• Utah State is 54-21 all-time against San José State, representing the sixth-longest rivalry in school history. The Aggies have won the last 15 contests and 36 of the last 40 match-ups in the series. USU is 17-13 all-time against the Spartans on the road.

• Utah State is 115-99 in road games under head coach **Stew Morrill**. The Aggies are currently 5-6 on the road this season and 3-3 in Mountain West road games, tying the most road victories by any team in the MW in conference play.

• Head coach **Stew Morrill** is 25-1 all-time against San José State, including a 21-1 record at the helm of Utah State.

• Utah State is 83-38 during the month of February under head coach **Stew Morrill**, which includes a 34-28 record on the road.

• Utah State has an overall record of 1,530-1,506 (.592) in its 2,586 games played.

PRESEASON POLL

Utah State men's basketball team has been selected 10th in the 2014-15 Mountain West Preseason Media Poll.

Defending 2013-14 champion San Diego State was a near unanimous pick to win the conference after garnering 34 of 35 first-place votes and 383 points. Boise State followed with one first-place vote and 275 points, picked just ahead of New Mexico and UNLV with 270 and 269 points, respectively.

Colorado State, Wyoming and Fresno State made up the middle of the group after being picked fifth, sixth and seventh with 258, 256 and 232 points, respectively. Nevada (126) and Air Force (102) were picked ahead of the Aggies (98) in eighth and ninth and San José State rounded out the poll in 11th with 41 points.

LAST RODEO FOR A TRUE AGGIE

Veteran head coach **Stew Morrill** announced on Jan. 9 that the 2014-15 season will be his last.

LOOKING AT UTAH STATE

Utah State has posted back-to-back victories with wins at New Mexico (63-60) and at home against Nevada (75-62). The Aggies are currently 14-10 on the year and 7-5 in league play.

USU has been led offensively by sophomore wing **Jalen Moore** with 15.5 points per game (No. 7 in the MW) and a team-best 6.8 rebounds per game (No. 7 in the MW). He is followed by redshirt freshman forward **David Collette** with 13.0 points per game (No. 10 in the MW), shooting 56.9 percent (128-of-225) from the court which is currently No. 3 in the Mountain West. Moore and Collette make up one of just two pair of teammates in the conference that each rank in the top-10 of the league in scoring.

Junior guard **Chris Smith** rounds out Utah State's double digit scorers, averaging 11.7 per game. Smith also leads USU with a 45.5 percent (45-of-99) clip from behind the 3-point line, No. 4 in the MW.

As a team, Utah State is shooting 44.2 percent (542-of-1,227) from the field, 39.1 percent (173-of-442) from behind the 3-point line and 65.3 percent (301-of-461) from the free throw line while averaging 64.9 points per game.

LAST TIME OUT

LOGAN, Utah - Utah State men's basketball shot a season-high 59.5 percent (25-of-42) from the floor, including a first half season-high of 63.6 percent (14-of-22) to post a 75-62 victory over Nevada on Tuesday night. The win moves the Aggies to 14-10 on the year and 7-5 in the Mountain West, while the Wolf Pack slip to 7-16 and 3-8 with the loss.

The win wrapped up an Aggie sweep of the Wolf Pack this season and ran a winning streak against Nevada to three straight games.

Utah State opened the contest with 7-0 run with the entire total coming from sophomore wing Jalen Moore on a perfect 3-for-3 clip from the field. The Aggies never lost the lead over the first 20 minutes with the Wolf Pack only coming as close as one in the opening frame. Utah State's advantage grew to as much as 11, 42-31, on a 3-point bucket by freshman guard Julion Pearre with 38 seconds on the clock. A layup by Nevada's Tyron Criswell left the scored at 42-33 going into halftime.

Utah State's 42 points in the opening stanza marked a season high for the Aggies and the home side's margin ballooned to 19 points, 58-39, on a Moore 3-pointer with 14:52 to play in the second half. USU's offense stalled over the next four minutes, allowing the Wolf Pack to get back to within 10, 59-49, but it was as close as the visitors came in the final half. Junior guard Chris Smith converted a pair of free throws with two minutes remaining to punctuate the game, 75-62, and the Aggie victory.

