SPARTANS AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

The fifth-ranked San José State women's golf team is making its 22nd appearance at the NCAA Championships. The Tom Fazio-designed Raptor course unfolds over the gentle hills and across shaded natural arroyos found in this corner of the Sonoran Desert. The course is listed among the best public golf courses in Arizona by *Golfweek* and *Golf Magazine*. The course will play at par 72 and 6,399 yards.

TICKETS - Through the generosity of local contributors, entry to the golf course and parking is free to the public. Parking for spectators will be on-site until the lot is full and then will be directed to the overflow off-site location.

TV COVERAGE: The Golf Channel will provide live coverage of the final three days of the championship.

Tuesday, May 24 - 9 a.m.-11:30 a.m. PT (quarterfinals)

Tuesday, May 24 - 2-6 p.m. PT (semifinal matches)

Wednesday, May 25 - 2-6 p.m. PT (championship match)

TEE TIMES: Tee times for the first and second rounds are determined by seeding. San José State will start the championship on Friday the 20th at 11:30 a.m. PT off of the first tee. On Saturday the 21st, SJSU will be in the first group to tee off on the 10th tee beginning at 6:30 a.m. PT. The Spartans will play the first two rounds with Wake Forest (4th seed) and Oklahoma State (6th seed). Tee times for Sunday, the 22nd, will be determined by the results after two rounds.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT: All 24 teams and 12 individuals will complete 54 holes of stroke play. Following 54-holes of competition on Sunday, the top-15 teams along with the top nine individuals not on an advancing team will advance for one additional day of stroke play to determine the top eight teams for match play competition and the 72-hole stroke-play individual champion.

The top eight teams after 72 holes of stroke play will be placed into a bracket with the No. 1 seed playing the No. 8 seed, the No. 2 seed playing the No. 7 seed, the No. 3 seed playing the No. 6 seed and the No. 4 seed playing the No. 5 seed in match play. Ties for the top 15 teams as well as the top 9 individuals, will be broken by use of a sudden-death playoff. Otherwise, the use of the established non-sudden-death tie-breaking procedures will be used for determining advancement.

Additionally, ties for the top eight teams and NCAA individual champion will be broken by a sudden-death playoff or, if necessary, by the established non-sudden-death tie breaking procedures.

SPARTAN LINEUP: San José State will travel the same lineup that has played in the past seven tournaments - **Natasha Andrea Oon, Lucia Lopez Ortega, Antonia Malate, Kajsa Arwefjäll,** and **Louisa Carlbom.** **Jordyn Parr** is the alternate.

The lineup started this run by finishing fifth at the Illini Women's Invitational before finishing either first or second at the next seven tournaments including two wins over No. 1 Stanford.

SAN JOSE STATE AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Spartans are making their 22nd appearance at an NCAA Championship and have won three national titles - 1987, 1989 and 1992. Current head coach **Dana (Lofland) Dormann** finished tied for 17th individually at the 1987 championship.

The Spartans last competed at the NCAA Championships in 2019 at the Blessings Golf Club in Fayetteville, Ark. The team finished 19th in the three-round stroke play portion of the tournament, shortened due to inclement weather. **Natasha Andrea Oon** finished ninth in the individual standings at 3-over 222 (par 73). She was the first Spartan to finish in the top-10 at an NCAA Championship since Janice Moodie finished second at the 1997 NCAA Championships. Pat Hurst is the only San José State player to win an individual title. In all, 13 Spartans finished in the top-10 a total of 22 times at the NCAA Championships. Janice Moodie finished in the top-10 in all four years she competed for San José State, finishing second in 1997. A complete listing is on page 25.

SAN JOSE STATE AT THE REGIONALS: The Spartans won their third regional team title in school history with the three-shot win over Virginia last week at the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional. The program made its 26th NCAA Regional since 1993. The other two regional titles came in 1994 in Albuquerque and 1995 in Tucson. The team has finished second twice - 1996 & 2000.

