Eastern Washington-San José State Postgame Notes

San José State shot at a 61 percent clip (14-of-23) from three-point range in the victory. The mark sets a single-game record for three-point field goal percentage in the Jamie Craighead era.

The 18-point win marks the program's largest margin of victory in a game against a non-league opponent since Dec. 20, 2015 (79-58 against UC Irvine).

The margin of victory is the highest in a game of any kind since Mar. 6, 2017 (79-58 vs. San Diego State).

San José State had four players finish scoring in double figures for the first time on the 2019-20 campaign.

The Spartans stayed undefeated against Eastern Washington and improved to 2-0 all-time against the Eagles.

Craighead improved to 5-2 in home openers at SJSU with the victory.

Sophomore Ayzhiana Basallo is averaging 17.5 points per game to lead the Spartans.

San José State is led on the glass by forward Tyra Whitehead, pulling down an average of 9.0 rebounds per game thus far.