Smith led all scorers with 18 points, where he was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, scoring in double figures for 14th time this season. He was followed closely by Moore with 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting (.778) in addition to pulling down three rebounds and adding two assists and two blocks. Redshirt freshman forward David Collette led the Aggies on the glass with six rebounds and added 14 points, three blocks, two steals and one assists with Pearre rounding out those in double figures with 12 points.

Nevada was led by freshman guard Eric Cooper Jr. with 14 points and he was followed by Criswell with 12 and junior forward with 10 points and a team-high seven rebounds. The Wolf Pack finished the game shooting 41.4 percent (23-of-56) from the floor, 42.9 percent (6-of-14) from long range and 71.4 percent (10-of-14) from the free throw line.

Utah State shot a season-high 59.5 percent (25-of-42) which is the highest total since 2013 when the Aggies shot 59.6 percent (28-of-47) at Idaho State on Jan. 31, 2013. USU's total included a 56.3 percent (9-of-16) performance from behind the 3-point line with the team also finding success at the free throw line, converting 72.7 percent (16-of-22).

The win marked the 200th conference victory for head coach Stew Morrill at Utah State and put him within two victories of claiming 400 at the helm in Logan.

(25-42), which is its highest shooting percentage since shooting 59.6 percent (28-47) at Idaho on Jan. 31, 2013, a span of 65 games. * Utah State has now shot at least 50 percent from the field twice this year, also doing so against Air Force (.542). USU also shot 63.6 percent from the field (14-22) in the first-half, which is a season-high and its second-highest shooting percentage in any half this year trailing the Illinois State (11/16/14) game when USU shot 70.0 percent (14-20) in the second half. * Utah State shot 56.3 percent from three-point range (9-16), which is its second-high shooting percentage from behind the arc this year trailing the 56.5 percent (13-23) it shot against Air Force (1/7/15). Overall, it is the second time this year USU has shot at least 50 percent from behind the arc. * Utah State's 16 made free throws and 22 free throw attempts are its most in its last five games. In fact, USU was 9-of-12 from the free throw line in the first half, as its nine made free throws in the first-half were its most in its last five games. * Utah State's 20 rebounds is a season-low as its previous season-low was 21 rebounds at Mississippi State (11/22/14). USU also had just three offensive rebounds, which is tied for its second fewest in a game this year, trailing its two offensive rebounds against CS Bakersfield (12/18/14). * Utah State's six turnovers are tied for its season-low, also committing six turnovers at UC Davis (11/26/14). Overall, it is the 11th time this year that USU has recorded single-digit turnovers, including its third-straight game. On the season, USU is 8-3 when committing single-digit turnovers. * Utah State had four players score in double-figures for the third-straight game and for the ninth time this year. USU is now 5-4 on the season when it has four double-figure scorers. * Utah State's nine blocks are its second-most in a game this year behind its 10 blocks at Utah Valley (12/13/14). In all, USU has now recorded five-plus blocks for the 12th time this year.

Nevada at Utah State Player Notes

* Junior guard Chris Smith scored in double-figures for the 14th time this year and in his career with his 18 points. * Sophomore wing Jalen

Moore scored in double-figures for the 22nd time this year and the 26th time in his career with his 17 points. * Redshirt freshman forward David Collette scored in double-figures for the 16th time this year and in his career with his 14 points. Collette also had three blocked shots in the game, marking the eighth time this year he has recorded at least three blocked shots in a contest. With his three blocked shots, Collette now has 51 blocks this season to rank fourth all-time in school history. * Freshman guard Julion Pearre scored in double-figures for the fifth time this year and in his career with his 12 points. * Freshman center Elston Jones scored a career-high five points and had a career-best three blocked shots. * Junior guard Darius Perkins had six assists and has now recorded six assists in each of his last two games. Overall, Perkins has dished out at least five assists in five different games this year, including three of his last five.

