OPENING TIP

• The Spartans are looking to return to postseason play for the third time in four years which would be the best stretch in program history

• Last season, the Spartans competed in the NIT for the first time since 1981

• The Spartans' 46 wins over their last three seasons is the most wins since the team won 46 games from 1985-88 while in the Big West conference

• This is the third game of a four game home stand for the Spartans. SJSU will play eight of 11 games at the Provident Credit Union Event Center from Nov. 11 - Jan. 17

• The Spartans LBSU matched up for the first time in 18 years last season at the Ball Dawgs Classic with the Spartans taking the game 82-66

• The Spartans last defeated Long Beach State at home on Feb. 11, 1991

• Colby Garland is averaging 17.9 points per game, ranking third in the Mountain West

• Yaphet Moundi has five double-doubles so far this season ranking first the Mountain West and eighth in the nation

• Moundi has the most double-doubles in a season for the Spartans since Michael Steadman recorded 11 in 2018-19

• The Spartans are averaging 13.1 offensive rebounds per game, second in the conference and 82nd best in the country

COLBY GARLAND IS ROLLING:

- Garland has scored 10 or more points in eight out of nine games this season, scored 20+ in four games and 30 in one game
- In addition to being third in the conference in scoring, Garland leads the conference in made field goals and is sixth in field goal percentage
- Garland became the first Spartan since Adrian Oliver in 2008-09 to score 20+ in each of his first three games of the season.
- Against UCSB, Garland shot 11-13 from the field and 8-9 from the foul line.
- Garland is the first Spartan to score 30 points without attempting a three since Brandon Clarke, who scored 36 against Air Force, on Jan. 14, 2017.
- Garland is also the first Spartan to score 30 on at least 80% shooting from the field since D.J. Brown who did it against CSU Bakersfield on Jan. 23, 2012.
- No player this century has scored 30 points on .846 field goal percentage for the Spartans.

YAPHET MOUNDI GOES HARD IN THE PAINT:

- Moundi is averaging 11.7 points and 9.1 rebounds so far this season
- Moundi's 9.1 rebounds per game is the third most in the Mountain West and 36th in the nation
- Moundi's 6.44 defensive rebounds per game is the third most in the conference and 32nd most in the nation
- Moundi had a double-double in three consecutive games (vs. #17 Michigan State, Bethesda & Southern), becoming the first Spartan since Michael Steadman in 2019 to accomplish the feat
- Moundi's 56 attempted free throws are the second most in the Mountain West

OTHER PLAYERS TO WATCH:

- Adrian Myers recorded a career-high 20 points, eight rebounds and four threes and shot 8-for-11 off the bench in the Spartans' win over San Diego (12/5)
- Ben Roseborough and Jermaine Washington are the team's leading three point shooters. Both are averaging over two threes a game and top ten in the Mountain West in made threes

- Roseborough is shooting .409 percent from beyond the arc, the best three point percentage on the team
- Roseborough is currently averaging 10.6 points per game. The last Spartan freshman to average more than 10 points per game was Keith Fisher in 2017-18
- Washington is averaging the third most minutes per game in the Mountain West this season. His averages of 12.0 points and 3.0 assists per game are career-bests
- Sadraque NgaNga is averaging 5.6 rebounds per game. Combined with Moundi, the Spartans starting frontcourt averaged 14.7 rebounds per game
- Marcus Overstreet is averaging 17.0 rebounds per 40 minutes, the highest on the team
- JaVaughn Hannah has been limited to one game so far this season due to injury. Against Utah, Hannah scored 12 points on 5-7 shooting

ACRISURE HOLIDAY INVITATIONAL REVIEW:

- The Spartans went 1-1 in the Acrisure Series, falling to Tulsa but defeating Loyola Chicago
- The Spartans defeated Loyola Chicago 63-51, getting revenge against the Ramblers after SJSU lost to them in the first round of last season's NIT
- The Spartans forced Loyola Chicago into 21 turnovers, the most forced for the Spartans since Hampton turned the ball over 22 times on Nov. 20, 2023
- The Spartans also held the Ramblers to 51 points, the fewest points allowed since they held Colorado State to 46 points on Feb. 28, 2023

NEW ERA IN COLLEGE BASKETBALL:

- For the second consecutive season, the Spartans will have a completely new starting five
- Three members of last season's starting five (Donavan Yap, Josh Uduje & Sadaidriene Hall) graduated while the other two transferred (Will McClendon - North Texas, Robert Vai-hola - Minnesota)
- The Spartans lost a total of six players to the transfer portal. Besides McClendon and Vaihola, sixth man Latrell Davis (12.8 PPG, .402 3P%) transferred to San Diego State

2025-26 TEAM CONSTRUCTION:

- The Spartans return just three players who saw minutes last season, equating to 19.4 percent of their scoring (Sadraque NgaNga - 6.8 ppg, Jermaine Washington - 4.4 ppg & Pasha Goodarzi - 2.3 ppg)
- SJSU added six new players from the transfer portal. They include Colby Garland (Longwood), Adrian Myers (Mississippi State), JaVaughn Hannah (Western Michigan), Jaden Goodall (Cal), Yaphet Moundi (Iona) & Marcus Overstreet (Mercer)
- The Spartans added five freshmen to the squad, including Melvin Bell Jr., Damase Coly, Eren Karakaya, Japhet Moupadele & Douglas Langford
- Two of the Spartans' freshmen, Karakaya and Moupadele, are international.
- The Spartans also add redshirt freshman Ben Roseborough,

who missed all of last season with an injury. Roseborough was a three star rated recruit and ranked as the 13th best player in California in his recruiting class.