SPARTAN COACHING STAFF: Head coach **Dana Dormann** is in her fourth year at the helm of the women's program and her 18th season affiliated with the San José State golf program. Named the head coach of the program in June of 2018, she has twice been honored by her peers as the Mountain West Coach of the Year, 2019 and 2022.

Kortnie Barrett is in her second year as the assistant coach for the Spartan program. She joined the program in January of 2021 and made an immediate impact on the team.

GOLFSTAT RANKINGS: Four Spartans rank among the top-100 players in the country.

U-M COURSE RECORDS: San José State rewrote two records at the U-M Golf Course last week after sweeping the team and individual titles. The Spartans shot an 862 for the three rounds, the second-lowest women's 54-hole total at the course. **Natasha Andrea Oon** set the record for the women's individual 54-hole total at 6-under 207 en route to winning the title.

G5 REPRESENTED: **San José State** is the only school not from a Power 5 conference to qualify for the 2022 NCAA team championship. The Spartans are representing the Mountain West for the second time in three years (2019) as the 2020 championships were canceled due to COVID. **Kajsa Arwefjäll** represented the Spartans at the 2021 championships as she qualified as an individual and finished tied for 36th after shooting a 294 (77-71-72-74).

WHAT A RECORD!: The Spartans have produced one of the best win-loss records in school history this spring. The team has won five of the six tournaments played for a 73-1 record. For the 2021-22 season, San José State enters the championships with a 124-8-1 record this season. The tie came in the second tournament of the fall when SJSU tied with UCLA at The Molly Collegiate Invitational.

DORMANN NAMED TO WATCH LIST: Head coach **Dana Dormann** has been named to the watch list for the 2021-22 Division I Jackie Steinmann WGCA National Coach of the Year Presented by Golf Pride. The award will be announced after medal play at the upcoming NCAA Championship.

Recognized as the highest annual coaching honor in women's collegiate golf, the Jackie Steinmann WGCA National Coach of the Year Presented by Golf Pride is awarded annually to the top coach in Division I, II III and NAIA. The recipient is selected by a prestigious collection of women's collegiate golf coaches.

FINAL ANNIKA AWARD WATCH LIST: Natasha Andrea Oon is one of 10 players named to the Final ANNIKA Award Watch List presented by Stifel, honoring the top female U.S. collegiate golfer. The award is voted on by players, coaches, SIDs and members of the college golf media.

This is the second time Oon has been on an ANNIKA Award Watch List. She was named to the 2019 Fall ANNIKA Award Watch List for the 2019-20 season. Unfortunately, that season ended early due to COVID-19.

AUGUSTA NATIONAL WOMEN'S AMATEUR: San José State women's golfer **Antonia Malate** shot a 6-over 78 at the Augusta National Golf Course in the final round to finish tied for 25th at the Augusta National Women's Amateur (ANWA). Malate finished the tournament at 11-over 227 and made her only birdie of the round on the par-5 15th hole.

She made the cut after shooting 75-74 in the first two rounds played at the Champions Retreat Golf Club. Malate was the first San José State women's golfer to ever compete at the ANWA.

SHE DID WHAT?? AFTER AUGUSTA??: After completing play at the Augusta National Women's Amateur on Saturday, April 2, **Antonia Malate** flew back to the Bay Area that night. The next morning, she joined her Spartan teammates for the practice round at the Silverado Showdown.

Then, on April 4, 5 and 6, Malate then went out and shot 69-68-76 for a 3-under 213 and finished third among 90 players at the Silverado Showdown, her best finish of the season.

CHEVRON CHAMPIONSHIP: **Natasha Andrea Oon** received a sponsor tournament invitation to The Chevron Championship at the Mission Hills Country Club, March 31-April 3. She shot 74-73 over her first two rounds and missed the cut by just two shots. Oon also had a familiar face on the bag as assistant coach **Kortnie Barrett** served as her caddie for the tournament.