SCOUTING SAN JOSÉ STATE

San José State is in the midst of a 14-game losing streak, having picked up its last victory on Dec. 9 against St. Katherine. The Spartans are 2-22 on the year, including an 0-12 mark in the Mountain West.

SJSU has been led in conference play by sophomore guard Rashad Muhammad and senior forward Jaleel Williams with 14.4 and 10.5 points per game, respectively. Sophomore forward Brandon Mitchell has paced the team on the glass with 5.9 rebounds per game. The Spartans have been without two of their leading scorers for most of the year in junior guard Jordan Baker (10.6 ppg) and junior forward Frank Rogers (10.4 ppg) because of suspensions.

As a team, San José State has shot 35.5 percent (441-of-1,241) from the floor, 28.0 percent (144-of-514) from behind the 3-point line and 64.8 percent (260-of-401) from the free throw line while scoring 53.6 points per game, last in the MW. SJSU opponents have averaged 69.3 points per game while shooting 45.8 percent (582-of-1,271) from the

floor and 38.7 percent (170-of-439) from behind the 3-point line, all last in the Mountain West. In addition, Spartan foes have shot 66.2 percent (329-of-497) from the free throw line.

Head coach **Dave Wojcik** is in his second year with the program, leading the Spartans to an overall mark of 9-46 over that span.

LAST TIME AGAINST SAN JOSÉ STATE

LOGAN, Utah - Utah State men's basketball used a 27-2 first-half run to pull away from a depleted San José State squad that only dressed seven players on Dec. 31, 2014 for a 61-33 victory in the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. The win continued a streak of 25 straight home opening conference wins and moved the Aggies to 8-5 on the year and 1-0 in the Mountain West. The win also continued a 15-game winning streak against the Spartans, as SJSU dropped to 2-11 and 0-1 in conference with the loss.

In all, 13 players appeared in the game for USU with nine different Aggies scoring. Sophomore wing Jalen Moore led all scorers with 19 points and added a career-high tying 11 rebounds for his second career double-double, shooting 6-of-8 from the floor, including a career-high four 3-pointers. Moore's scoring total marked the 11th consecutive game in double digits which is the longest streak since Jarred Shaw had 13 consecutive games in double digits during the 2012-13 season.

Junior guard Chris Smith joined Moore in double figures with 14 points, going 5-of-7 from the floor, 2-for-4 from long range and a perfect 2-for-2 from the free throw line. For the night, Utah State shot 46.7 percent (21-of-45) from the floor, including a season-high 11 3-point buckets where the team shot 50 percent (11-of-22). The Aggies struggled at the free throw line, shooting a season-low 40 percent (8-of-20) after recording a season-high 88.9 percent (16-of-18) against Wayland Baptist over the weekend.

San José State was held without a double-digit scorer as the Spartans were led by freshman forward Ryan Singer and freshman guard Darryl Gaynor II with eight points apiece. SJSU shot 20 percent (12-of-60) from the floor which is the lowest percentage by a Utah State opponent this year and lowest since a 17.9 percent (10-of-56) showing by Louisiana Tech in the 2010-11 season. The total by the Spartans included a 21.4-percent (6-of-28) clip from long range as SJSU also shot 37.5 percent (3-of-8) from the free throw line.

LAST TIME AGAINST SAN JOSÉ STATE IN SAN JOSÉ

Utah State men's basketball earned head coach Stew Morrill's 600th career win with a 75-58 spearing of the Spartans of San Jose State on March 1, 2014 at SJSU's Event Center.

Senior guard/forward Spencer Butterfield netted a career-high six three-pointers on the way to a game-best 22 points. Fellow senior, center Jarred Shaw logged his seventh double-double of season and 16th of career with 19 points and a career-high 17 rebounds, helping USU to a dominating, 46-31, rebounding advantage.

Another Aggie senior, guard Preston Medlin, netting 12 points, as USU improved to 7-2 this season when Butterfield, Shaw and Medlin all post double-digits.

