### **No. 10 Grand Canyon-San José State Post-Match Notes**

For the first time in 21 years, SJSU has earned multiple results over top-20 opponents (1-1 vs. #13 Stanford, 3-2 at #12 Cal State Fullerton in 2000). This year's team tallied a 0-0 draw at No. 20 Stanford earlier this season before tonight's 2-1 victory over No. 10 Grand Canyon.

The victory marked the program's first win over a top-10 opponent in 16 years to the day (won at No. 2 New Mexico on Oct. 16, 2005).

SJSU's 4-1-1 start to conference play is their best through six league matches since 2005 (started MPSF action 5-1).

San José State's unbeaten streak is now up to a season-long five matches (4-0-1 in that stretch).

Willy Miranda scored his team-leading fifth goal of the season and his 14<sup>th</sup> in a Spartan kit in the match's 10<sup>th</sup> minute.

Kasper Poulsen scored his second goal of the season (and career), netting what would prove to be the match-winner in the 18<sup>th</sup> minute.

Both Max Allen and Rudi Castro assisted on each Spartan goal on Saturday night.

The Spartans are now 5-3-2 all-time against Grand Canyon.
