SPARTANS HEADED TO ATHENS FOR REGIONAL ACTION: For the 27th time in school history, the ninth-ranked San José State women's golf team has been selected to play at an NCAA Regional. The Spartans are the No. 2 seed at the Athens Regional to be played at the University of Georgia Golf Course in Athens, Ga., May 8-10.

The six regions feature 12 teams and six individuals competing over 54 holes. The top-five teams and top individual, not on an advancing team, in each region will advance to the NCAA Championships, May 19-24, at Grayhawk Golf Club in Scottsdale, Ariz.

The other five regionals will be played in Pullman, Wash. (Palouse Ridge Golf Club), West Field, Ind. (The Club at Chatham Hills Golf Course), Raleigh, N.C. (Lonnie Poole Golf Course), San Antonio, Texas (TPC San Antonio) and Palm Beach Gardens, Fla. (PGA National Resort).

The Athens Regional will be played at the University of Georgia Golf Course in Athens, Georgia with Georgia serving as the host institution. Conference automatic qualifiers are indicated in parenthesis next to the institution.

TEE TIMES: Tee times for the first round begin at 8 a.m. EDT/5 a.m. PDT with the Spartans starting on the 1st tee with No. 1 South Carolina and No. 3 Ole Miss at that time. Tee times for the second and third rounds will be determined by the results after each round.

SPARTAN LINEUP: San José State will travel the same lineup that has played in the past six tournaments - **Kajsa Arwefjäll, Antonia Malate, Lucia Lopez Ortega, Louisa Carlbom and Rebecca Gyllner.** **Jordyn Parr** is the alternate.

SAN JOSE STATE AT THE REGIONALS: The Spartans are making their 27th regional appearance since 1993. Last year, the team won their third regional team title in school history with the three-shot win over Virginia at the 2022 NCAA Ann Arbor Regional. The other two regional titles came in 1994 in Albuquerque and 1995 in Tucson. The team has finished second twice - 1996 & 2000.

SPARTAN COACHING STAFF: Head coach **Dana Dormann** is in her fifth year at the helm of the women's program and her 19th season affiliated with the San José State golf program. Named the head coach of the program in June of 2018, she has twice been honored by her peers as the Mountain West Coach of the Year, 2019 and 2022, and was Golfweek Coach of the Year after the program's very successful 2021-22 season.

Kortnie Barrett is in her third year as the assistant coach for the Spartan program. She joined the program in January of 2021 and made an immediate impact on the team. She took a break from the Spartans mid-fall season as Kortnie and her husband, Chelso, welcomed daughter Blair Darling to the world in October. Blair can be seen at the course with her beautiful smile

AUGUSTA NATIONAL WOMEN'S AMATEUR: Two Spartans played at the 2023 Augusta National Women's Amateur (ANWA). **Antonia Malate** played at the tournament for the second consecutive year. She finished tied for 20th at 4-over 220. She shot 70-73-77 for her three rounds. Malate was bogey free for the first 14 holes of the final round at the Augusta National Golf Club with 13 pars and a birdie on the fifth hole.

Kajsa Arwefjäll received her first invitation to the ANWA this year, the second Spartan to play at the tournament. She finished at 6-over 150 for her two rounds, shooting 74-76 in her first appearance.

She made the cut after shooting 75-74 in the first two rounds played at the Champions Retreat Golf Club. Malate was the first San José State women's golfer to ever compete at the ANWA.

YOU HAVE A 64, AND YOU HAVE A 64: After no one shooting a round lower than 65 prior to the season, twice this year a Spartan has recorded a 64 in a round for the Spartans. **Kajsa Arwefjäll** started the 2022-23 season by shooting a 64 in the final round of the USF Intercollegiate to win the tournament. She had a clean card for the round with seven birdies and 11 pars.

Not to be outdone by her teammate, **Antonia Malate** went out in the next tournament and shot a 64 in the second round at the Illini Women's Invitational. She too had a clean card with her 64, making eight birdies and 10 pars, shooting a 6-under 30 over the back nine at Medinah Country Club.

WINNER, WINNER, TWO CHICKEN DINNERS: The Spartans have two tournament wins this season and have finished in the top-five in eight of the nine tournaments played. They started the fall season by winning the USF Intercollegiate at The Olympic Club in San Francisco, shooting a 4-under 848. The team then finished the fall season by winning the 20th Annual Landfall Tradition with a 22-under 842.

TWO INDIVIDUAL TITLES: Two Spartans won their first collegiate tournament titles this fall as well. **Kajsa Arwefjäll** won the USF Intercollegiate by shooting an 11-under 202 (66-72-64-202). **Louisa Carlbom** tied for first at the Landfall Tradition with a 10-under 206 (67-70-69-206).