CHALLENGING NON-CON SCHEDULE:

- The Spartans opened the season with three road games for the first time 1994-95, not including neutral site games.
- The Spartans will play three power four non-con games, facing off against Utah, Michigan State and Stanford. The Stanford game will be played at the PCUEC.
- The average win total from 2024-25 of the 11 DI non-con opponents the Spartans will potentially face is 19.2

- Only Goodarzi and Christian Wise remain from the 2023-24 team
- The last Spartan to play all four years at SJSU without having ever transferred was Omari Moore who graduated following the 2022-23 season. Moore was named 2023 Mountain West Player of the Year

COACH MILES HONORS

- Head Coach Tim Miles will be inducted into the Southwest Minnesota State University Athletics Hall of Honor
- Miles is one of eight people to be honored as member of the class of 2026
- The induction will take place on Jan. 26, 2026
- Miles was also inducted into the Mayville State University hall of fame in 2016

- Coach Miles is two Mountain West wins away from 50 career Mountain West wins
- Coach Miles is seven wins away from 350 career wins as an NCAA Division I head coach
- Marcus Overstreet needs 37 rebounds for 500 in his career

HEAD COACH TIM MILES



Tim Miles returns for his fifth season as Head Coach of San José State men's basketball. Miles was named the head coach of the Spartans program on April 6, 2021, and brought over 24 years of head coaching experience to the South Bay.

In 2022-23, Miles and Spartans achieved feats that had not been seen in program history including having both the Mountain West Player of the Year in Omari Moore and the Coach of the Year in Miles. Coach was also a Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Finalist in recognition of the team's 13-win improvement from the previous season.

Despite losing every starter from the previous season, the Spartans returned to postseason play in 2024-25, appearing in the NIT for just the first time since 1981 and second time in program history. It also marked the first time SJSU hosted a postseason basketball game in school history. Miles led the Spartans to 15 wins, seven of which came in conference play. Josh Uduje was named Third Team All-Mountain West.

In 2023-24, Miles led the Spartans to nine wins on the year. SJSU was second in the conference in three pointers made per game with 8.3. Myron Amey Jr. was named all-conference honorable mention in both the Mountain West Coaches Poll and the Mountain West Media Poll.

The Spartans' success propelled them into postseason play in 2022-23 as the team was invited to play in the Discount Tire CBI. The team went 1-1 at the tournament played at the Ocean Center in Daytona Beach, Fla. At the tournament, two of Miles' former players were on coaching staffs of participating teams. Aaron Fearne was then the Associate Head Coach at Charlotte and now Head Coach at Charlotte, while Flynn Clayman was the Associate Head Coach at Southern Utah and is now the Associate Head Coach at High Point University.

In his inaugural season Miles posted eight wins which was the most wins since the 2016-2017 season. The Spartans were third in the conference in 3-point shooting percentage under the guidance of Miles. Under the guidance of Miles, the Spartans had a program record 17 3-pointers against Portland State.

Miles came to San José State after coaching at the University of Nebraska from 2012-19. During his time in Lincoln, Nebraska saw unprecedented success as they were guided to some of their most successful seasons in program history. In 2014, just two seasons after being hired, Miles led the team to their first NCAA Tournament in 16 seasons. He was named the Jim Phelan Award winner for national coach of the year and was also tabbed as the Big Ten Coach of the Year.

That 2013-14 season made Nebraska the talk of college basketball after reaching the tournament despite being selected to finish last in the Big Ten standings in the preseason poll. The Cornhuskers overcame a 1-5 start in conference play by winning 10 out of their last 12 games to finish fourth in the standings with an 11-7 record. Among those wins was a 60-51 victory over No. 9 Michigan State, the program's first road win over a top-10 program since 1997, and a 77-68 defeat of Wisconsin, who would later go on to advance to the 2014 Final Four.

The turnaround at Nebraska began immediately under Miles' wing with the Cornhuskers seeing a three-win improvement from 12 to 15 wins in the 2012-13 year. With just one returning starter, Miles and company defeated three NCAA Tournament teams and finished the year off with a victory over Purdue in the Big Ten Tournament.

After the success of the Huskers' NCAA Tournament appearance in 2013-14, the following season saw more firsts for the Nebraska program as they achieved a national ranking for the first time since 1995.

In 2017-18, Miles led the Cornhuskers to one of their most successful seasons in program history. Nebraska won 22 games, their most since the 1990-91 campaign, with a school record 13 wins in conference play and earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) for their first postseason appearance in four seasons.

