San José State-No. 20 Stanford Post-Match Notes

Sophomore goalkeeper Eric Waltz made a career-high seven saves in Saturday's draw with the Cardinal.

Waltz now has two shutouts in three career appearances (was in goal for 1-0 victory over UNLV in 2020-21 regular season finale).

The 0-0 draw marks the program's first result against a ranked opponent since Aug. 24, 2018 (0-0 at No. 1 and three-time defending national champion Stanford).

San José State has now earned five results in the last 20 years against the Cardinal (won in 2006, tied in 2005, 2008, 2018 and 2021).

At 2-1-1, the Spartans are off to their best start to a season through four matches in 10 years (also started 2-1-1 in 2011 with victories over Fresno Pacific and Omaha).

SJSU has now earned six straight away results dating back to last season (and have earned a win or draw in eight of its last nine road matches dating back to 2019).