TOUGH DECISION TO MAKE: Most golfers dream of getting one invitation to a prestigious event. **Natasha Andrea Oon** had to make a choice in March after she received invites to play at the Augusta National Women's Amateur and The Chevron Championship. Both tournaments were played at the same time, and she made the tough decision to stay in California and get the experience of playing at an LPGA event.

WINNER, WINNER, FIVE CHICKEN DINNERS: The Spartans have been on a speech tour this spring season as the team won five tournament titles, tying for the fourth-most in school history. The Spartans placed second at the other spring tournament, one shot behind Texas Tech at the MountainView Collegiate.

FIRST MW CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE SWEET: San José State finally added a Mountain West Championship trophy to the case after winning 20 conference titles in the Western Athletic Conference (6), Big West (10) and Nor-Cal (4). The Spartans shot a four-under 860 at the Mission Hills Country Club to win by a MW record 30 shots over New Mexico.

The Spartans also captured the individual title as **Natasha Andrea Oon** birdied the final hole to win with a record-setting 10-under 206. Oon shot a 1-under 71 in the final round, including three-under over the final 10 holes, to win the title.

Oon set the championship scoring record of 10-under par, breaking the previous record of 7-under 209, set by Therese Koelhaek of UNLV (2011) and Ryley Webb of New Mexico (2001).

Oon also set the record for largest winning margin, winning her first championship title by seven shots and breaking the old record of five set by Alexandra Kauai of UNLV in 2016.

OON JOINS ELITE COMPANY: **Natasha Andrea Oon** joined a prestigious list of Spartans who have won an individual conference title, starting with current head coach Dana (Lofland) Dormann who won the PCAA title in 1987. Others on that list include – Pat Hurst, Denise Philbrick, Tracy Hanson, Lisa Walton, Janice Moodie, Marie Hedberg, Ashley Gomes, Jenelle Gomez and Erica Moston.

ARNOLD PALMER CUP SELECTIONS: Continuing to build upon their golfing successes, San José State players **Natasha Andrea Oon, Kajsa Arweffjäll** and **Antonia Malate** have been named to the 2022 Arnold Palmer Cup teams. The matches will be played at Golf Club de Genève in Switzerland, July 1-3, 2022.

The Arnold Palmer Cup is a Ryder Cup-style tournament featuring the top men's and women's university/college golfers matching the United States against a team of International players, the only major tournament which features men and women playing side-by-side as partners.

Oon and Arweffjäll will play for the International team, while Malate will be part of Team USA. They are the first participants from San José State to play at the Arnold Palmer Cup. San José State is also only one of four schools to be represented by more than one player – Stanford, 4; San José State, 3; Arizona State 2; Wake Forest 2.

FINALS AND GRADUATIONS: While the Spartans are at the championships, finals are going on at San José State (18, 19, 20, 23, 24). Graduations will be held on the 25th, 26th and 27th.

Antonia Malate is graduating this semester with her ceremony scheduled for Wednesday, the 25th at 4 p.m., the same time as the championship match play.

EARNED HER DEGREE IN DECEMBER: **Natasha Andrea Oon** received her bachelor's degree in business administration in December 2021. She is currently in graduate school and working on her master's degree in interdisciplinary studies with an emphasis on data analytics.

ARWEFJÄLL REPRESENTED SWEDEN AT THE SPIRIT: San José State women's golfer **Kajsa Arweffjäll** was chosen as part of a four-player team that represented Sweden at The Spirit International at the Whispering Pines Golf Club in Trinity, Texas, from November 4-6.

She shot a two-over 74 in the final round to tie for 11th in women's individual standings at three-over 219. The team of four placed third in the combined standings, while Arweffjäll and Andrea Lignell combined to place fourth in the women's standings. Over the three days, Arweffjäll shot 73-72-74. She was second in the tournament in pars made with 41 over the three rounds.

The Spirit is a celebration of international goodwill through the game of golf, featured 80 competitors from 20 countries and four continents and was a 54-hole, four-ball stroke play competition. The best three scores counted each day in the team competition. There were also competitions for women's team, men's team, women's individual and men's individual.

