From Loading Bays to Luxury Lobbies: Chetan's Journey of Transformation

When Chetan Ramesh Chavan was just one year old, a case of medical negligence changed the course of his life — leading to a permanent hearing and speech impairment. The only son and youngest among four siblings, Chetan was the first in his family to face such a challenge. His father recalls the early years as a period of deep confusion and helplessness, as the family struggled to understand how to support him. With encouragement from their community, they eventually enrolled Chetan in a special school for children with hearing impairments, where he completed his education up to Class 12.

After finishing school, Chetan began working at a local shop, doing heavy loading and unloading tasks. The work was physically exhausting and far from his dreams, but family financial pressures left him with little choice. Each day felt repetitive and limiting,

yet he silently nurtured the desire to build a better life and stand on equal footing with others.

That opportunity arrived when a friend introduced him to Sarthak Educational Trust's Thane Center. Joining Sarthak marked the beginning of a remarkable transformation. During the three-month training program,

Chetan enhanced his communication through sign language, learned essential workplace etiquette, and gained professional skills tailored to the hospitality sector. More importantly, he found confidence – the belief that his disability did not define his destiny.

Chetan's hard work and determination soon bore fruit. With Sarthak's placement support, he cleared an interview and secured a position as an F&B Steward at DoubleTree by Hilton, Thane. From handling crates in a backroom to welcoming guests in a premium hotel — the change was profound. His crisp uniform and warm smile became symbols of pride for his entire family.

Today, after completing one successful year at Hilton and earning ₹2.76 LPA, Chetan stands tall — financially independent and emotionally fulfilled. He now contributes to his household income and

supports his sisters' needs, bringing a sense of dignity and stability to his family.

Expressing his gratitude, Chetan signs with a radiant smile,

"Sarthak changed my life. From lifting goods in a small shop to serving guests in a five-star hotel — it's truly a dream come true for me and my family."



From Bed Rest to Boardrooms: Rahul's Journey of Resilience

For Rahul Kumar Soni, life began with trials most would struggle to imagine. Born with over 90% locomotor disability, his childhood was defined by endless hospital visits and surgeries. The first five years of his life were spent not in playgrounds but in recovery rooms — each operation a painful yet hopeful step toward mobility.

It wasn't until the age of nine that Rahul finally took his first independent steps — a moment his family still remembers as nothing short of miraculous. Walking unlocked a world he had only dreamed of: school, friends, laughter, and a sense of belonging. From then on, Rahul's journey was driven by determination and brilliance.

His perseverance shone through when he cleared JEE Advanced in 2016, earning a coveted seat at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, one of India's premier institutions. It was a proud

milestone, proving that no physical limitation could restrain his intellectual potential.

But destiny had another test waiting. In 2021, Rahul underwent a major surgery that left him bedridden for over a year. The physical pain was immense, but the emotional toll was even greater. Yet, in that long period of uncertainty, Rahul refused to surrender.

During his recovery, he came across Trust's Sarthak Educational Gurugram Centre – a discovery that would change the course of his life once again. At Sarthak. Rahul found more than skill training; he found a community that believed in him. The team provided professional guidance, and mentoring, constant encouragement – helping him rebuild his confidence along with his career path.

Through Sarthak's placement network, Rahul and five other trainees were offered a six-month internship at Infosys. His performance spoke volumes. By the end of the internship, Rahul received a full-time offer as a System Engineer, marking the start of a new chapter.

Four years later, Rahul continues to thrive at Infosys — now as a Senior System Engineer. His career growth reflects not just his technical expertise but also his indomitable spirit.

With quiet pride, Rahul shares,

Turning Struggles into Strength: Akhilesh's Triumph Over Challenges

Life tested Akhilesh early and relentlessly. As a child, he was diagnosed with a disability that left him with only one leg. While other children ran freely in the playground, Akhilesh often sat quietly, watching from the sidelines. He longed to join them — to run, laugh, and play — but his body held him back.

What hurt him more than his physical pain were the words of others. Instead of empathy, he often faced mockery and judgment. Some people openly pointed out his disability, while others whispered cruel remarks that cut even deeper. Each word reinforced the feeling of being "different," of being seen for what he lacked rather than who he was.

