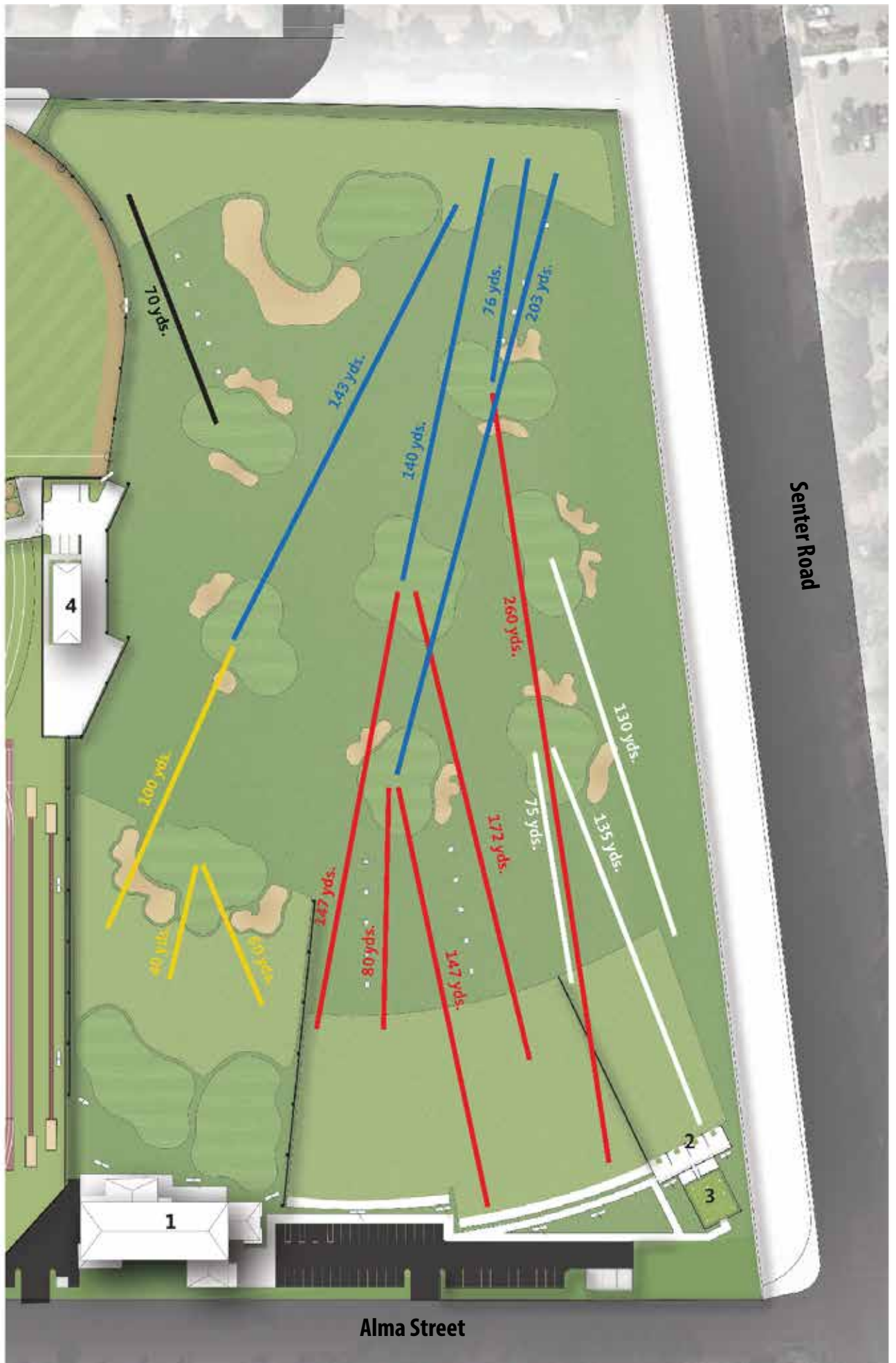

JOHN KENNADAY

Head Coach

11th Season

San José State, 1987

John Kennaday was appointed the San Jose State University men's golf coach in April 2005. His hire marked a return to his alma mater, where as a senior he was a 1987 All-American.