SPARTANS GO 1-2-3 AT MW CHAMPS: For the first time in MW history, one school had the top-three finishers at the championship. **Natasha Andrea Oon** finished first by seven strokes over **Lucia Lopez Ortega**. Oon shot 10-under, followed by Lopez Ortega at 3-under, and **Kajsa Arweffjäll** tied for third at even-par 216.

SPARTANS SETTING RECORDS: This year's team has set the school record for the most rounds of par or better in a single season. The Spartans have recorded 51 rounds under par and 20 rounds of par play. A complete listing is found on page 31.

SPARTANS SWEEP MOUNTAIN WEST HONORS: For the second time in four seasons, the fifth-ranked San José State women's golf team swept the Mountain West postseason honors and placed four players on the All-MW first team.

Natasha Andrea Oon has been named the MW Player of the Year for the second time in three years, while freshman **Lucia**

Lopez Ortega is the MW Freshman of the Year. Spartan head coach **Dana Dormann** adds to her trophy case as she is the MW Coach of the Year for the second time (2019 & 2022).

The Spartans also placed four on the first team All-MW – Oon, Lopez Ortega, **Kajsa Arweffjäll** and **Antonia Malate**. The four players from one school are the most on the first team since 2006 when UNLV placed four players on an eight-player team.

ACADEMICS IMPORTANT IN TITLE "STUDENT-ATHLETE"

Three women's golfers were honored at the San José State Honors Convocation on May 6 for earning President's Scholar recognition - **Kajsa Arwefjäll, Louisa Carlbom, and Antonia Malate**. To earn a President's Scholar designation, a student must earn a 4.00 grade-point average in one of the two semesters (Spring, 2021 or Fall 2021) before the Honors Convocation.

Four others earned Dean's Scholar recognition for earning a 3.65 gpa in Spring 2021 or Fall 2021 - **Jadan Gonzalez, Lucia Lopez Ortega, Jordyn Parr and Danielle Suh**.

CHAMPIONSHIP CALIBER COACH: NCAA Championship play is nothing new Spartan coach **Dana Dormann**. She helped the Spartans win the 1987 team title, the first in school history in women's golf. She was the student assistant coach for the 1989 championship team. Dormann was the assistant coach for the 2010 and 2013 teams that played in Wilmington, N.C., and Athens, Ga., respectively. This is her second appearance at an NCAA Championship as a head coach (2019).

Two-time Mountain West Women's Golf Coach of the Year



No stranger to NCAA Championship competition, San José State women's golf coach Dana Dormann is in her fourth season at the helm of the Spartan program. The former Spartan All-American and San José State Sports Hall of Fame honoree was named to lead the program in June of 2018.

The 2022 Mountain West Coach of the Year has led the San José State women's golf program back to national prominence with the Spartans ranked in the top-10 for much of the 2021-22 season. The Spartans finished either first or second in eight of the nine tournaments played. San José State won the first Mountain West Women's Golf Championship in April of 2022, winning by a record 30 shots over their nearest competitor. The team won four tournaments in the spring of 2021 including twice over top-ranked Stanford at the Lamkin Invitational and the Juli Inkster at Meadow Club Invitational. The Spartans broke the school record for most under par & par rounds recorded in a season at 64.

For all their successes in 2021-22, the Spartans swept the conference awards as Natasha Andrea Oon was the MW Player of the Year, Lucia Lopez Ortega the MW Freshman of the Year and those two, along with Kajsa Arweffjäll and Antonia Malate were selected to the All-MW first team.

Throughout the previous three seasons, Dormann navigated the program through an early shut down of the season in 2020 due to COVID-19, to a spring-only season in 2021. She coached Arweffjäll to an appearance at the NCAA National Championship where she finished tied for 36th in the individual standings.

In her first season (2018-19), Dormann and the Spartans won two tournaments - Minnesota Invitational, and The Gold Rush. The Spartans advanced to the 2019 NCAA Championships at the Blessings Golf Course where the team finished 19th. She coached the top-two golfers in the Mountain West - Abigail Arevalo, the 2018-19 MW Women's Golfer of the Year, and Oon, the 2018-19 MW Women's Golf Freshman of the Year. Dormann was honored as the 2018-19 MW Women's Golf Coach of the Year.

