Colorado State-San José State Postgame Notes

San José State's 69-64 victory gives the team its 16th victory of the year, matching the program's best single-season win turnaround in school history (+10 from 2018-19 to 2019-20 and 1999-00 to 2000-01).

The win over Colorado State is the program's third straight over the Rams.

The victory gave the program its first-ever regular season sweep of Colorado State.

Sophomore Raziya Potter came off the bench and led all scorers with a career-high 20 points.

Potter became the first Spartan to score 20+ points off the bench in a conference game since Emily Vann did so on Feb. 27, 2016 (20 vs. Utah State).

Saturday's results led to San José State becoming the third team in the Mountain West to clinch a first round bye for next month's conference tournament. This is the first time the Spartans have earned a bye since the 2015-16 season (entered the tournament as the No. 4 seed).

SJSU has now won 10 conference games, the first time the program has reached the 10-win plateau in league play since 2015-16 (went 11-7).

The Spartans are now 10-3 inside the Provident Credit Union Event Center this season.
