Kansas City-San José State Post-Match Notes

San José State's 6-0 win set a program record for margin of victory in a conference match.

The six-goal margin was the program's largest in any match since a 6-0 win against Notre Dame de Namur on Aug. 29, 2003.

Juniors Rodolfo Castro and Danny Sanchez both notched two-goal performances in the victory, marking the program's first match with multiple multi-goal scorers since Oct. 10, 2014 (Rory Knibbs and Greg Harte at Air Force).

Sanchez now tops the team with four goals through eight matches.

Freshman goalkeeper David Sweeney recorded the team's first shutout of the season.

The Spartans improved to 3-0 all-time at home against Kansas City with the 6-0 victory.

Junior Carlos Gomez-Zavala played another 55 minutes on Friday, bringing his total to a team-high 746 minutes on the season.