ARNOLD PALMER CUP SELECTION: For the second consecutive year, San José State women's golfer **Antonia Malate** has been selected to Arnold Palmer Cup team representing the United States at matches which will be hosted by the Laurel Valley Golf Club, in Ligonier, Pa., June 8-10, 2023.

Malate was one of six ranking women's qualifiers for the United States team. She is coming off a sixth-place finish at the Mountain West Championship and has eight top-25 finishes this season. Malate also tied for 20th at this year's Augusta National Women's Amateur. Last year, Malate went 2-1-1 at the 2022 Palmer Cup in Switzerland.

Another familiar face to Spartan fans will be there as assistant coach **Kortnie Maxotopoulos Barrett** will serve as one of the two United States assistant coaches.

The Arnold Palmer Cup is a Ryder Cup-style tournament featuring the top men's and women's university/college golfers matching the United States against a team of International players, the only major tournament which features men and women playing side-by-side as partners.

THREE SPARTANS IN THE TOP-10 AT MW CHAMPS: Three Spartans finished in the top-10, led by **Kajsa Arweffjäll** who was second at 5-under par, at the 2023 Mountain West Championship played at the Mission Hills Country Club in Rancho Mirage, Calif., in April

Arweffjäll shot a 2-under 70 in the final round to finish at 211 for the tournament (70-71-70). She finished the three rounds leading the field in par-4 scoring at -5.

Antonia Malate tied for sixth at 3-under 213 (68-72-73), her best finish at the championship in four tries. She had a clean card through 13 holes in the final round.

Lucia Lopez Ortega tied for ninth at 2-under 214 (75-69-70-214). She made three birdies and 14 pars in the finals round.

SPARTANS NEARING RECORDS: This year's team has tied the record for the most rounds under par with 57, matching the 2021-22 team. The Spartans are just 11 rounds away from the school record for total rounds of par or better, set by last year's team at 77. A complete listing is found on page 32.

SCHOOL STROKE AVERAGE: With their stroke averages this season, three Spartans have vaulted themselves into the top-10 in San José State history in scoring average for a season. Kajsa Arweffjäll is poised to become the second Spartan to record a stroke average below 71 as she currently stands at 70.67. She has the chance to break the record of 70.71 set by **Natasha Andrea Oon** last season. Antonia Malate is currently fourth at 71.44, followed by Lucia Lopez Ortega at 72.04.

Two-time Mountain West Women's Golf Coach of the Year



No stranger to NCAA Championship competition, San José State women's golf coach Dana Dormann is in her fifth season at the helm of the Spartan program. The former Spartan All-American and San José State Sports Hall of Fame honoree was named to lead the program in June of 2018.

The 2022 Mountain West Coach of the Year led the San José State women's golf program back to national prominence with the Spartans ranked in the top-10 for much of the 2021-22 season. The Spartans finished either first or second in eight of the 10 tournaments played. San José State won its first Mountain West Women's Golf Championship in April of 2022, winning by a record 30 shots over their nearest competitor. The team won four tournaments in the spring of 2021 including twice over top-ranked Stanford at the Lamkin Invitational and the Juli Inkster at Meadow Club Invitational. The Spartans broke the school record for most under par & par rounds recorded in a season at 64.

For all their successes in 2021-22, the Spartans swept the conference awards as Natasha Andrea Oon was the MW Player of the Year, Lucia Lopez Ortega the MW Freshman of the Year and those two, along with Kajsa Arweffjäll and Antonia Malate were selected to the All-MW first team.

Throughout the previous three seasons, Dormann navigated the program through an early shut down of the season in 2020 due to COVID-19, to a spring-only season in 2021. She coached Arweffjäll to an appearance at the NCAA National Championship where she finished tied for 36th in the individual standings.

In her first season (2018-19), Dormann and the Spartans won two tournaments - Minnesota Invitational, and The Gold Rush. The Spartans advanced to the 2019 NCAA Championships at the Blessings Golf Course where the team finished 19th. She coached the top-two golfers in the Mountain West - Abigail Arevalo, the 2018-19 MW Women's Golfer of the Year, and Oon, the 2018-19 MW Women's Golf Freshman of the Year. Dormann was honored as the 2018-19 MW Women's Golf Coach of the Year.

Dormann was the associate head coach and assistant coach for the Spartan program for 13-plus seasons. She mentored many players during those years including All-American and conference Player of the Year winners Erica Moston and My Leander. Dormann helped coach the Spartans to berths at the NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championships - 2013 in Athens, Ga., and 2010 in Wilmington, N.C.

In 2011, Dormann was named the Coach of the Year for the Western Section, as selected by the LPGA Teaching and Club Professional membership. She was one of five collegiate coaches selected for the award.

