San José State-New Mexico Postgame Notes

San José State's 81-80 victory marks the program's first-ever win at New Mexico.

The Spartans improved to 3-0 in conference play for the first time since the 2015-16 season (last 4-0 start was 2005-06).

Guard Megan Anderson made six three-pointers on Wednesday, setting a single-game season high while matching her career-high for made three-pointers.

SJSU rallied from a 15-point deficit to earn the victory. The team now owns two of the conference's biggest comeback wins this season after erasing a 14-point deficit to beat Buffalo earlier this year.

San José State exploded for 35 points in the third quarter, marking its second 35-point third quarter in the last 18 days.

The Spartans had five players finish the night scoring in double figures. Anderson led the way with 20 points and was followed by Ayzhiana Basallo (19), Danae Marquez (14), Fieme'a Hafoka (13) and Raziya Potter (12).

San José State now has nine wins through 14 games, marking the quickest the program has reached the nine-win plateau since the 2004-05 season.
