Utah State-San José State Postgame Notes

San José State's 76-38 victory gives the team its 17th victory of the year, marking the program's best single-season win turnaround in school history (+11).

The 38-point win is the program's largest victory in a conference game since Jan. 11, 1980 (70-25 vs. Santa Clara).

The 38 points allowed is the program's fewest in a game since Feb. 18, 2006 (58-35 vs. New Mexico State).

SJSU has now won three straight games over Utah State.

The victory gave the program its third regular-season sweep of the Aggies in school history.

Sophomore Ayzhiana Basallo led all scorers with 18 points in the win. Basallo entered the day as the Mountain West's leading scorer.

The Spartans allowed just four points in the game's second quarter and six in the third, marking the team's fourth and fifth single-digit defensive quarters of the year.

Head coach Jamie Craighead earned career victory No. 125 with the win.

The 17th victory marks a season-high for San José State in the Craighead era. It also gave the team its 11th conference win, matching the program's record for league victories under Craighead.
