One World-One University Undergraduate* Scholarship

Eligibility: Application to this scholarship is available to all Schiller International University undergraduate students who are preparing, personally and professionally, for future leadership roles in an international setting.

Applications for the One World-One University Scholarship will only be considered during the enrollment process.

Eligibility will be considered towards:

- Students who demonstrate via application essay, an interest in developing international and cross-cultural competencies.
- Students who demonstrate via application essay, their intent to create strong interaction among people with diverse backgrounds.
- Students have previously demonstrated or who demonstrate via application essay, a propensity and desire to act as leaders of Global Change.
- Students who have previously demonstrated or who demonstrate via application essay, or through actions and/or ideas, their desire to foster and maintain a more sustainable environment while encouraging ideas and/or actions to reduce the overall carbon footprint on the planet.
- Students who hold citizenship from a country that Schiller International University has not enrolled previously.
- Women who enroll in the Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) program.
- ***For the Women in STEM Scholarship, this scholarship will be applicable to Undergraduate and Graduate applicants**
 - The following programs are considered STEM - Bachelor of Science and Digital Business

The One World-One University scholarships will be available to all students who are beginning their undergraduate studies at Schiller International University. This scholarship is available for the first two semesters only. Scholarship Award: Up to \$1,500.00 / €1,264.95 per semester (up to \$125.00/€105.41 per credit hour)

1. Schiller International University reserves the right to change this scholarship offerings without notice at any time.
2. Scholarships may not be combined.
3. Essays must be English, with minimal spelling or grammatical errors and submitted with the application, unless otherwise noted.
4. One World-One University Scholarship applications will not be considered without all required documents.
5. The One World-One University scholarship committee will consist of the following people by campus.
 - a. The Campus Director
 - b. The Global Head of Marketing
 - c. The Global Head of Admissions
6. The One World-One University Scholarships committee will decide on the applications of One World-One University scholarship applications within 5 business days of the receipt of the application.
7. One World-One University Scholarships will be posted to each student ledger at the end of the completion of each eligible semester.
8. All Scholarship applications must be received by the start of the first day of the starting semester at Schiller International University. Late applications will not be processed.
9. The One World-One University scholarship is awarded for the first two semesters only. After the second semester, students are encouraged to apply for an academic scholarship.
10. Student must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours for each semester to qualify for any One World-One University scholarship. If a student is unable to attend 12 hours in a semester due to transfer credits, course availability, the scholarship will then be awarded on a prorated per credit basis.
11. Students who withdraw from the University are subject to loss of scholarship eligibility.
12. Any students scheduled to receive a scholarship award must be current on their scheduled cash payments, as agreed to in their most recent Award Letter. Scholarships will not be awarded to any student who is not current or up to date on their student cash payments. The Campus Director will maintain final authority on this issue.
13. The One World-One University Scholarships are limited, and Schiller International University reserves the right to pause or discontinue all University scholarships at any time. Applications will be reviewed on a first come first served basis.

One World-One University Scholarship Essay Questions

To be considered for the One World-One University Scholarship, all applicants are required to choose one of the essay questions below and provide an essay answer to the question selected.

- Your essay must be a minimum of 500 words and must reflect your thoughts and opinions.
 - Your essay must have a minimum of three paragraphs and written in proper format with minimal spelling and grammatical errors. To ensure fairness a grading rubric will be used to evaluate each essay.
1. **Diversity:** Every student has a background, identity, interest, or talent that is so meaningful they believe their application would be incomplete without it. What is it about you that is unique and how can you apply it to the world?
 2. **Social Media:** If your goal in life was to be a social media entrepreneur, what would your business plan be, how would you market it; has your past experiences helped or hurt your overall presence?
 3. **Global Leader:** How do you define Global Leadership and how does your Global view of our planet change with your ideas? A good leader sees it from both sides and makes a calculated decision, so give a positive and negative solution and outcome.
 4. **Sustainable Environment:** Imagine that you could change one of the 3 pillars of Sustainability, which are economic, social, or environmental. Which one would you choose, how would you choose it and why?
 5. **Citizenship:** There are many countries that an International University has yet to foster. If you are the first from your country to attend Schiller International University, then what it would mean for you to represent your country, your culture and background.
 6. **Women in STEM:** This scholarship is for women in the STEM field. What does it mean to you to be part of this incredible movement and what aspirational goals do you have for the future of humankind?
