### **San José State-Colorado State Postgame Notes**

San José State's 58-53 victory marks the team's fourth straight road win to start conference play. This is the program's first team to accomplish that feat since the 1978-79 campaign, when the Spartans won at San Francisco, Santa Clara, Stanford and Fresno State in NorPac action.

The Spartans are now 5-1 in Mountain West play, matching the program's best six-game start to conference play since the 1981-82 season.

SJSU improved to 2-9 all-time at Colorado State with both victories coming in the last two seasons (won 78-70 last year).

San José State now owns six victories this season after trailing at halftime (were down 31-22 at half).

Sophomore Ayzhiana Basallo led all scorers with 26 points in the victory. The point guard entered the day leading the Mountain West in scoring.

Sophomore Raziya Potter scored a career-high 19 points and tallied her second career double-double in the win.

San José State proved it could win a slower type of ballgame in its victory on Saturday. Its 58 points is the program's fewest scored in a road victory since Jan. 5, 2012 (57-45 at Utah Valley).