Dormann was the associate head coach and assistant coach for the Spartan program for 13-plus seasons. She mentored many players during those years including All-American and conference Player of the Year winners Erica Moston and My Leander. Dormann helped coach the Spartans to berths at the NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championships - 2013 in Athens, Ga., and 2010 in Wilmington, N.C.

In 2011, Dormann was named the Coach of the Year for the Western Section, as selected by the LPGA Teaching and Club Professional membership. She was one of five collegiate coaches selected for the award.

Dormann has been successful in golf from a young age, winning the 1985 U.S. Junior and Junior World championships to becoming a three-time All-American for the Spartans. She played on 1985 through 1988 teams, was a member of the 1987 NCAA Championship team, won four tournaments and was the 1987 Pacific Coast Athletic Association Player of the Year. Dormann was also an assistant coach for the 1989 NCAA Championship team.

Professionally, she played 10 years on the LPGA Tour, winning the 1992 Las Vegas LPGA International and the 1993 McCall's LPGA Classic. Dormann is a member of the Golf Coaches Association of America Hall of Fame.

Still playing competitively, Dormann earned medalist honors by shooting a three-under 68 to qualify for the inaugural 2018 U.S. Senior Women's Open in Chicago. Dormann was the only player under par at the qualifier on the par-71 Ocean Course at San Francisco's Olympic Club. She qualified for the 2019 U.S. Senior Women's Open after winning the Stanford qualifier with an even-par 71. Dormann is no stranger to USGA events as she played in 14 U.S. Women's Open Championships.

Dana and her husband, John, are the proud parents of sons William and Jason.



Kortnie Barrett

Assistant Head Coach

Kortnie Maxoutopoulos Barrett joined the Spartan program as an assistant coach in January of 2021.

Barrett had a whirlwind beginning to her first five months as a Spartan in 2021. The team finished in the top-four in the first three tournaments played. She helped coach Kajsa Arewfjäll to the 2021 NCAA Championships where she tied for 36th after a fifth-place finish at the NCAA Stanford Regional. Academically, the team posted one of the highest semester grade point averages in school history.

Prior to San José State, Barrett spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Mississippi State where she helped the 2019 team get back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in four seasons. She was responsible for all team travel and assisted in recruiting top talent to the school. The school's Golfstat ranking improved from 68 when she started to 22 in the nation this past school year.

Before Starkville, Barrett spent one season on the staff at Long Beach State. She helped coach the team to the Big West Conference Championship, UC Irvine Invitational title and the program's first NCAA Regional bid in almost 10 years. The program jumped 41 spots in the Golfstat ranks during the one season she coached the 49ers.

Barrett received her master's degree in public & non-profit administration from Georgia Southern University in 2017 where she spent two years as the graduate assistant coach for their inaugural women's golf program.

Playing as the former Kortnie Maxoutopoulos, she competed for three seasons at TCU after playing at Rutgers her freshman year. While at Rutgers, she was a 2011-12 BIG EAST All-Academic honoree and had seven top-10 finishes including three wins at the Bucknell Invitational, Rutgers Invitational and Lehigh Invitational

Barrett graduated from TCU with a bachelor of science degree in political science with a psychology of leadership emphasis. During her college career, she participated in the 2016 NCAA Emerging Leaders Seminar and was a SAAC team representative. She competed in 24 events and earned three top-10 finishes and four top-25 finishes. Her best finish was third place at the 2015 Big XII Championship.

Growing up in the Bay Area, Maxoutopoulos Barrett graduated from Foothill High School in 2011 and called Castlewood Country Club her golf home. She ranked 115th nationally in junior golf for the class of 2011 and placed third with partner Tom Kite at the 2010 First Tee Open at Pebble Beach.

