### SPARTANS AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

The 26th-ranked San José State women's golf team is making its 24th appearance at the NCAA Championships in 2024. This year's championship is being played at the Omni La Costa Resort & Spa North Course in Carlsbad, Calif. This is the first of three years that the facility will host the championship. The course has just been renovated by renowned golf course architect Gil Hanse, who designed the Rio de Janeiro course for the 2016 Olympics.

**TV COVERAGE:** The Golf Channel will provide live coverage of the final three days of the championship.

Monday, May 22 - 3-7 p.m. PT (individual national championship)

Tuesday, May 23 - 3-7 p.m. PT (semifinal matches)

Wednesday, May 24 - 3-7 p.m. PT (championship match)

**TEE TIMES:** Tee times for the first and second rounds are determined by seeding. San José State will start the championship on Friday the 17th at 7:35 a.m. PT off of the 10th tee. On Saturday the 18th, SJSU will tee off on the 1st tee beginning at 12:55 p.m. PT. The Spartans will play the first two rounds with SMU and North Carolina. Tee times for Sunday, the 19th, will be determined by the results after two rounds.

**CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT:** All 30 teams and six individuals will complete 54 holes of stroke play. Following 54-holes of competition on Sunday, the top-15 teams along with the top nine individuals not on an advancing team will advance for one additional day of stroke play to determine the top eight teams for match play competition and the 72-hole stroke-play individual champion.

The top eight teams after 72 holes of stroke play will be placed into a bracket with the No. 1 seed playing the No. 8 seed, the No. 2 seed playing the No. 7 seed, the No. 3 seed playing the No. 6 seed and the No. 4 seed playing the No. 5 seed in match play. Ties for the top 15 teams as well as the top 9 individuals, will be broken by use of a sudden-death playoff.

Additionally, ties for the top eight teams and NCAA individual champion will be broken by a sudden-death playoff or, if necessary, by the established non-sudden-death tie breaking procedures.

#### **SAN JOSE STATE AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

The Spartans are making their 24th appearance at an NCAA Championship and have won three national titles - 1987, 1989 and 1992. Current head coach **Dana (Lofland) Dormann** finished tied for 17th individually at the 1987 championship.

This is the third consecutive appearance as a team for the Spartans, and **Kajsa Arweffjäll** is making her fourth consecutive appearance as she qualified as an individual for the 2021 championship.

Last year, SJSU finished 16th in the team standings, one shot from playing in the fourth round. **Lucia Lopez Ortega** and **Arweffjäll** advanced to the final round individually. Lopez Ortega tied for second at 9-under 279. Arweffjäll tied for 18th at 2-under 286.

The Spartans competed at the 2022 NCAA Championships at Grayhawk. The team advanced to match play for the first time in school history, finishing seventh in the team standings after the four rounds of stroke play. In match play, SJSU fell 3-0 to Oregon in the quarterfinals. **Natasha Andrea Oon** finished second in the individual standings, the first Spartan to finish second since Janice Moodie in 1997.

In 2019, the team finished 19th in the three-round stroke play portion of the tournament which was shortened due to inclement weather. **Oon** finished ninth in the individual standings at 3-over 222 (par 73). She was the first Spartan to finish in the top-10 at an NCAA Championship since 1997.

**Pat Hurst** is the only San José State player to win an individual title. In all, 13 Spartans finished in the top-10 a total of 22 times at the NCAA Championships. Janice Moodie finished in the top-10 in all four years she competed for San José State, finishing second in 1997. A complete listing is on page 25.

**G5 WELL REPRESENTED:** After being the only G5 school at the 2022 NCAA Championships, **San José State** is not alone this year as the Spartans are one of four schools not from current Power 5 conferences at the championship. The Spartans are representing the Mountain West for the fourth time in six years (2019, 2022, 2023) as the 2020 championships were canceled due to COVID. **Kajsa Arweffjäll** represented the Spartans at the 2021 championships as an individual qualifier and finished tied for 36th after shooting a 294 (77-71-72-74).

All four G5 schools represented in the championships are here for the second consecutive year - Pepperdine, SMU, Tulsa and the Spartans.

**SPARTAN LINEUP:** San José State's lineup will be - **Kajsa Arweffjäll, Lucia Lopez Ortega, Louisa Carlbom, Rebecca Gyllner** and **Moa Andersson**. **Tessa Kremser** is the alternate.

**SPARTAN COACHING STAFF:** Head coach **Dana Dormann** is in her sixth year at the helm of the women's program and her 20th season affiliated with the San José State golf program. Named the head coach of the program in June of 2018, she has been honored by her peers as the Mountain West Coach of the Year three times, 2019, 2022 and 2024, and was *Golfweek* Coach of the Year after the program's very successful 2021-22 season.