SJSU had four players in double-figures, led by D.J. Brown's 15 points off the bench, while starters Jaleel Williams, Chris Cunningham and Jalen James combined for 31 points, with Williams netting 11 and Cunningham and James tallied 10 points apiece. Cunningham pulled down a team-high nine rebounds and had a game-high two blocked shots.

2014-15 AGGIE NOTEBOOK

SHARING THE BALL

Utah State has tallied 339 assists on 542 baskets this season with players creating opportunities for teammates 62.5 percent of the time. That total includes a season-high of 22 against Air Force on Jan. 17 and 12 games with 15 or more helpers. The Aggies are currently fourth in the Mountain West with 14.1 assists per game.

AGGIE BLOCK PARTY

Utah State has nearly doubled up its competition on the block, recording 118 blocks this season to its opponents' 60. The Aggies are currently third in the Mountain West with 4.9 blocks per game.

LESS THAN 30

Utah State has held 13 of its 24 opponents to less than 30-percent shooting from behind the 3-point line this year. USU has held opponents to 30.0 percent (146-of-487) from deep, third-best in the Mountain West.

LESS THAN 40

Utah State's defense has held 12 of 24 opponents to less than 40-percent shooting from the field this year. The Aggies are 10-2 this season when holding opponents to less than 40 percent from the floor.

60 IS A LUCKY NUMBER

Utah State is 9-0 this season and 201-16 (.924) overall under head coach **Stew Morrill** when holding opponents under 60 points. The Aggies have won 136 of their last 142 games when holding opponents under the 60-point threshold.

70 IS EVEN LUCKIER

Utah State has won 111 of its last 125 games (.887) when reaching 70 points and is now 253-39 (.865) all-time under head coach **Stew Morrill** when scoring 70 points in a game.

BACK-TO-BACK 80's

Utah State scored 80 or more points in back-to-back games this season, scoring 81 against BYU (12/2/14) and 84 at USC (12/7/14). The Aggies last scored 80 or more points in subsequent games during the 2012-13 season in an 80-78 win over Santa Clara and an 86-57 win over Western Oregon.

JALEN MOORE NO. 17 ON SI'S PROJECTED LIST OF BREAKOUT PLAYERS IN 2014-15

Sophomore wing **Jalen Moore** has been picked No. 17 on Sports Illustrated's projected list of breakout players in 2014-15 as released in an article on Oct. 15. Said SI.com "Moore is the Aggies' only returning rotation player -- and thus it's hard to envision a scenario in which he doesn't become an important part of the offense".

ANOTHER OPENING

Utah State has debuted a total of nine players this season. The number represents 69 percent of the players to have suited up for the Aggies this season.

IN PURSUIT OF 400 USU VICTORIES

Head coach **Stew Morrill** only needs two more victories to hit the 400-win benchmark at Utah State, where he is entering his 17th season. Morrill recorded his 600th career victory in a 73-58 win over San José State last season, becoming just the 14th active coach to notch 600 wins in a career.

Morrill coached his 900th career game this season when the Aggies hosted the Air Force Academy on Jan. 17.

STREAKY THREES

Utah State's longest winning streak this year has been three games, matched three times during the season.

NO THREES FOR YOU

Utah State is one of the best in the nation in defending the 3-point line, holding opponents to just 30.0 percent from behind the 3-point line. The mark is currently third in the Mountain West, 26th nationally and second-best by a Morrill led team over the past 17 years.

BALL SECURITY

Utah State is in the top-20 nationally in taking care of the ball, committing just 10.4 turnovers per game, which ranks 16th in the nation.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Utah State's starting five has recorded 73.2 percent of minutes played, 86.4 percent of the team's points and 64.9 percent of the team's total rebounds this season.

LOCK DOWN D

Utah State is 10-2 this season when keeping opponents under 40 percent, holding Weber State to 38.8 percent (19-of-49), Illinois State to 32.8 percent (22-of-67), Santa Clara to 36.4 percent (20-of-55), Utah Valley to 29.4 percent (15-of-51), CSU Bakersfield to 35.8 percent (19-of-53), Idaho State to 35.0 percent (21-of-60), Wayland Baptist to 37.3 percent (22-of-59), San José State to 20.0 percent (12-of-60), Nevada to 35.0 percent (21-of-60) and Wyoming to 36.0 percent (18-of-50) shooting.

