# HEAD COACH JOHN KENNADAY



John Kennaday was appointed the San Jose State University men's golf coach in April 2005. His hire marked a return to his alma mater where he was a 1987 All-American as a senior.

Kennaday is responsible for helping re-establish San Jose State's golf legacy. Most recently, Kennaday became the first coach since 1979 to have a team win three tournaments in the same season as the Spartans won three out of five fall events in 2011.

A record setting day at the 2011 Dash Thomas Memorial (9/26-27) was just one of many highlights during the Spartans' fall run. Kennaday's team shattered a school record for 36-hole team score with a 542 and their 265 (-19) in the second round broke a 13-year-old school record for lowest 18-hole team score.

In the 2010-11 season, the Spartans received their first NCAA Regional Championship invitation in

14 years, posted a program-best second place finish at the Western Athletic Conference Championship and placed in the top-half of the field in 10 out of 12 tournaments.

Individually in 2010-11, the Spartans' Mark Hubbard and Jay Myers were first and second-team All-WAC players, respectively, for the second time in three seasons. During Kennaday's tenure, his players earned all-conference honors five times and academic All-WAC recognition 10 times. Hubbard is also the most recent of eight GCAA Scholar All-Americans which Kennaday has coached throughout his career.

Kennaday returned to San Jose State after spending six seasons as the head coach for the Santa Clara University men's golf team. The once-dormant program became competitive in the West Coast Conference and along the West Coast under Kennaday. In 2001, he was named the conference Coach of the Year.

Kennaday currently manages and directs the Western Intercollegiate tournament, the longest running men's college golf tournament west of the Mississippi River. The Western Intercollegiate now is in its 67th year at the famed Pasatiempo Golf Course in Santa Cruz, Calif. The San Jose State head coach also oversees the Spartans' Friendraiser for men's golf. The event attracts Spartan alums and PGA Tour winners such as Ken Venturi, Roger Maltbie, Mark Wiebe and Arron Oberholser for a day of instruction and goodwill.

Besides his San Jose State duties, Kennaday is the personal coach for Oberholser, a two-time Spartan All-American, winner of the 2006 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and a former top-50 ranked player in the world on the PGA Tour. Kennaday was named in 2011 as one of two current coaches serving on the NCAA Division I Men's Golf Committee.

# HEAD COACH JOHN KENNADAY

As a player, Kennaday was a two-time Coast Conference Most Valuable Player at Monterey Peninsula College before transferring to San Jose State. He was a 1986 and 1987 first-team All-Pacific Coast Athletic Association and was selected as an individual to compete in the 1986 NCAA Championship. Kennaday helped the Spartans to a 12th-place tie at the 1987 NCAA Championships.

He went on to play professionally on the Canadian PGA, Nike and Golden State Tours for seven and a half years.

His teaching career began in Milpitas, where he served as a teaching pro at the Mark Docak's Complete Golf School. He also was an assistant pro at the Spring Valley Golf Course.

John and his wife, Christina, have two sons, Jack and Benjamin. The Kennaday family resides in San Jose.

**AT SAN JOSE STATE:** In his fourth season with the Spartans....One career top-10 and four career top-25 placings...2010 Academic All-WAC honoree and SJSU Scholar-Athlete.

**2010-11 SEASON:** Played in eight tournaments...season stroke average of 76.63...A final-round 69 helped him to his best finish of 22nd in the Palouse Collegiate (9/14)...Had three under-par rounds to go along with two rounds at even par...Dipped into the 60's twice with a 69's in the opening round at the Alister Mackenzie Invitational and the third round at the Palouse Collegiate.

**2009-10 SEASON:** Averaged 76.75 strokes over 20 rounds on the year...Had a three round total of 226 at the Western Intercollegiate, good for 54th place as an individual entry...He shot a 232 and placed 77th at the Oregon Duck Invitational (3/22-23)...Also placed 77th at the Linger Longer Invitational in Greensboro, Ga., where he shot 239 over three rounds...Notched his first major college top-10 finish tying for eighth at the Palouse Collegiate with a 218 (+2)...Averaged 76.18 strokes per round...Had two rounds of one under par scoring during the Fall season.

**2008-09 SEASON:** Fifth on the team in stroke average at 74.89 strokes per round...Saw most of his action in the spring season playing in five of the seven tournaments...Best finish was his college debut in the Kauai Collegiate Invitational and tied for 19th place at 213 (-3)...Helped San Jose State set a team scoring record for 54 holes with his final round 67 (-5)...Team counted 13 of his 18 rounds...Five rounds total at or under par.