**Kortnie Barrett** is making her fourth postseason appearance with the program and first as associate head coach. She joined the program in January of 2021 and made an immediate impact on the team.

**WAGR RANKINGS:** Two San José State players are currently ranked among the top-75 amateur players on the World Amateur Golf Rankings (WAGR).

**AUGUSTA NATIONAL WOMEN'S AMATEUR:** **Kajsa Arweffjäll** played at the 2024 Augusta National Women's Amateur (ANWA). This was her second year to receive an invitation and play at ANWA. She finished tied for 26th at 6-over 222, after shooting a 4-over 76 in the final round at the Augusta National Golf Club.

**BRIDESMAID OR BRIDE THIS YEAR?:** For the past two championships, a Spartan has finished second in the individual standings. In 2022, **Natasha Andrea Oon** finished second at 3-under, 285, to Stanford's Rose Zhang.

Last year, **Lucia Lopez Ortega** tied for second at 9-under 279, one shot behind Zhang.

**MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONS:** For the second time in three years, San Jose State won the Mountain West championship, shooting a 9-under 279 in the final round to win by 18 shots at 17-under 847, at the Mission Hills Country Club. The Spartans set the tournament record for lowest 54-hole score with the 847, besting the record of 853 set by New Mexico in 2023.

The 18-shot victory is the fourth-biggest in championship history.

**MOUNTAIN WEST INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION: Kajsa Arweffjäll** shot a 6-under 66 in the final round to claim the 2024 Mountain West Individual Title at a 9-under 207. Arweffjäll had a clean card in the third round with her six birdies and 12 pars. Arweffjäll led the field in par-3 scoring (-1) and par-4 scoring (-5) and was second in the field in birdies made with 16. Her 66 ties for the second-lowest individual score at the championship and her low score this year.

Her 207 is the second-lowest 54-hole score shot in the 24-year history of the tournament, one shot from former Spartan Natasha Andrea Oon who had a 10-under 206 to win in 2022.

Arweffjäll joins Oon as the only two Spartans to win the MW Individual Championship. In her four years at the championship, Arweffjäll finished tied for ninth in 2021, tied for third in 2022, second in 2023 and champion in 2024.

**THREE OTHER SPARTANS FINISH IN TOP-10 AT MW CHAMPS: Lucia Lopez Ortega** finished third at 5-under 211, shooting a 2-under 70 in the third round. Lopez Ortega started her round 5-over through the first five holes of the day, making double bogey-bogey-par-par-double bogey to start and shot a 40 for the first nine holes.

Starting on hole nine, Lopez Ortega made five consecutive birdies to pull herself back to even par. She finished the round making back-to-back birdies to shoot a 30 for the back nine. With her seven birdies made on Thursday, Lopez Ortega led the tournament in birdies with 17.

**Louisa Carlbom** and **Rebecca Gyllner** tied for ninth place at even-par 216. Carlbom shot an even-par 72 in the final round with four birdies. Gyllner had a 1-over 73, and had two birdies and nine pars over her final 11 holes played.

**ARWEFFJÄLL NAMED ANNIKA AMBASSADOR: Kajsa Arweffjäll** was named one of four collegiate women's golfers named to the second class of ambassadors for the ANNIKA Development Program at Old Barnwell Golf Club in Aiken, S.C., as announced by the ANNIKA Foundation recently.

The program provides opportunities for women to excel in both golf and life and benefits a select group of college graduates who are attempting to pursue a professional career in golf. They were selected on a combination of their golf talent, potential, leadership skills, personal character and dedication to their college careers.

Over the next three years, each ambassador will have access to play and practice at Old Barnwell and will receive training from its professional staff. They will also receive a \$10,000 annual stipend to cover tournament fees and travel. Annika will provide mentoring sessions during their time in the development program. Additionally, ambassadors will receive housing for the first year of the program.

#### **FOUR SPARTANS RECEIVE MOUNTAIN WEST HONORS:**

For the second consecutive year, San José State women's golfer **Kajsa Arweffjäll** has been selected as the Mountain West Women's Golfer of the Year for the 2023-24 season. Spartan head coach **Dana Dormann** has been named the MW Coach of the Year for the third time in her career, while three other Spartans received All-MW honors.

In the 25 years of the conference, Arweffjäll is just the sixth player to receive multiple MW Women's Golf of the Year honors and the second Spartan to be named twice. For five of the past six seasons, a San José State player has received Player of the Year honors.