DEFENSIVE PROWESS

Utah State's defensive field goal percentage of 39.2 percent (536-of-1,367) is the second best for a Morrill led team over the past 17 years.

MOORE'S DOUBLE-DIGIT STREAK

Sophomore wing **Jalen Moore** has scored in double digits in all but two of Utah State's 20 games this season, including a streak of 17 straight that was snapped against Wyoming. USU All-American **Jaycee Carroll** has the longest streak in recent history, scoring in 39 consecutive games over the course of the 2006-07 and 2007-08 seasons. Moore matched Carroll's sophomore streak of 16 consecutive games with a career-high 22 points at Nevada.

HALFTIME TURN AROUND

Utah State opened the year 0-4 when leading at the half, but have since gone 10-0 in games when leading at the break.

The swap continues as USU started the year 4-0 when trailing at the half and have since gone 0-5.

AGGIES AT THE HALF

Overall, Utah State is 10-4 on the year when leading, 4-5 when trailing and 0-1 when going into halftime tied.

COUNTING COLLETTE

Forward **David Collette's** 22 points in the season opener against Weber state are the most points scored by a freshman in the opening game of the season in school history, topping the 19 points **Jaycee Carroll** scored against Georgia Southern to start his career in 2004. It is also the most points scored by an Aggie newcomer since **Brockeith Pane** scored 23 points at home against Weber State in his USU debut to start the 2010-11 season.

Collette broke the freshman single-game scoring mark with 32 points against USC on Dec. 7 which is the most points in a single game by any player in the Mountain West this season. The previous record was held by former Aggie All-American **Jaycee Carroll** who scored 28 points against UC Santa Barbara, Jan. 6, 2005.

NO OVERTIME

Utah State is 0-3 this season in games that have been decided in overtime. The Aggies are 55-45 all-time in overtime contests.

BETTER TO BURY THE OPPOSITION

Utah State is 8-2 this season in games that have been decided by 10 or more points.

ASSISTED DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Junior guard **Darius Perkins'** double-double of 11 points and 10 assists against Air Force is the first double-double with assists since the 2010-11 season when **Brockeith Pane** tallied 20 points and 10 assists against Oakland.

LOSING THE BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

Utah State is currently minus-7.1 in rebounding, as opponents have averaged 38.6 boards to the Aggies' 31.5. The margin includes a 319-165 differential on the offensive glass and has led to 140 more shots for the opposition.

Utah State out rebounded back-to-back opponents with a 37-35 performance against Wayland Baptist (12/27) and a 42-40 showing against San José State (12/31). USU also out rebounded back-to-back MW opponents against UNLV in Las Vegas, 42-33 (1/24) and at home against Wyoming, 32-28 (1/27).

CLIMBING THE MOUNTAIN WEST

As a team, Utah State is in the top-five of the Mountain West in 10 statistics, including 3-point field goal percentage (.391, second), assist/turnover ratio (1.4, second), defensive 3-point field goal percentage (.300, third), blocks (4.9, third), defensive rebounds (24.6, fourth), defensive field goal percentage (.392, fourth), assists (14.1, fourth), scoring defense (62.4, fifth), turnover margin (+1.0, fifth) and 3-point field goals made (7.2, fifth).

MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK (11/17)

Redshirt freshman forward **David Collette** was awarded Utah State men's basketball's first ever Mountain West Player of the Week award on Nov. 17, following his showings in the opening games for the Aggies. Collette averaged 19.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals, 2.5 blocks and 1.0 assist in 28.0 minutes per game, while shooting 72.0 percent from the field (18-25) and 50.0 percent at the free throw line (3-6).