Dormann has been successful in golf from a young age, winning the 1985 U.S. Junior and Junior World championships to becoming a three-time All-American for the Spartans. She played on 1985 through 1988 teams, was a member of the 1987 NCAA Championship team, won four tournaments and was the 1987 Pacific Coast Athletic Association Player of the Year. Dormann was also an assistant coach for the 1989 NCAA Championship team.

Professionally, she played 10 years on the LPGA Tour, winning the 1992 Las Vegas LPGA International and the 1993 McCall's LPGA Classic. Dormann is a member of the Golf Coaches Association of America Hall of Fame.

Still playing competitively, Dormann earned medalist honors by shooting a three-under 68 to qualify for the inaugural 2018 U.S. Senior Women's Open in Chicago. Dormann was the only player under par at the qualifier on the par-71 Ocean Course at San Francisco's Olympic Club. She qualified for the 2019 U.S. Senior Women's Open after winning the Stanford qualifier with an even-par 71. Dormann is no stranger to USGA events as she played in 14 U.S. Women's Open Championships.

Dana and her husband, John, are the proud parents of sons William and Jason.



Kortnie Barrett

Assistant Head Coach

Kortnie Maxoutopoulos Barrett joined the Spartan program as an assistant coach in January of 2021.

Barrett had a whirlwind beginning to her first five months as a Spartan in 2021. The team finished in the top-four in the first three tournaments played. She helped coach Kajsa Arewfjäll to the 2021 NCAA Championships where she tied for 36th after a fifth-place finish at the NCAA Stanford Regional. Academically, the team posted one of the highest semester grade point averages in school history.

Prior to San José State, Barrett spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Mississippi State where she helped the 2019 team get back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in four seasons. She was responsible for all team travel and assisted in recruiting top talent to the school. The school's Golfstat ranking improved from 68 when she started to 22 in the nation this past school year.

Before Starkville, Barrett spent one season on the staff at Long Beach State. She helped coach the team to the Big West Conference Championship, UC Irvine Invitational title and the program's first NCAA Regional bid in almost 10 years. The program jumped 41 spots in the Golfstat ranks during the one season she coached the 49ers.

Barrett received her master's degree in public & non-profit administration from Georgia Southern University in 2017 where she spent two years as the graduate assistant coach for their inaugural women's golf program.

Playing as the former Kortnie Maxoutopoulos, she competed for three seasons at TCU after playing at Rutgers her freshman year. While at Rutgers, she was a 2011-12 BIG EAST All-Academic honoree and had seven top-10 finishes including three wins at the Bucknell Invitational, Rutgers Invitational and Lehigh Invitational

Barrett graduated from TCU with a bachelor of science degree in political science with a psychology of leadership emphasis. During her college career, she participated in the 2016 NCAA Emerging Leaders Seminar and was a SAAC team representative. She competed in 24 events and earned three top-10 finishes and four top-25 finishes. Her best finish was third place at the 2015 Big XII Championship.

Growing up in the Bay Area, Maxoutopoulos Barrett graduated from Foothill High School in 2011 and called Castlewood Country Club her golf home. She ranked 115th nationally in junior golf for the class of 2011 and placed third with partner Tom Kite at the 2010 First Tee Open at Pebble Beach.

Barrett and her husband, Chelso, were married in 2019, welcomed daughter, Blair Darling, on October 23 have a yellow Labrador retriever named Tillie.

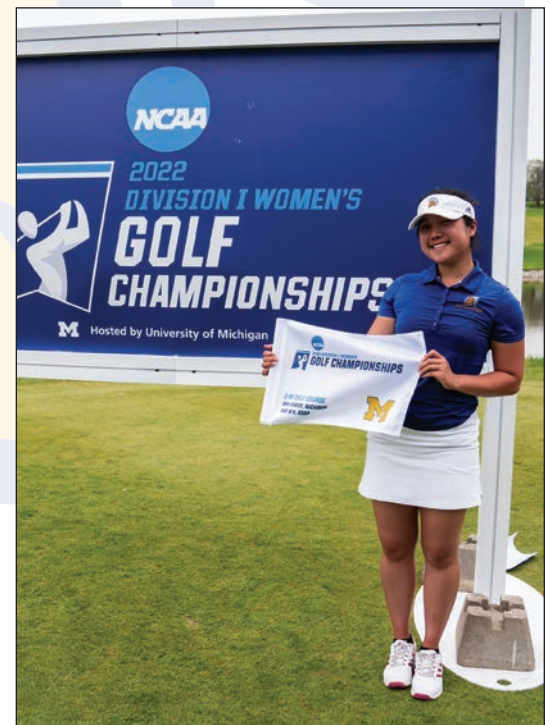
