### **San José State-UNLV Postgame Notes**

San José State's 76-63 victory gives the team its 18<sup>th</sup> victory of the year, allowing the Spartans to end the regular season with the nation's largest single-season win turnaround (+12 from 2018-19).

The 12-win turnaround also marks the best in program history.

The victory gave the team its first regular-season sweep of UNLV in program history.

Sophomore Ayzhiana Basallo clinched the conference's scoring title on Thursday, ending the year with 506 total points. Basallo was the Mountain West's only player to reach the 500-point plateau.

Playing in her final collegiate regular season game, senior Fieme'a Hafoka led SJSU with 16 points. San José State has now had seven different players lead the team in scoring this season.

The Spartans allowed just nine points in the game's second quarter, marking the team's sixth single-digit defensive quarter this year.

The victory marked the team's 12<sup>th</sup> conference win of the season, setting a record for league victories at SJSU in the Jamie Craighead era.

The Spartans will enter the Mountain West Tournament in the No. 4 spot, matching the program's best-ever seed for a conference tournament.