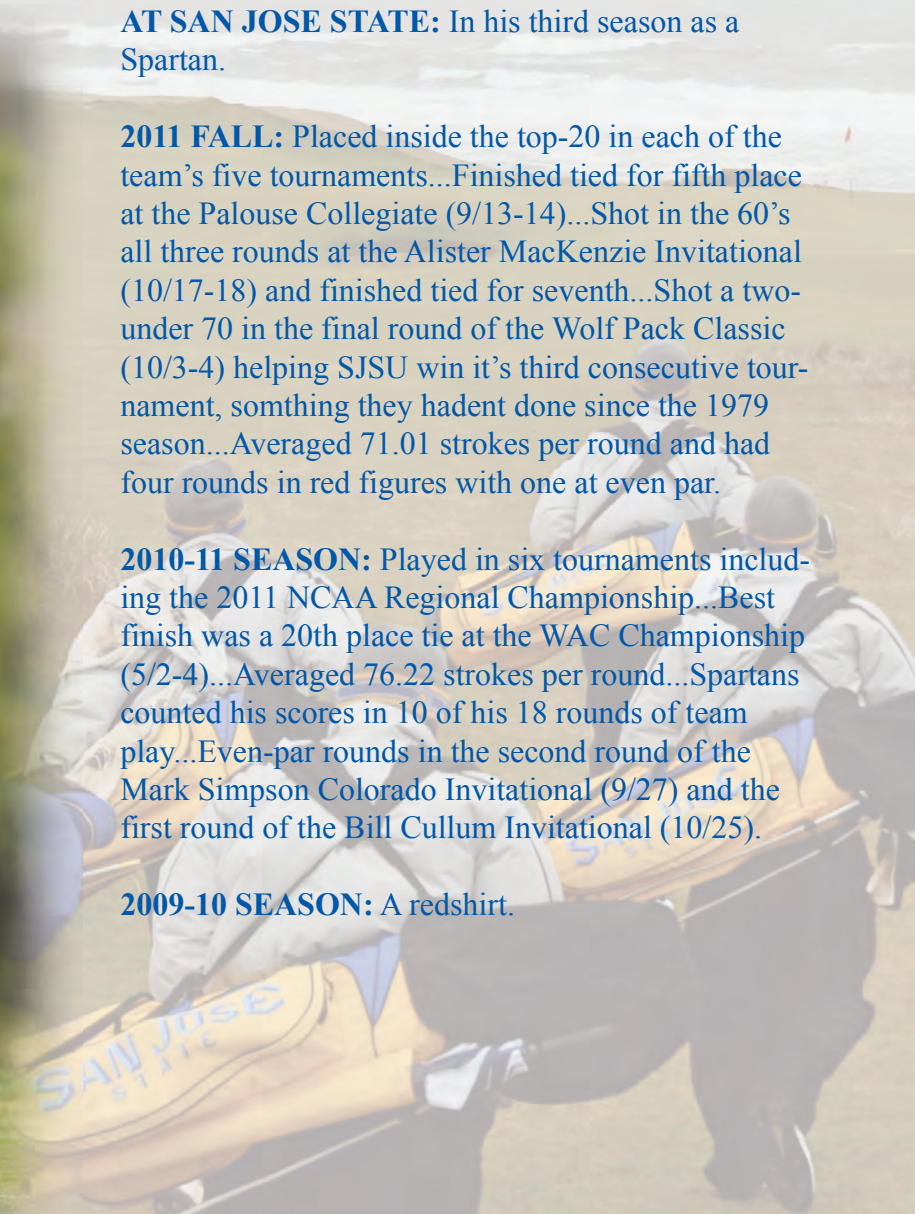

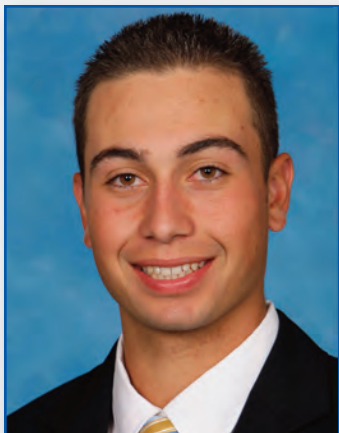

**AT SAN JOSE STATE:** In his fourth season with the Spartans...Has improved every season at the major college level...More than 4.00 strokes per round better as a junior than his freshman season...Five career top-five finishes and ten total top-20 results in 26 tournaments...Five 54-hole under-par tournament scores...20 under par scores and three at level par in 75 rounds of competition...Single-round career best six-under 66 in the first-round of the 21st annual Amer Ari Invitational (2/2/11).

# THE WESTERN INTERCOLLEGIATE



The Western Intercollegiate, hosted by San Jose State, has flourished since its inception as the Northern California Intercollegiates in 1947 and is in its 66th year in 2012.

Early on, area junior colleges, business colleges and four-year schools comprised the fields. The 50's brought inevitable growth until a gigantic field of 35 teams and 210 golfers descended upon Pasatiempo in 1962.

The Western became a prestigious invitational with a limit of 25 teams beginning in 1968. Since then, the strength of the field has grown to where teams from Hawaii to Duke venture to the Alister MacKenzie-designed course.

These championships have served as a springboard to the PGA Tour. The late-Bob Rosburg, Ken Venturi, Johnny Miller, Ron Cerrudo, John Lotz, Dave Stockton, Al Geiberger, Tom Watson, Roger Maltbie, Peter Jacobson, Bobby Clampett, Mark O'Meara, Duffy Waldorf, Tiger Woods and Arron Oberholser have gone after the Western Intercollegiate championship during their college days.

The 50th Western Intercollegiate, held in 1996, became the first nationally-televised in-season collegiate tournament - emphasizing the longest-running tournament west of the Mississippi River. In a stunning manner, San Jose State's Arron Oberholser overtook Tiger Woods of Stanford on the final four holes for the individual title.