**SCHOOL STROKE AVERAGE:** Two Spartans have vaulted themselves into the top-10 in San José State history in scoring average for a season. **Kajsa Arweffjäll** currently sits second on the list with a 70.96 stroke average, just behind of Natasha Andrea Oon who had 70.71 average for the 2021-22 season. Arweffjäll is listed in the top-15 in four different seasons. **Lucia Lopez Ortega** is 10th at 72.38 stroke average this year. She is also in the fifth position at 71.88 from 2022-23.

**ACADEMICS IMPORTANT IN TITLE "STUDENT-ATHLETE"**

Three women's golfers were honored at the San José State Honors Convocation for earning President's Scholar recognition - **Moa Andersson, Tessa Kremser and Lucia Lopez Ortega**. To earn a President's Scholar designation, a student must earn a 4.00 grade-point average in one of the two semesters (Spring 2022 or Fall 2022) before the Honors Convocation. Three others earned Dean's Scholar recognition for earning a 3.65 gpa in Spring or Fall 2022 - **Kajsa Arwefjäll, Rebecca Gyllner and Darae Chung**.

**CHAMPIONSHIP CALIBER COACH:** NCAA Championship play is nothing new Spartan coach **Dana Dormann**. She helped the Spartans win the 1987 team title, the first in school history in women's golf. She was the student assistant coach for the 1989 championship team. Dormann was the assistant coach for the 2010 and 2013 teams that played in Wilmington, N.C., and Athens, Ga., respectively. This is her third appearance at an NCAA Championship as a head coach (2019, 2022).

# Dana Dormann

## Head Coach

### Three-time Mountain West Women's Golf Coach of the Year



No stranger to NCAA Championship competition, San José State women's golf coach Dana Dormann is in her sixth season at the helm of the Spartan program. The former Spartan All-American and San José State Sports Hall of Fame honoree was named to lead the program in June of 2018.

The 2024 Mountain West Coach of the Year led the San José State women's golf program back to national prominence with the Spartans finishing the 2021-22 season ranked third nationally. The Spartans finished either first or second in eight of the 11 tournaments played and advanced to match play at the NCAA Championships for the first time in school history. San José State won its first Mountain West Women's Golf Championship in April of 2022, winning by a record 30 shots over their nearest competitor. The team won five tournaments in the spring of 2021 including twice over top-ranked Stanford at the Lamkin Invitational and the Juli Inkster at Meadow Club Invitational and the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional. The Spartans broke the school record for most under par & par rounds recorded in a season at 77.

Dormann was a finalist for the Division I Jackie Steinmann WGCA National Coach of the Year, presented by Golf Pride, and earned her second Mountain West Coach of the Year distinction (2018-19, 2021-22) after the Spartans dominated the field at the conference tournament. SJSU was the only school outside of the Power 5 to qualify for the national championships and finished seventh through stroke play to advance to match play. For all their successes in 2021-22, the Spartans swept the conference awards as Natasha Andrea Oon was the MW Player of the Year, Lucia Lopez Ortega the MW Freshman of the Year and those two, along with Kajsa Arwefjäll and Antonia Malate were selected to the All-MW first team.

Dormann navigated the program through an early shut down of the season in 2020 due to COVID-19, to a spring-only season in 2021. She coached Arwefjäll to an appearance at the NCAA National Championship where she finished tied for 36th in the individual standings.

In her first season (2018-19), Dormann and the Spartans won two tournaments - Minnesota Invitational, and The Gold Rush. The Spartans advanced to the 2019 NCAA Championships at the Blessings Golf Course where the team finished 19th. She coached the top-two golfers in the Mountain West - Abigail Arevalo, the 2018-19 MW Women's Golfer of the Year, and Oon, the 2018-19 MW Women's Golf Freshman of the Year. Dormann was honored as the 2018-19 MW Women's Golf Coach of the Year.

Dormann was the associate head coach and assistant coach for the Spartan program for 13-plus seasons. She mentored many players during those years including All-American and conference Player of the Year winners Erica Moston and My Leander. Dormann helped coach the Spartans to berths at the NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championships - 2013 in Athens, Ga., and 2010 in Wilmington, N.C. In 2011, Dormann was named the Coach of the Year for the Western Section, as selected by the LPGA Teaching and Club Professional membership. She was one of five collegiate coaches selected for the award.

Dormann has been successful in golf from a young age, winning the 1985 U.S. Junior and Junior World championships to becoming a three-time All-American for the Spartans. She played on 1985 through 1988 teams, was a member of the 1987 NCAA Championship team, won four tournaments and was the 1987 Pacific Coast Athletic Association Player of the Year. Dormann was also an assistant coach for the 1989 NCAA Championship team.

Professionally, she played 10 years on the LPGA Tour, winning the 1992 Las Vegas LPGA International and the 1993 McCall's LPGA Classic. Dormann is a member of the Golf Coaches Association of America Hall of Fame.