Still, Akhilesh refused to give up. He completed his 10th standard and began searching for work, determined to support his family and live with dignity. But rejection

followed him everywhere. Time after time, employers turned him away — not because of his abilities, but because of his disability. The constant disappointment pushed him into despair. Nights grew longer, and he began questioning his worth as he watched his peers move ahead in life.

Yet, deep within, a small spark of hope remained. Even when his world seemed to

stand still, he believed that someday, someone would give him the chance he deserved. That day came when he received a call from Sarthak Educational Trust, informing him about free training and employment programs for persons with disabilities. For Akhilesh, it felt like a ray of light piercing through years of darkness.

Without hesitation, he joined the Sarthak Lucknow Center, hoping to rebuild his life. In the beginning, it wasn't easy — he was shy, hesitant, and afraid to speak. But as days passed, he watched his peers participating confidently in discussions and activities, and something inside him shifted. Determined to change, Akhilesh started responding in class, sharing his thoughts, and engaging with others. Slowly, his confidence began to bloom.

Through the training sessions, he learned computer skills, communication techniques, and workplace etiquette. More than

anything, he learned to believe in himself again. The quiet, withdrawn boy had now transformed into a self-assured young man ready to take on the world.

His dedication paid off when he cleared an interview with Blue Dart and was selected as a Warehouse Executive, earning ₹1.62 LPA. For Akhilesh, this wasn't just a job — it was a victory over every rejection, every doubt, and every limitation society had placed on him.

With a proud smile, Akhilesh shares,

"Many doors were closed to me because of my disability. But Sarthak gave me the confidence and skills to open new ones on my own."

From being mocked for his condition to earning his place in a respected company, Akhilesh's story stands as a powerful reminder that with determination and the right support, no challenge is too great to overcome.



Beyond Sight: Archana's Journey of Courage and Determination

For as long as she could remember, Archana Robert was known for her brilliance, optimism, and ambition. A bright student and a devoted daughter, she pursued her B.Sc. degree with dreams of building a successful career and making her family proud. But as she approached her final year, life placed before her an unexpected test — one that would change everything she knew about herself and her world.

It began subtly — letters on the page becoming blurry, colors less vivid, and lights seeming dimmer. At first, Archana brushed it aside, blaming exhaustion from long hours of studying. But the blur deepened, until one day, she could no longer ignore it. Doctors confirmed what she feared most — she was gradually losing her eyesight.

confidence now struggled to see the world around her. The darkness in her eyes slowly crept into her spirit. Her dreams — once so vivid — began to fade. "How will I study? How will I work? What will happen to my life now?" she asked herself, as tears replaced words.

Yet, even through the pain, Archana refused to let go of her dreams. After completing her

Interview after interview ended the same way — polite smiles followed by rejection. Employers admired her intelligence but doubted her capability. Every "no" was another door closed, another reminder that society often looked at her disability before her talent.

When hope seemed to be slipping away, a new light appeared. Archana learned about Sarthak Educational Trust and its training and employment program for persons with disabilities. Something inside her stirred — a belief that this could be her chance to rebuild. Without hesitation, she enrolled at the Sarthak Thane Center, ready to start anew.

At Sarthak, Archana found more than skill training — she found purpose and belonging. The sessions helped her rediscover her confidence, refine her

communication, and strengthen her professional abilities. Each day, she realized that her disability did not define her — her determination did. Slowly, the girl who once feared darkness began to shine again.

Her dedication soon bore fruit. After completing her training, Archana appeared for an interview at Datasol Cafe Pvt. Ltd. and was selected as a Salesforce Officer with a salary of ₹1.5 LPA. That offer letter symbolized more than employment — it was her victory over doubt, rejection, and fear.

Today, Archana walks forward with renewed faith and quiet pride. Her family beams with joy, seeing their daughter live with dignity and independence. From losing her sight to finding her light again, Archana's journey reminds us that true vision comes not from the eyes but from the heart that refuses to give up.