DOUBLE DOWN, NO PROBLEMS

Utah State has faced 10 double-digit deficits this season, but have been able to come back and take the lead or tie in eight of the nine games. USU was down 18 points to Weber State, down 12 at Illinois State, down 15 against Santa Clara and down 10 at Utah Valley before coming back and winning each game. The Aggies overcame an 11-point second half deficit at UC Davis, taking a three-point lead with seconds left, but ultimately fell in overtime. USU also came back from a 15-point second-half deficit at home against South Dakota State to tie the game with 10 seconds left, but suffered defeat in overtime. USU came back from an 11-point deficit at Fresno State to tie the game in the second half, before suffering the defeat. USU overcame a 10-point first half deficit at UNLV, only to fall 79-77 in overtime.

RECENT TRENDS

- Utah State has had four players score in double figures in three consecutive games.
- Redshirt freshman forward David Collette has turned in double-digit points over the

past three games, averaging 13.7 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.7 blocks per game while shooting 62.5 percent (15-of-24) from the floor and 64.7 (11-of-17) from the free throw line.

- Sophomore wing Jalen Moore has recorded double-digit points in each of the last four games, averaging 16.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 59.5 percent (22-of-37) from the floor, 50.0 percent (7-of-14) from deep and 86.7 percent (13-of-15) from the charity stripe.

- Junior guard Chris Smith has scored in double digits in each of the last three games, averaging 15.7 points per game while shooting 60.0 percent (18-of-30) from the floor, 38.5 percent (5-of-13) from behind the 3-point line and 75.0 percent (6-of-8) from the free throw line.

- Utah State has shot over 50 percent from the field over the past three games, connecting on 51.0 percent (75-of-147).

- Utah State hit 16-of-22 (.727) at the free throw line against Nevada after combining for 13-of-22 (.591) from the charity stripe over the previous two games.

- Utah State has committed single-digit turnovers in three straight games, matching a season-low six against Nevada, and have recorded single-digit turnovers in 11 games this season.

Entering his 29th season as a collegiate head coach and 17th year at Utah State, Stew Morrill has established himself as one of the most respected heights leading coaches in the country. He is also the school's all-time winningest coach as he passed the legendary E. Lowell Romney's 225 career wins on Jan. 17, 2008 with an 82-78 win against Boise State.

In 16 years at Utah State, Morrill has taken the Aggie Basketball program to unprecedented heights leading USU to an incredible 384-143 (.729) record, including a 193-73 (.726) mark in three different conference, the Big West (1999-05), Western Athletic (2006-13) and Mountain West (2014-pres.).

While at Utah State, he has guided the Aggies to a 21-win season a total of 14 times, as USU's 13 straight postseason appearances (NCAA-8, NIT-4, CIT-1), was snapped in 2012-13, but both of which are school records. Prior to Morrill's run, USU had never posted more than three-straight 20-win seasons and participated in more than three-straight postseason tournaments.

Morrill has also led Utah State to the sixth-best winning percentage in the nation during the last 14 years at 73.9 percent with an overall record of 369-130. Against conference opponents, Utah State has a 219-82 record with seven regular season league championships and six tournament titles during that time, including appearances in its league's tournament championship game 10 times in the last 15 years.

Under Morrill, Utah State has notched 12 of the top 13 seasons in school history as the Aggies set a school record with 28 wins during the 2000 season, tied that record with 28 wins during the 2001 season, set a school record with 30 wins in 2009 and tied that record with 30 wins in 2011.

The 2013-14 edition of Utah State men's basketball was in its first season in the Mountain West, posting an 18-14 overall and 7-11 MW mark, finishing eighth in the league. USU won its first-ever MW Championships game with a come-from-behind 73-69 win over Colorado State, before falling to top-seed and eighth-ranked San Diego State in the quarterfinals.

Individually, senior guard/forward Spencer Butterfield and fellow senior, center Jarred Shaw became USU's first MW honorees, as the Aggie duo collected honorable mention all-MW accolades.

USU was 13-5 at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum in 2013-14, marking the Aggies' 11th-straight sea-

son with 13 or more home wins and its 21st-straight season with double-digit home wins.