Still playing competitively, Dormann earned medalist honors by shooting a three-under 68 to qualify for the inaugural 2018 U.S. Senior Women's Open in Chicago. Dormann was the only player under par at the qualifier on the par-71 Ocean Course at San Francisco's Olympic Club. She qualified for the 2019 U.S. Senior Women's Open after winning the Stanford qualifier with an even-par 71. Dormann is no stranger to USGA events as she played in 14 U.S. Women's Open Championships.

# Kortnie Barrett

## Associate Head Coach

Kortnie Maxoutopoulos Barrett joined the Spartan program as an assistant coach in January of 2021 and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2023.

Barrett made her third appearance at the NCAA Championships with the San José State program in 2023. She was the assistant for the 2022 team which advanced to match play before falling to runners-up Oregon. Barrett also coached Kajsa Arwejfäll in at the 2021 championship with Arwejfäll participated as an individual and advanced to the fourth round on a playoff.

A part of the Spartan program for the whirlwind 2021-22 season, Barrett helped the Spartans finish the season ranked No. 3 in the country. The Spartans won four tournaments in the spring of 2022 including the first-ever Mountain West Championship by 30 shots and the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional by three shots. The Spartans broke the school record for most under par & par rounds recorded in a season at 77.

Coming out of COVID restrictions, Barrett had a whirlwind beginning to her first five months in 2021. The team finished in the top-four in the first three tournaments played. She helped coach Kajsa Arewfjäll to the 2021 NCAA Championships where she tied for 36th after a fifth-place finish at the NCAA Stanford Regional. Academically, the team posted one of the highest semester grade point averages in school history.

Prior to San José State, Barrett spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Mississippi State where she helped the 2019 team get back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in four seasons. She was responsible for all team travel and assisted in recruiting top talent to the school. The school's Golfstat ranking improved from 68 when she started to 22 in the nation this past school year.

Before Starkville, Barrett spent one season on the staff at Long Beach State. She helped coach the team to the Big West Conference Championship, UC Irvine Invitational title and the program's first NCAA Regional bid in almost 10 years. The program jumped 41 spots in the Golfstat ranks during the one season she coached the 49ers.

Barrett received her master's degree in public & nonprofit administration from Georgia Southern University in 2017 where she spent two years as the graduate assistant coach for their inaugural women's golf program.

Playing as the former Kortnie Maxoutopoulos, she competed for three seasons at TCU after playing at Rutgers her freshman year. While at Rutgers, she was a 2011-12 BIG EAST All-Academic honoree and had seven top-10 finishes including three wins at the Bucknell Invitational, Rutgers Invitational and Lehigh Invitational

Barrett graduated from TCU with a bachelor of science degree in political science with a psychology of leadership emphasis. During her college career, she participated in the 2016 NCAA Emerging Leaders Seminar and was a SAAC team representative. She competed in 24 events and earned three top-10 finishes and four top-25 finishes. Her best finish was third place at the 2015 Big XII Championship.

Growing up in the Bay Area, Maxoutopoulos Barrett graduated from Foothill High School in 2011 and called Castlewood Country Club her golf home. She ranked 115th nationally in junior golf for the class of 2011 and placed third with partner Tom Kite at the 2010 First Tee Open at Pebble Beach.

Barrett and her husband, Chelso, were married in 2019, have a daughter, Blair Darling (1) and a yellow Labrador retriever named Tillie.

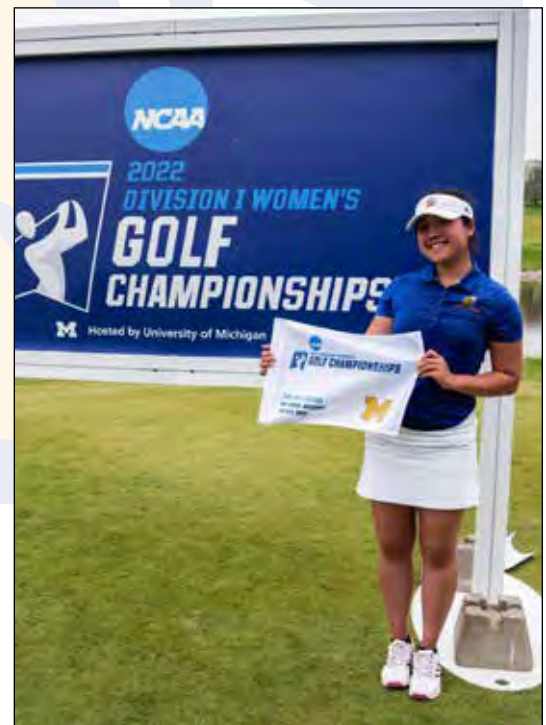