Kennaday is responsible for helping re-establish San Jose State's golf legacy. In the 2011-12 season, Kennaday became the first Spartans coach since 1982 to have a team win four times in the same season and the first since 1979 to win three consecutive tournaments.

A record setting day at the 2011 Dash Thomas Memorial (9/26-27) was just one of many highlights during the Spartans' fall run. Kennaday's team shattered the school record for a 36-hole score with a 542. Their 265 (-19) in the second round broke a 13-year school record for lowest 18-hole team score. The Spartans ended the season just as strong as they started, winning their first ever Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Championship and earning a second consecutive bid to NCAA Regionals. Senior Jay Myers also took medalist honors at the WAC Championship, making it two in a row for the Spartans after Mark Hubbard won it in 2011.

In the 2010-11 season, the Spartans received their first NCAA Regional Championship invitation in 14 years, posted a program-best second-place finish at the WAC Championship and placed in the top-half of the field in 10 of 12 tournaments.

Individually in 2010-11, Hubbard and Myers were first and second-team All-WAC players, respectively. It was the second time in three seasons the duo achieved the honor. During Kennaday's tenure, his players earned all-conference honors six times and academic All-WAC recognition 10 times. Hubbard is also the most recent of eight Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA) Scholar All-Americans which Kennaday has coached in his career.

Kennaday returned to San Jose State after spending seven seasons as the head coach for the Santa Clara University men's golf team. The once-dormant program became competitive in the West Coast Conference and regionally under Kennaday. In 2001, he was named the conference Coach of the Year.



Kennaday currently manages and directs The Western Intercollegiate, the longest running men's college golf tournament west of the Mississippi River. "The Western" is in its 70th year at the famed Pasatiempo Golf Course in Santa Cruz, Calif. He also oversees the Spartans' Friendraiser event that attracts Spartan alums and PGA Tour winners such as Ken Venturi, Roger Maltbie, Mark Wiebe and Arron Oberholser for a day of instruction and goodwill.

Besides his San Jose State duties, Kennaday is the personal coach for Oberholser, a two-time Spartan All-American, winner of the 2006 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and a former top-50 ranked player in the world. In 2011, Kennaday was named one of two current coaches serving on the NCAA Division I Men's Golf Committee.

As a player, Kennaday was a two-time Coast Conference Most Valuable Player at Monterey Peninsula College before transferring to San Jose State. He was a 1986 and 1987 first-team All-Pacific Coast Athletic Association pick, and helped the Spartans to a 12th-place tie at the 1987 NCAA Championships.

He went on to play professionally on the Canadian PGA, Nike and Golden State Tours for seven and a half years.

John and his wife, Christina, have two sons, Jack and Benjamin. The Kennaday family resides in San Jose.





MATT HOVAN

Assistant Coach

3rd Season

San José State, 2012

Matt Hovan was appointed assistant men's golf coach in June 2013.

Hovan uses his experience from a successful four-year (2009-12) men's golf career at SJSU to both mentor and challenge the current team during practices and in tournaments. He was on the bag alongside current Spartan junior Cody Blick when he qualified for and played in the U.S. Amateur Championship during the summer of 2014.

A second-team All-Western Athletic Conference performer in 2012, he helped the team three straight wins to open the year. The regular season was capped with a fifth place finish, as an individual, and a WAC Championship for the team. The Spartans went on to compete at the NCAA Regional at Stanford Golf Club in Palo Alto, Calif.

The low round of his collegiate career, a six-under 66, came in the opening round of the 2011 Amer Ari Invitational and the second round of the 2011 Dash Thomas Memorial. His round at the Amer Ari is tied for the third lowest score to par in a single round for a Spartan since 1997-98.