Utah State's streak of consecutive seasons with at least one player earning first-team all-league accolades halted in 2013, but two Aggies collected second-team all-WAC honors in Butterfield and Shaw. Both were also tabbed to the WAC's all-newcomer team.

During the 2011-12 season, Utah State made its 30th postseason appearance all-time as it advanced to the championship game of the Collegelinsider.com Tournament winning four postseason games in the process, which is a single-season school record.

Guard Preston Medlin was named first-team all-WAC in 2011-12, becoming just the second sophomore in school history to earn first-team all-conference honors along with Nate Harris (2004).

Utah State had two other players honored by the WAC in 2012 as senior guard Brockeith Pane was named to the league's honorable mention team, while junior forward Kyisean Reed was voted to the WAC's all-newcomer team.

Medlin and Pane were also named to the Collegelinsider.com all-tournament team in 2012 along with senior forward Morgan Grim.

Overall, Morrill has coached 15 first-team all-league players at Utah State who have won the award a total of 21 times. Morrill has also coached three WAC Players of the Year in Tai Wesley (2011), Gary Wilkinson (2009) and Jaycee Carroll (2008), and all three of those players went on to earn Associated Press honorable mention All-America honors - Wesley (2011); Wilkinson (2009); Carroll (2007, 2008).

During the 2010-11 season, Morrill guided Utah State to its fourth-straight regular season WAC Championship, including its third-straight outright title with a 15-1 record. USU also won its second WAC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the 20th time in school history, including eight times under Morrill's watch.

Furthermore, the 2010-11 Aggie basketball team was nationally ranked for the last nine weeks of the season and finished the year ranked No. 25 in the country in final ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll, marking the first time since the 1978 season and only the eighth time in school history that an Aggie team was nationally ranked at the end of the year.

Morrill was also honored during the 2010-11 season and was named the WAC Coach of the Year for the third time in as many years. He was also named the 2011 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year by Collegelinsider.com and the National Association of Basketball Coaches District 6 Co-Coach of the Year for the second-straight season.

All-time, Morrill has been named Coach of the Year five times in his 15 years at USU (2000 BWC, 2002 BWC, 2009 WAC, 2010 WAC, 2011 WAC), along with winning the Big Sky award while the head coach at Montana in 1991.

Morrill has taken full advantage of the home

court at USU, the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. In Morrill's 16 years, USU is an amazing 237-27 (.898) at home, which includes a 116-18 (.866) record in league play.

As for Morrill, he has won 20 or more games on 18 different occasions during his career and has won at least 18 games a total of 25 times.

With an overall record of 602-281 (.682), Morrill became the 14th active Division I head coach and the 41st all-time Division I head coach with 600 wins, after the Aggies' 75-58 win at San José State on March 1, 2014. Morrill's career winning percentage of 68.2 percent ranks 19th among active coaches and 80th all-time. He is also one of 22 active coaches with 500 career wins at the Division I level and one of just nine active coaches to notch at least 18 20-win seasons. His streak of 14 straight 20-win seasons ranks tied for fifth among active coaches.

Academics and community service have been of top priority to Morrill and his staff as all of the team members are involved with USU's CHAMPS/Life Skills Program within the community. In his 16 years, Morrill has graduated better than 80 percent of his players, and over the past 12 years, Utah State has had 36 academic all-conference honorees.

Morrill, who was born in Provo, Utah and attended Provo High School, owns a career record of 602-281 in 28 years of collegiate coaching, including a 384-143 record at Utah State in 16 years, a 121-86 record in seven years at Colorado State (1992-98) and a 97-52 mark in five campaigns at Montana (1987-91).

"There are several reasons that I was attracted to Utah State," Morrill said when he was hired. "The first was being a Utah native so that it is a homecoming of sorts for me. My brother and sister both live within an hour and a half of Logan.

"I am very familiar with the tradition of Utah State basketball and can name the greats as well as any alumni could," Morrill added. "It is a good basketball situation and my family will love the quality of the community of Logan. It is a great place to live and that is very important to me and my family. It just made sense to us."

