game in games played through September 17.

Improved kick return coverage: San José State is ranked eighth in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in defending kickoff returns at 14.2 yards per return.

In his first season as the Spartans' kickoff specialist, **Michael Carrizosa** has 12 touchbacks credited in 18 kickoffs (66.7 percent). A year ago, the Spartans finished 118th in kickoff yards per return allowing 25.3 per return and had 27 touchbacks on 69 attempts (39.1 percent).

66 points for the Spartans: San José State's 66 points in the Portland State win rank as the fifth highest scoring game in school history since 1946. The two highest are the back-to-back games against the University of Mexico to end the 1948 and open the 1949 seasons.

A 400-plus yard ground game: San Jose State's 409 yards rushing in the Portland State win are the most by a Spartan team since a 476-yard performance on October 28, 2006 when San Jose State rushed for 476 yards in a win over Louisiana Tech. The 409 figure is the eighth time a San Jose State team rushed for at least 400 yards in a game and ranks eighth on the school's single game rushing list.

The 409 rushing yards rank as the tenth best single-game total in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in games played through September 17.

Two 100-yard rushers & nearly a third: For the first time in 15 years, two San Jose State players rushed for at least 100 yards in the same game in the Portland State victory. Graduate student **Deontae Cooper** with 126 yards and one touchdown on 18 carries and redshirt freshman **Zamore Zigler** with 15 carries for 111 yards and two scores reached the 100-yard plateau.

Sophomore **Malik Roberson** nearly became a third 100-yard rusher for the Spartans. Roberson finished with 92 yards and a touchdown on eight carries. He had as many as 97 rushing yards in the Portland State game.

Long runs leave marks: Two of San Jose State's nine touchdowns in the Portland State game came on runs of 87 yards by **Malik Roberson** and 74 yards by **Zamore Zigler**. Roberson's touchdown burst matches UCF's Adrian Killins for the third longest run in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in 2016 and ties the sixth longest rushing play in school history.

The two long touchdown runs for Roberson and Zigler mark the first time San Jose State rushed for two touchdowns in one game of 70 or more yards.

Crawford 10-for-10: **Bryce Crawford** joined an exclusive group of San Jose State kick scorers with 10 successful kick-scoring attempts in a game. He was 9-for-9 on PAT attempts and converted a 22-yard field goal against Portland State. The single-game school record for PATs in a modern-era San Jose State game since 1950 is 10 by **Jeff Carr** against Rice on October 2, 2004. Another Spartan with at least 10 successful kick-scoring attempts in a game is former San Francisco 49ers kicker **Joe Nedney** who was 7-for-8 in PATs and kicked three field goals in a 64-45 win over Pacific in 1991.

Crawley becomes the 27th: With his team-leading fourth reception in the game at Tulsa, wide receiver **Tim Crawley** became the 27th San José State player with 100 career receptions. Tight end **Billy Freeman** likely is the next Spartan to reach 100 career receptions. Freeman has 98 after catching two passes against Portland State.

First time starters: Safety **Ethan Aguayo** became the eighth San Jose State player to make his first major college start in a game this season when he started against Portland State. Left tackle **Troy Kowalski**, wide receiver **Rahsheed Johnson**, defensive tackle **Owen Roberts** and defensive backs **David Williams**, **Trevon Bierria**, **Dakari Monroe** and **Jeremy Kelly** were first-time starters in the opener at Tulsa.

Brothers on the field at the same time: During the Tulsa game, brothers **Jeremy Kelly** and **Jermaine Kelly** played as defensive backs together. Though San José State has had other brother combinations on the same team in the last seven years, the last time two brothers played on the field at the same time was in the 2009 season when defensive end **Carl Ihenacho** and his younger brother, defensive back **Duke Ihenacho**, were starters for the Spartans.

Season captains named: Wide receiver **Tim Crawley**, linebacker **Christian Tago**, quarterback **Kenny Potter** and safety **Maurice McKnight** were named team captains for the 2016 season. McKnight is the only non-senior among the four. Tago, yet to play a game this season while recovering from an injury, was one of four team captains last season.

Seven get the scholarship word: On August 20, seven players were placed on scholarship. Tight end **LeVander Brown**, wide receiver **Tre Hartley**, defensive back **Chandler Hawkins**, quarterback **Josh Love** and linebackers **Mark Amann**, **Alex Manigo** and **Epie Sona** were informed after the team's scrimmage. Love is a redshirt freshman; Hartley and Hawkins, sophomores; and Brown, Amann, Manigo and Sona, seniors.

The graduate transfer: Running back **Deontae Cooper** from the University of Washington and wide receiver **Dontonio Jordan** from Stanford University are two graduate transfers on the 2016 San José State football team.

San José State's 99th season: The 2016 season marks San José State's 99th playing college football. According to available records, the Spartans began playing football in 1893, but did not have games in 1894, 1897, 1901-20 and 1943-45.

New home stadium name: Recently, San José State and Citizens Equity First Credit Union (CEFCU, pronounced SEFF-cue) agreed to a 15-year naming rights agreement for Spartan Stadium, built in 1933, to be called CEFCU Stadium - Home of the Spartans. CEFCU and San José State Athletics first became partners in 2011 with signage on the stadium scoreboard and at the West gate entry point.
