San Diego State-San José State Postgame Notes

San José State is now 7-3 after Saturday's victory. This is the program's best record through 10 games since the 2004-05 campaign (also started 7-3).

The Spartans are 2-0 in Mountain West play for the first time since the 2015-16 season (started 3-0 with victories over Utah State, Air Force and San Diego State).

SJSU has now won five of its last six conference home openers.

Ayzhiana Basallo, Danae Marquez and Fieme'a Hafoka all finished the game with five assists. Saturday's win marked the program's first game with three players dishing out at least five assists since November 28, 2017 (at Santa Clara, Danae Marquez, Myzhanique Ladd, Taylor Turney).

The 84-67 win marked the program's second straight victory over San Diego State.

The 17-point victory was the program's largest win in a conference game since December 29, 2016 (107-84 vs. Nevada).

Sophomore Ayzhiana Basallo reached the 20-point plateau for the 10th time in 10 games with two free throws in the final minute. The point guard's 226 total points leads all of Division I.

San José State has now won six of its last seven games.