One Accident, Many Barriers—But Sravanthi Refused to Stop

What if a single moment could change your life—and the way the world sees you? For 26-year-old Birudu Sravanthi from a small village in Mahabubnagar, Telangana, that moment came unexpectedly. An accident left her unable to use her right hand, abruptly halting her plans as a B.Com aspirant. Overnight, she faced not just physical limitations, but the quiet judgments of those around her—people who doubted her independence, her capability, and even her "normalcy."

Raised in a modest household with her parents and three younger brothers, Sravanthi was no stranger to challenges. Her family had always navigated financial struggles, but what hurt more was the subtle shift in how people treated her after the accident. The onceconfident young woman now found herself underestimated, pitied, and unsure of her own potential.

The first months were the hardest. Without emotional support or a clear direction, Sravanthi often questioned her future. Could she still pursue her dreams? Could she support her family? Could she ever regain her confidence?

Then, on 15th March 2025, a turning point arrived. Sravanthi enrolled at the Hyderabad center of Sarthak Educational Trust to pursue




CRM Voice training in the ITES sector. Under the guidance of trainer Mohd Rafi, she began more than just a vocational program—she embarked on a journey of self-discovery. The training emphasized not only technical skills but also communication, workplace etiquette, and confidence-building.

The first days were challenging. Sravanthi hesitated to speak up, unsure if she could meet expectations. But the supportive environment at Sarthak gradually helped overcome these fears. her encouragement, one-on-one guidance. and practical exercises transformed her perspective. Every session strengthened not just her skill set, but also her belief in herself. She started seeing her potential clearly: that she could be an asset, not a liability.

"The accident changed how people looked at me, but Sarthak changed how I looked at myself," Sravanthi shares with a smile.

Her transformation soon bore fruit. Equipped with new skills and renewed confidence, she cracked the interview with Wipro and secured a role as an Associate in the Google Mapping Process. Today, Sravanthi earns an annual income of INR 2 LPA, working from Hyderabad, contributing to her household, and helping fund her younger brothers' education. From struggling with self-doubt to becoming a professional in a top company, Sravanthi's journey is a shining example that one accident does not define your abilities—it only redirects your path. She has shown that with the right guidance, support, and determination, barriers can be broken. and potential can flourish.



A Life Rebuilt: Chandan's Story of Determination

Life can change in an instant—and for Chandan Kumar, that change came painfully. Once a cheerful young man full of dreams and energy, Chandan had always imagined building a better future for himself and his loved ones. But a tragic accident left him with a disability, and overnight, the life he had planned seemed to slip away.

The days that followed were filled not just with physical pain, but with the weight of uncertainty. Simple tasks that had once been effortless now felt like mountains. Each step required extra effort, patience, and determination. Yet, what troubled him most was the thought of becoming a burden on his family. Sleepless nights were haunted by questions: "Will I ever work again? Will I be able to support my family? Or am I destined to always depend on others?"

Chandan's confidence wavered as opportunities seemed to vanish. Jobs he once

dreamed of felt out of reach, and while people around him expressed sympathy, some looked at him with doubt—as if his disability had erased his abilities. But deep inside, Chandan refused to surrender. He wanted to stand tall again, not just for himself, but for the family that had stood by him through every struggle.

From childhood, Chandan had known hardship. Born into a family with limited

Then, a turning point arrived. Chandan discovered Sarthak Educational Trust, an organization providing free training and employment opportunities for persons with disabilities. For the first time, he felt

that his abilities mattered. On enrolling at the GRC Center, he stepped into a place where learning, guidance, and encouragement awaited him.

The initial days were challenging. Shy and nervous, Chandan struggled to interact with others. But with patient guidance from trainers, supportive peers, and structured sessions, he began gaining confidence. Over time, he acquired vital skills—English, computer basics, workplace etiquette, CRM, and interview preparation. Each lesson strengthened not just his abilities, but also his belief in himself.

After completing his training, Chandan attended an interview at Jugnoo Security & Allied Services. His efforts paid off—he was selected as a picker with an annual package of INR 1.49 LPA. Beyond the job, he had gained self-belief, resilience, and a renewed sense of hope.