Hovan was a 2007 graduate of Serra High School in San Mateo, Calif. He led the team to the 2007 West Catholic Athletic League title as a senior, the 2006 Central Coast Section title as a junior and place third at the 2006 CIF State Championship.

As an amateur he competed in the stroke play portion of the 2008 and 2011 California State Amateur Championship.

Hovan graduated in 2012 with a degree in business management from San José State and resides in San Jose, Calif.

AT SAN JOSÉ STATE: In his fourth season as a Spartan... two-time PING All-West Region honoree (2014 and 2015)... two-time Mountain West All-Conference Honoree (2013-14 and 2014-15)... 2012-13 WAC Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and first team All-WAC.

2014-15: Ended a season for the record books with a 70.71 stroke average, the lowest on record in San José State men's golf history... selected All-Mountain West and PING All-West Region for the second consecutive year... selected and competed as an individual in his third NCAA Regional Championship in as many seasons as a Spartan... two victories moved him into second all-time at SJSU with four career wins behind only Arron Oberholser... set a new single-round school record in relation to par with a 10-under 62 in the final round on his way to victory at the Price's Give 'Em Five Invitational (10/24-26)... the 62 featured 10 birdies, no bogeys and gave him a new school-record 54-hole total of 198... second win of the season came at the Bandon Dunes Championship (3/13-14) where he shot 65-73-138 (-6)... played 22 rounds at par or better, tying Oberholser for the second most in a single season in program history behind Mark Hubbard's 23 rounds... finished tied for 9th at the Mountain West Championship (5/1-3) after firing a final-round 66 (-5)... runner-up finish at the Wolverine Intercollegiate (9/6-7), shooting 70-68-69-207 (-6)... third place at the Golfweek Conference Challenge (9/14-16), shooting 73-71-68-212 (-4)... opened The Goodwin (3/26-28) with back-to-back 66's and finished in a tie for ninth place... ended the season shooting 77-72-75-224 (+8) and in a tie for 40th place at the NCAA Regional Championship in Rancho Santa Fe, Calif.

2013-14: Averaged 71.13 strokes per round in 11 tournaments (32 rounds) which is the lowest average in records available since 1978-79... earned his first two collegiate wins; at the Itani Quality Homes Collegiate (9/9-10) and Wolverine Intercollegiate (9/16-17)... shot a career-best 64 in the second round of the Wolverine Intercollegiate tying Jay Myers and Arron Oberholser for the program's lowest round since the 1987-88 season... his seven-under par 64 at the Wolverine Intercollegiate is the second best round to par since 1997-98 season... shot back-to-back 203 tournament totals, his career-best at the Itani Quality Homes Collegiate and Wolverine Intercollegiate... in the Itani Quality Homes Collegiate he shot three rounds in the 60s for the first time in his college career... three of four starts in the fall resulted in two wins and a second place finish... six top-10 finishes including four in the top-4... 11 of his 32 rounds were in the 60s... 18 of his 32 rounds were at level par or better... finished in the top-25 in every regular-season tournament except the Alister MacKenzie Invitational (DQ) and The Goodwin (WD)... competed in the NCAA Regional Championship as an individual and finished tied for 39th.

2012-13: Averaged 72.85 strokes per round in 13 tournaments (39 rounds)... one of four golfers to play in each round on the season... eight top-20 and three top-10 finishes... best result was a tie for second at the Duck Invitational (3/25-26)... shot a team and Western Athletic Conference best 13 rounds under par... best single round was a 66 to open the U.S. Intercollegiate (3/28-30) among 10 rounds in the 60s... twice shot a season-best tournament score of 210, at the Amer Ari Invitational (2/6-8) and the Duck Invitational... 16 of his 39 rounds were shot at par or better... one of two freshman in the nation to earn his conference's Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and first team honors... competed in the NCAA Regional Championship as an individual and finished tied for 50th... Ken Venturi 1931-2013

A member of the San José State Sports Hall of Fame and accorded Legend status, Ken Venturi was a highly-acclaimed high school golfer from San Francisco who played for the 1951 through 1953 Spartan golf teams. As a San José State golfer he won the California State Amateur championship in 1951 and would repeat in 1956 before embarking on a career as a professional.