In Miles' final season at Nebraska, the Huskers won 19 games and earned another top-25 ranking in the Associated Press poll. They advanced to their second-straight NIT appearance.

In his seven total seasons at the helm of Nebraska men's basketball, Miles guided nine players to All-Big Ten accolades including two-time all-conference pick Terran Petteway, who became the first Husker in program history to win the Big Ten scoring title in 2013-14 with an average of 18.1 points per game.

In addition to being a premier talent at building programs, Miles also demands excellence from his student-athletes in the classroom. He guided 17 Nebraska players to Academic All-Big Ten honors, including a conference-best five selections in 2015. In 2014-15, Shamian Shields became the first player in program history to earn first-team Academic All-American honors.

Prior to his extended stint at Nebraska, Miles made a name for himself at Colorado State where he took the Rams to new heights and laid the foundation for what is now one of the top teams in the Mountain West. In five seasons at the helm, he increased his win total in each season with his best year being the 2011-12 campaign that saw CSU defeat a school-record three ranked teams en route to their first 20-plus win season since 1997-98. The Rams finished with a 20-12 record, put three players on the all-conference team, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in nine years. For his efforts, Miles was named the District VIII Coach of the Year by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.

The 2011-12 Colorado State team averaged 70.1 points per game and was the Mountain West leader in field goal percentage (47.1), 3-point percentage (40.0) and free throw percentage (76.8). They also were one of just two programs nationwide to rank in the top 10 in both free throw and 3-point percentage. The Rams' 20-win campaign was just the seventh in program history.

Similar to what he would eventually do at Nebraska, Miles quickly turned the Colorado State program around from his first day on campus. His first two seasons saw the Rams battle through growing pains and injuries while still making strides towards becoming the program that it is today. Colorado State improved their win total in league play in Miles' second season and finished the year off with a key victory over Wyoming in the Mountain West Tournament.

Years three through five were some of the most successful for the Rams in recent history, culminating in CSU's NCAA Tournament

bid in 2011-12. In 2009-10, Miles led the Rams to their first postseason appearance in seven years after posting 16 regular-season wins. Colorado State was selected to participate in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), and Miles was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year by CollegeInsider.com.

The 2010-11 team finished in fourth place in the Mountain West after posting the program's first winning record since 2007. The Rams finished the year 19-13 and earned a berth to the NIT for their second-straight postseason appearance. Miles and company won nine conference games that year, the most for the Rams since the formation of the Mountain West in 1999-2000, and received votes in the top-25 national poll at year's end for the first time since 2005-06.

Before going to CSU, Miles was the head coach of the Bison of North Dakota State for six seasons, where he guided the program through their transition to Division I. The Bison reached at least 16 wins in each of Miles' final five seasons at the helm. One of their biggest moments came in 2005-06 against 13th ranked Wisconsin. North Dakota State handed the Badgers a 62-55 loss, snapping Wisconsin's 27-game win streak against non-conference opponents. The loss was also just one of 10 non-conference home losses for the Badgers under hall of fame coach Bo Ryan. Miles was awarded the CBS Sportsline Division I Independent Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year Award.

Miles was also the catalyst for turning around Southwest Minnesota State University, who he guided for four seasons before joining North Dakota State. Prior to Miles' arrival, the Mustangs had just one winning season in the previous decade. Miles changed all of that by posting a 78-39 four-year total, including a program-record 28-win season in 2001. The Mustangs won the 2001 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Championship as well as the NCAA North Central Regional Championship before advancing to the Division II Elite Eight. Miles was named the NSIC and North Central Region Coach of the Year Awards for his unprecedented success. Miles will be inducted into the SMSU Hall of Honor in Jan. 2026.

Miles made his head coaching debut as the head man at Mayville (N.D.) State University. The program was just 4-44 in the previous two seasons before Miles took over, and in the first of many instances of changing a program's culture, he was able to turn things around and led them to a 35-22 record in three seasons. Miles was inducted into the Mayville State Hall of Fame in 2016.

Before reaching the head coaching ranks, Miles made his coaching

debut as an assistant at Northern State. He spent six seasons on staff from 1989-90 to 1994-95, helping lead the program to five NAIA playoff appearances and five regional titles. As the team's recruiting coordinator, he brought in and molded five All-Americans and helped the Wolves advance to the NAIA National Championship in back-to-back seasons.

A native of Doland, S.D., Miles graduated from the University of Mary in Bismarck, N.D., in 1989. He then earned his master's degree in health and physical education from Northern State in 1990. In 2007, he was inducted into the University of Mary Hall of Fame.

Following his stint at Nebraska Miles took a brief two-year pause from coaching, turning in his whistle for a microphone. He began working with the Big Ten Network, Fox Sports and FS1 as an analyst in 2019 and also lent his talents to a podcast called "Inside the Mind of Miles" as part of the "Field of 68" college basketball media network.

Miles has daughter, Ava who graduated from San José State in 2023, and a son, Gabe, who is a student-athlete at North Dakota State. They have a yellow lab, appropriately named Sammy.
