

One World-One University Scholarship

UNDERGRADUATE APPLICANTS

Eligibility:

Application to this scholarship is available to all Schiller International University undergraduate students who are preparing, personally and professionally, for future leadership roles in an international setting.

Applications for the One World-One University Scholarship will only be considered during the enrollment process for new students to Schiller International University starting January 1st, 2022.

Continued eligibility is based on a series of essays and or projects to be completed during each academic year to ensure criteria is met.

- 1st Academic Year (Application process) - You must demonstrate with a minimum 750-word essay, how you have and how you intend to prepare yourself personally, for a future leadership role in an international setting. What would you like to accomplish relative to one issue starting now, in our current global environment? How will you execute this idea?
- 2nd Academic Year – (31- 60 credit hours) - You must explain with a minimum 1,000-word essay, and reflecting on your first-year essay, how you will create an action plan to develop your idea professionally.
- 3rd Academic Year – (61- 90 credit hours) –You must demonstrate with a minimum 1,250-word essay, how implementing your action plan will be accomplished. You are required to carry out your action plan during this year.
- 4th Academic Year – (91 to 120 credit hours) – You must write an essay of a minimum of 1,500 words, evaluating the effectiveness of your action plan and what ideas were successful. What might you change the next time? And now, as a leader in global change, how would you apply what you have learned in your future professional career.

- Schiller International University reserves the right to change scholarship offerings without notice at any time.
- All Essays and plans must be in English, with minimal spelling or grammatical errors and submitted at the start of academic each year.
- Scholarship applications will not be considered without the required documents.
- Scholarships are posted to student ledgers at the end of the completion of each academic year based on credit hours earned.
- All initial Scholarship applications must be received by the start of the academic year for which they are applying. Late applications will not be processed.
- Students entering the University with transfer credits will be required to complete the application based on their current academic standing based on credit hours.
- Undergraduate students are required to re-apply for this scholarship annually as outlined on the scholarship wording.
- Student must have the minimum required CGPA for this scholarship at the time of re-application.
- If an Undergraduate student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, this scholarship will be cancelled. Extenuating circumstances will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- Student must enroll for and successfully complete a minimum of 30 credit hours for each academic year in order to qualify for any scholarship. If a student is unable to attend 30 credit hours in an academic year, due to transfer credits, course availability, expected graduation, or approved Leave of Absence, the scholarship will then be awarded on a prorated per credit basis.
- Students who withdraw from the University will automatically lose all scholarship eligibility.
- Any students scheduled to receive a scholarship award must be current on their scheduled cash payments, as agreed to in their most recent Award Letter. Scholarships will not be awarded to any student who is not current or up to date on their student cash payments.
- Scholarships are limited and Schiller International University reserves the right to suspend or to terminate any and all University sponsored scholarships at any time.
- Scholarships cannot be combined.