"Mr. Venturi was the epitome of what a gentleman golfer should be and he set that standard for this program from the very first day he set foot on the San José State campus. His high level of integrity both on and off the course is a model that every golfer who plays for San José State strives to achieve. His impact on the game he loved and on those who represented San José State cannot be understated," said current Spartans head golf coach John Kennaday.

"I've lost a dear friend and a mentor, but the world of golf has lost one of its greatest ambassadors. Kenny was truly a wonderful person and I will miss him everyday."

Mr. Venturi consistently assisted the San José State men's golf program with his "Day with Ken" and "Friend-raisers" fund-raising events. Becoming a better golfer and a better person from playing his game were at the core of his message.

Mr. Venturi joined the PGA Tour in 1956. He won 14 tournaments as a professional. His 1964 U.S. Open championship at Congressional Country Club in Bethesda, Md., continues to be remembered as one of the greatest victories in the history of the sport.

Mr. Venturi gained even more notoriety in his second career as the lead analyst for CBS Sports' coverage of the PGA Tour. His 35 years as a commentator is acknowledged as the longest tenure in broadcast sports history.

Besides his San José State honors, Mr. Venturi was inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame in the lifetime achievement category on May 6, 2013.

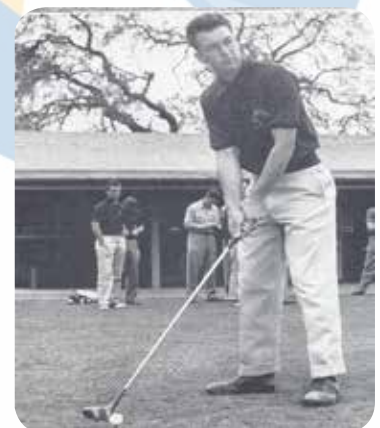

San José State, led by Bob Harris (middle), was the 1948 NCAA Men's Golf Champion. Harris earned Individual Medalist honors after finishing in first place in stroke play. Morgan Fottrell, Eli Bariteau, Ross Smith, Warren McCarty and Howard Verutti were also members of that championship team.

In 50 years, between 1947 and 1997, the Spartans made the NCAA Championship field 32 times. Including its NCAA Championship in 1948, San José State recorded five top-5 and 15 top-10 finishes in that time. In 1964, Terry Small became San José State's second men's golfer to win Individual Medalist honors in stroke play at the NCAA Championship.

The 1997 Spartans, under head coach Art Williams, are the program's most recent NCAA Championship contenders. The squad featured Ted Bakelis, Jim Beste, Steve Grier, Lucas Horrobin, Brandon Kearney, Joseph Lucidi, Chad McGowan, Aaron Oberholser and Trent Tessler. The team finished the Championship in 18th place and Oberholser earned a ninth-place finish for Individual Medalist.