The 62-year old ranks second on the CSU victory list and second in winning percentage. He guided the Rams to back-to-back 20-win seasons the last two years in Fort Collins, with identical 20-9 marks. During the 1997-98 season, CSU made its second trip to the NIT in the last three years.

Morrill guided CSU to two of its eight all-time 20-win seasons and won at least 17 games five times in his seven years. In fact, Morrill-led CSU teams own three of the top nine winning seasons in school history.

During his tenure at Colorado State, he coached three first-team all-WAC selections, one second-team pick and six honorable mention choices. Three of his players were named to the WAC all-tournament team.

After his collegiate playing career, which included being named an All-American at nearby Ricks (Idaho) Junior College and a two-time all-

Big Sky selection at Gonzaga, Morrill played professionally in Europe.

His coaching career began as an assistant at Gonzaga from 1975-78 and then to Montana where he was an assistant from 1979-86 working for Mike Montgomery, who spent 17 years as the head coach at Stanford and is now the head coach at California. Montgomery worked under Jim Brandenburg and Jud Heathcote, who retired after a successful career, which included a national championship at Michigan State.

Morrill took over the Montana program in 1987 before moving to Colorado State in 1992. He is known for his deep-rooted values, consistency, hard work, dedication, honesty, integrity and concern for the welfare of his student-athletes.

Morrill earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from Gonzaga in 1974. He was born July 25, 1952 in Provo, Utah.

He and his wife Vicki have four grown children; sons Jesse and Allan, and daughters Nicole and Tiffany, and five grandchildren.

MORRILL DID YOU KNOW'S?

- Head coach Stew Morrill (398-153) is the winningest coach in school history and is first all-time in games coached (551). Morrill is also the second-longest tenured coach at Utah State (17 seasons) behind E. Lowell Romney (1920-41).

- In his 17th season with the Aggies, Morrill has a 398-153 (.722) overall record, a 200-78 (.719) conference record and a 25-10 (.714) record in conference postseason play. Overall, Morrill owns a 616-291 (.679) record in 907 career games in this his 29th year as a collegiate head coach.

- Morrill became the 14th active Division I head coach to tally 600 wins in his career in a 75-58 victory over San José State last season.

- Morrill is one of just nine active coaches to notch 18 20-win seasons.

- Morrill was named the 2009, 2010 and 2011 WAC Coach of the Year, along with earning Coach of the Year honors from the United States Basketball Writers Association in 2009 and Coach of the Year honors from the National Association of Basketball Coaches in 2010 and 2011.

- Morrill is the dean of MW coaches, entering his 29th year as a head coach and has the longest coaching tenure, as well as the most overall wins of all the current Mountain West Conference coaches. Morrill has amassed a 602-281 (.682) record in his 28 years. San Diego State's Steve Fisher is 496-258 (.658) in 23 seasons as a head coach. Colorado State's Larry Eustachy has a compiled a 444-283 (.611) overall record, also in 23 seasons, including a 98-53 (.649) mark during five seasons at Utah State (1994-98).

- Morrill has been named conference coach of the year six times during his career, winning the award in 1991 while at Montana and in 2000, 2002, 2009, 2010 and 2011 while at Utah State.

- Morrill was named the 2011 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year by CollegeInsider.com.

- Morrill has coached 15 first-team all-league players who have won the award a total of 21 times. Those players are Shawn Daniels (twice), Tory Rolle, Bernard Rock, Tony Brown, Desmond Penigar (twice), Mark Brown, Cardell Butler, Nate Harris (three times), Spencer Nelson, Jaycee Carroll (twice), Gary Wilkinson, Jared Quayle, Tai Wesley (twice), Brockeith Pane and Preston Medlin.

- Under Morrill, Utah State has had 22 players earn academic all-conference honors a total of 37 times.

- Utah State is 238-27 (.898) in the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum under Morrill.

- Morrill led Utah State to its first NCAA Tournament win in 31 years when USU defeated No. 5 Ohio State, 77-68, in overtime during the 2001 NCAA Tournament.