Chandan's journey shows that while life may bring unexpected challenges, determination, learning, and the right support can rebuild what seemed lost. Today, he stands proud—not just as a working professional, but as a symbol of courage and perseverance, proving that no setback can define one's potential.


Strength in Every Step – Chetan Sharma's Journey of Determination



His managers quickly recognized his dedication and enthusiasm. Today, he continues perform with consistency, earning both appreciation and financial stability. Through his job, Chetan also contributes to his household and enjoys benefits like

performance incentives and a life insurance policy – small but powerful affirmations of his independence.

Beyond his professional achievements, Chetan has become an inspiration to others around him — proof that barriers may slow you down, but they can never stop you if you keep walking with courage.

Born with a slow learning disability and speech and language impairment, Deepak grew up in a world that often saw his limitations before his light. Every day brought new challenges — understanding lessons, expressing thoughts, or simply being accepted by peers who didn't always understand his silence.

Then came another setback — a minor accident that left his leg weak, limiting his ability to stand for long hours. Physically and emotionally drained, Deepak wondered if life would ever give him a fair chance.

That chance came when he found Sarthak Educational Trust's Chennai center in early 2025. For the first time, he entered a space where ability was celebrated, not judged. The trainers at Sarthak saw beyond his disability and helped him rebuild his confidence from the ground up.

"For the first time, someone saw my potential, not my problems," Deepak says, smiling.

At Sarthak, he learned professional communication, computer literacy, and workplace readiness. More than that, he learned to believe in himself again. Through patient mentoring, peer support, and

constant encouragement, Deepak began to rediscover his strength – quiet, steady, and unshakable.

After completing his training, Deepak was placed at the Taj Hotel as a CCTV Monitor in the Security Department — a perfect role that matched his calm focus and need for a sitting-based job. Each day, he monitors the safety of hundreds of guests with unwavering diligence. His supervisors praise his integrity, discipline, and attention to detail — qualities that make him an invaluable part of the team.

Today, Deepak earns ₹3 LPA, proudly supporting his mother and living the dignity he once thought unreachable.

"This job means more than a salary," he says softly. "It means I've found my place in the world."

From a boy once misunderstood for his silence to a man respected for his calm strength, Deepak's journey reminds us that real courage doesn't always shout — sometimes, it simply endures, and quietly wins.

Madhab Bora: From Struggles to Skills — A Journey of Empowerment and Hope

Some people are born into challenges. Others are born to rise above them. Madhab Bora, a 25-year-old from the serene village of Nagaon, Assam, belongs to the latter.

Born with a congenital locomotor disability affecting both lower limbs, Madhab's early life was marked by constant hurdles — physical, emotional, and social. Coming from a low-income family of three, he faced not only financial limitations but also the invisible weight of stigma that often surrounds disability in small communities. Traveling long distances to school, struggling to keep pace with his peers, and managing his condition without proper support — every day was a test of endurance and willpower.

"I often felt like I was running a race where everyone else had a head start," he recalls softly. Yet, giving up was never an option. Madhab continued his studies with resilience.

eventually earning a B.Com degree – a personal triumph that reflected years of quiet persistence.

But even with a degree in hand, another obstacle awaited him. Without professional or technical skills, Madhab found himself unprepared for the competitive job market. Rejections piled up, and hope began to fade.

Then came the turning point. In March 2025, Madhab enrolled in the Healthcare Associate


course at Sarthak Educational Trust's Guwahati Centre. The experience was transformative. Under the patient guidance of Sarthak's trainers, he learned not just new skills — Microsoft Word, Excel, and communication techniques — but also a new way to see himself. With each completed assignment and mock interview, his confidence grew stronger.

"For the first time, I felt I belonged somewhere that believed in my potential," Madhab shares with a smile. The inclusive and encouraging environment at Sarthak became the bridge between his education and meaningful employment.

On August 8, 2025, Madhab began his professional journey as a Healthcare Associate at Herbal Life, Nagaon, earning ₹1.08 LPA. His work involves using computers to manage and record healthcare data — skills he once thought were beyond his reach.

"My journey was difficult because I lacked technical knowledge and faced many rejections," Madhab says. "But because of Sarthak Educational Trust's training and support, I'm now working proudly and supporting my family."