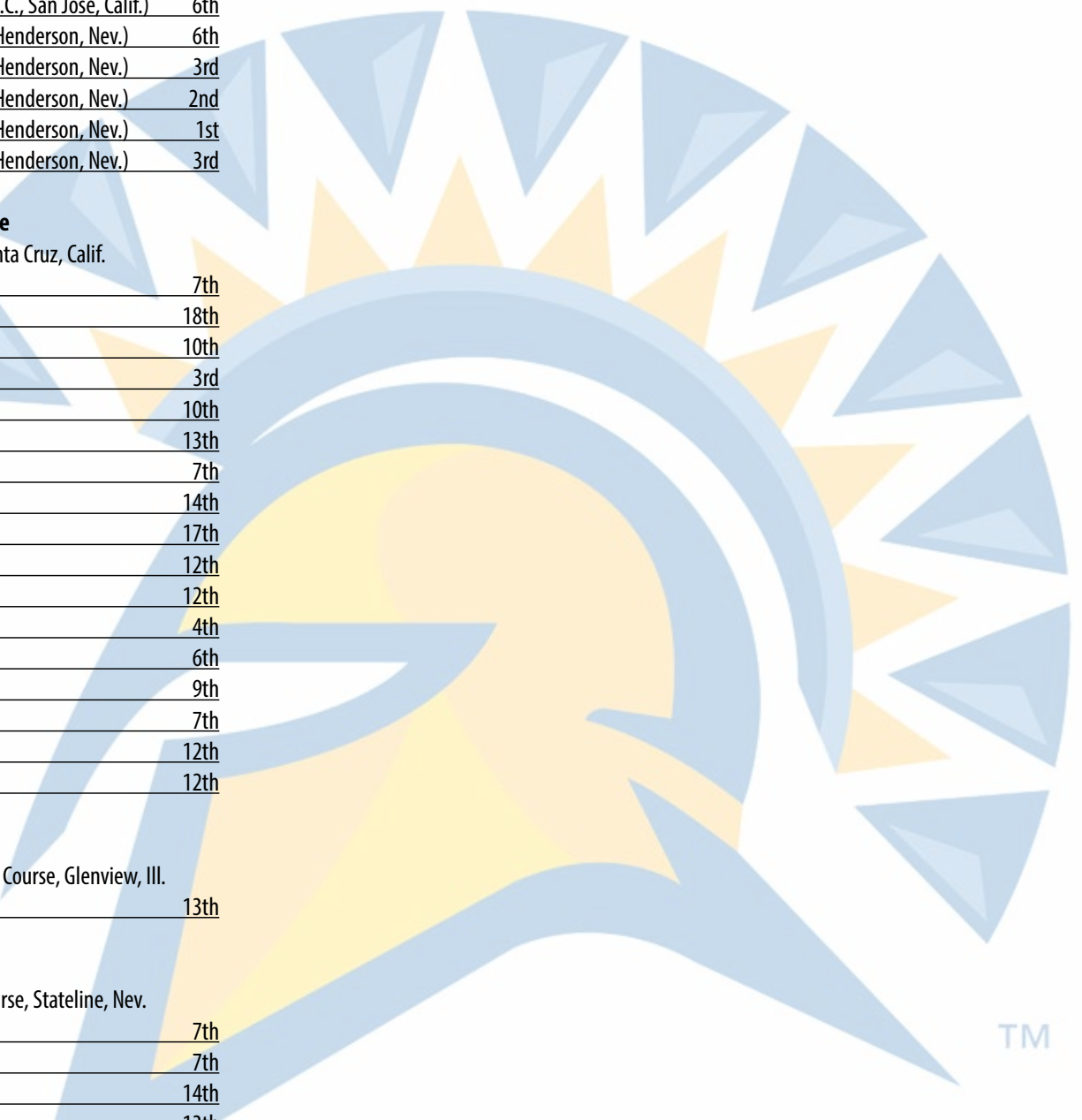

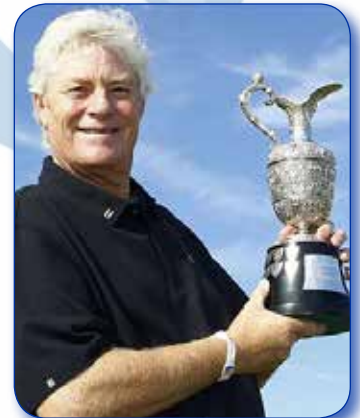

The Alister MacKenzie designed Pasatiempo Golf Club has been recognized as one of the top courses west of the Mississippi since it opened in 1929. Today, the 6,615-yard par 70 course provides a great challenge for the nation's top collegiate golfers year in and year out at the Western Intercollegiate. The Green Jacket symbolizes one of golf's most prestigious achievements, a Masters champion. Likewise, the Blue Jacket, awarded to the Western Intercollegiate champion, has been one of the most sought after awards in collegiate golf since its inception in 2008.

