Helping young people fulfil their potential

In recent years, Trefoil has awarded around £120,000 in total annually across the main funding themes of sport, art, music, life skills and adventure.

Who can apply?

Trefoil offers 3 different types of grants:

Personal Development Grant

For young people under the age of 25 with additional needs which may be psycho/social or of a physical nature which impacts upon their development.

Organisational Grant

For organisations whose aims and objectives comply with Trefoil's own. Trefoil funds a wide variety of projects with different organisations across Scotland.

Lilias Finlay Holiday Fund

To individuals, families or small groups who meet Trefoil's criteria for development needs. Applicants must be under the age of 18, resident in Scotland, and wishing to apply for a UK based holiday.
