Your child has signed up to enter the Google Science Fair, a global science competition made possible by Google in partnership with Virgin Galactic, LEGO Education, National Geographic and Scientific American.

Your child will be submitting a project online to compete with students from all over the world for incredible prizes, scholarships, and once in a lifetime opportunities, such as a trip to the Galapagos Islands. For your child to enter this competition, we require your permission.

If you do not give permission by the parental or guardian consent deadline of December 12th, 2018, your child cannot submit their project or participate in the Google Science Fair. For projects for which there is no parental consent, all Google Science Fair account and project information will immediately be deleted following the 2018 consent deadline. Google Science Fair will not use account or project information for any purpose outside of the 2018 Google Science Fair competition. This parental consent is between Google, LLC, and you, as parent or legal guardian of a child who would like to enter the Google Science Fair. The Google Science Fair is an international science and engineering competition for students, ages 13-18. Students will submit their science or engineering projects online to compete for internships, scholarships, and other great prizes, including a trip to the Galapagos Islands.

To participate, your child must be 13 years old on, or before, December 12th, 2018, and he or she must be 18 years old, or younger, as of September 13th, 2018. If your child lives in Israel or South Korea, he or she must be 14 years old on, or before December 12th, 2018, and he or she must be 18 years old, or younger, as of September 13th, 2018. If your child lives in one of the [28 member countries in the European Union](#) they must be at least 16 years of age as of December 12th, 2018. Please note that your child will not be able to register until they turn the minimum age for entry.



By submitting this parental consent, you agree to the following terms and conditions: I have read and understood the rules for the Google Science Fair. As parent and legal guardian of my child, I permit him/her to participate in the Science Fair described in the [Science Fair Rules](#), available at [www.googlesciencefair.com](http://www.googlesciencefair.com).

Furthermore, my child and I agree to be bound by the [Science Fair Rules](#) and the terms of this parental consent. I, as parent and legal guardian of my child, affirm that my child is between the ages of 13 and 18 years old. If he/she is 13 or 18 years old, I affirm that he/she turned 13 years old on or before December 12th, 2018, or that he/she was 18 years old as of September 13th, 2018. If my child lives in Israel or South Korea, I affirm that he/she turned 14 years old on, or before December 12th, 2018 or that he/she was 18 years old as of September 13th, 2018. If my child lives in one of the [28 member countries in the European Union](#), I affirm that he/she turned 16 years old on or before December 12th, 2018 or that he/she was 18 years old as of September 13th, 2018.

I understand that participation in a Science Fair involves a certain degree of risk, which could result in injury or other unintended consequences.

My child's participation in the Google Science Fair is voluntary, and as such, I agree to be solely responsible for my child's safety while he/she is working on his/her science project. I am aware of the risks involved, and take full responsibility, and waive any claims of personal injury or damage to personal property associated with my child's participation in the Google Science Fair.
