- 1. Schiller International University reserves the right to change scholarship offerings without notice at any time.
- 2. Essays must be in English, with minimal spelling or grammatical errors and submitted with the application, unless otherwise noted.
- 3. Scholarship applications will not be considered without the required documents.
- 4. Scholarships are posted to student ledgers at the end of the completion of each eligible semester.
- 5. All initial Scholarship applications must be received by the start of the semester for which they are applying. Late applications will not be processed.
- 6. Undergraduate students are not required to re-apply for a scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA for that scholarship.
- 7. After an Undergraduate student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.
- 8. If an Undergraduate student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:
 - Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
 - Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
 - Student must re-apply with new application and essay.
 - The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.
- 9. Graduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.
- 10. After a Graduate student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester.
- 11. If the Graduate student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:
 - Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
 - Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
 - Student must re-apply with new application and essay.
 - The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.



- 12. Student must enroll for and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours for each semester in order to qualify for any scholarship. If a student is unable to attend 12 hours in a semester due to transfer credits, course availability, expected graduation, or approved Leave of Absence, the scholarship will then be awarded on a prorated per credit basis.
- 13. Students who withdraw from the University will automatically lose all scholarship eligibility.
- 14. Any students scheduled to receive a scholarship award must be current on their scheduled cash payments, as agreed to in their most recent Award Letter. Scholarships will not be awarded to any student who is not current or up to date on their student cash payments.
- 15. Scholarships are limited and Schiller International University reserves the right to suspend or to terminate any and all University sponsored scholarships at any time.

- In order to apply for a Scholarship at Schiller International University, applicants are required to pick one question below to answer.
- Your answer must be a minimum of 500 words (750 words for Academic Excellence Undergraduate Scholarship) and a minimum of three paragraphs and must reflect your thoughts and opinions.
- Scholarship application essays will be reviewed for thoughtfulness, clarity, and expression of ideas. Your essay should demonstrate your interests, your background, and most importantly, give the University an idea of who you are.

PICK ONE QUESTION TO ANSWER

For the <u>Academic Excellence Undergraduate Scholarship</u>, you must answer question #1 or #4 ONLY (750 words minimum).

- 1. In your opinion, what are the two biggest issues facing the industry relative to your degree program? How would you go about resolving them?
- 2. What are your strengths as a person, and as a student? What are your weaknesses as a person, and as a student? Go in depth with your answer.
- 3. What have you failed at in your life? How did you or how would you overcome and succeed at that failure?
- 4. If you could pick one person from history and sit down and chat with them, who would it be and why? Go in depth with your answer.