Barrett and her husband, Chelso, were married in 2019, and have a yellow Labrador retriever named Tillie.

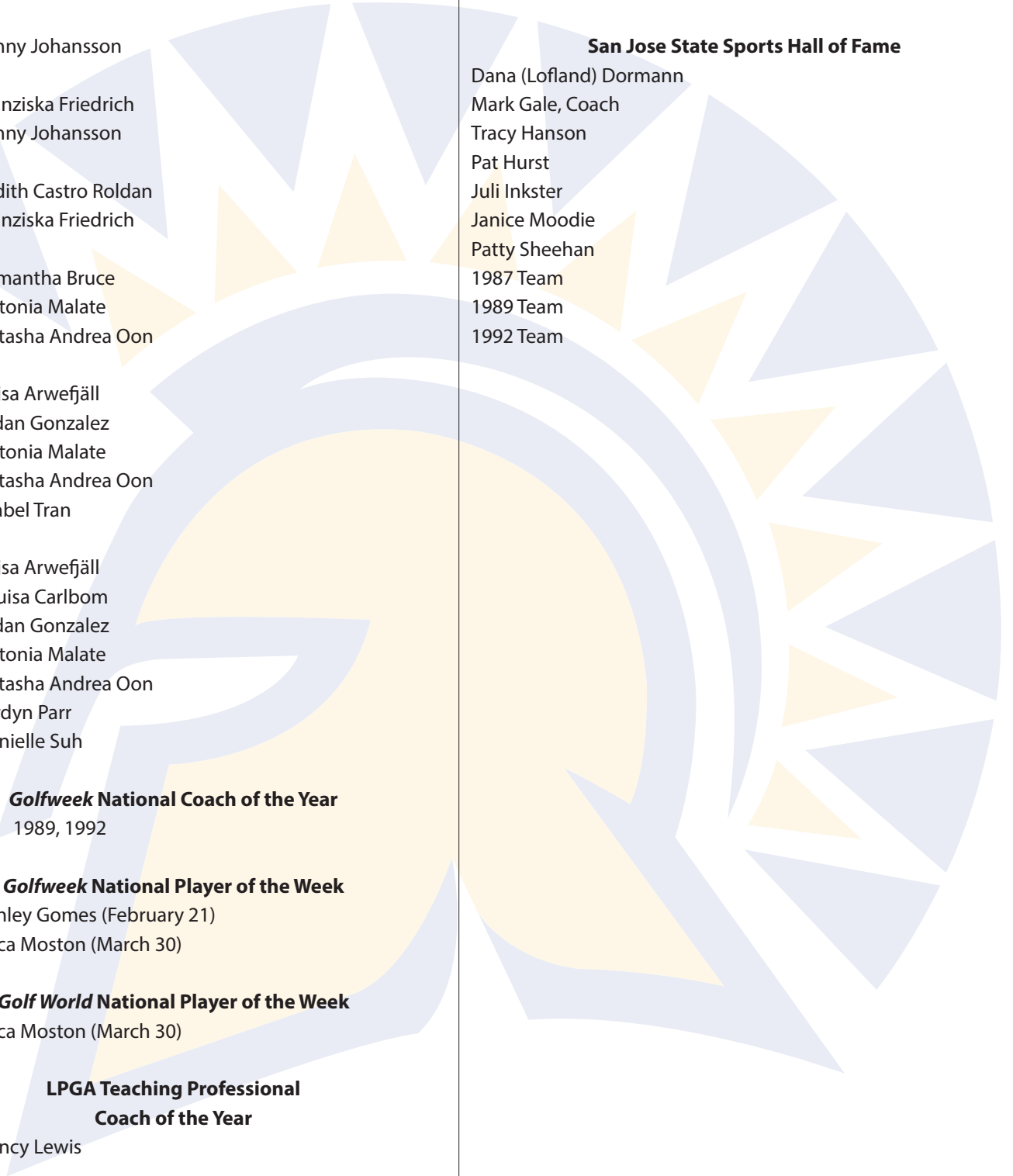