The Western Intercollegiate, hosted by San José State, has flourished since its inception as the Northern California Intercollegiate in 1947 and in 2015 celebrates its 69th year.

Early fields were comprised of area junior colleges, business colleges and four-year schools. The 1950's brought growth until a gigantic field of 35 teams and 210 golfers descended upon Pasatiempo in 1962.

"The Western" became a prestigious invitational with a limit of 25 teams beginning in 1968. Since then, the strength of the field has grown, drawing teams from as far away as Hawai'i and Duke to the Alister MacKenzie-designed course.

The Western has served as a springboard to the PGA Tour. The late-Bob Rosburg and Ken Venturi, Johnny Miller, Ron Cerrudo, John Lotz, Dave Stockton, Al Geiberger, Tom Watson, Roger Maltbie, Peter Jacobson, Bobby Clampett, Mark O'Meara, Duffy Waldorf, Tiger Woods, Jordan Spieth and Arron Oberholser have gone after the Western Intercollegiate championship during their college days.

The 50th Western Intercollegiate, held in 1996, became the first nationally-televised in-season collegiate tournament. In a stunning manner, San José State's Arron Oberholser overtook Tiger Woods of Stanford on the final four holes for the individual title.

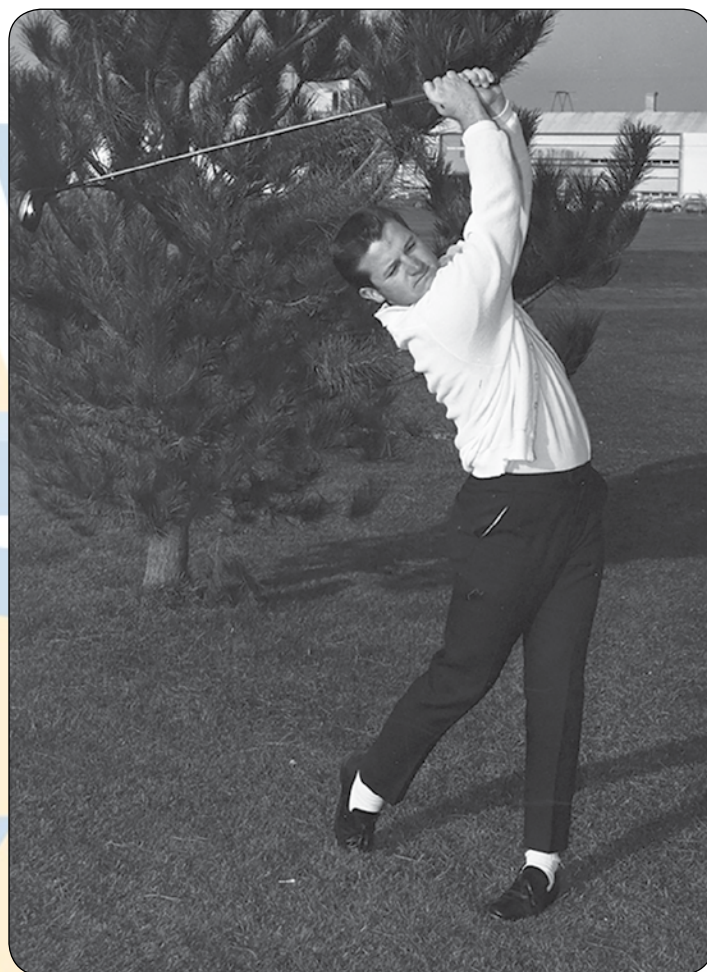
