- The Aztecs have won at least 20 games in a school-record six straight seasons and 25 or more in three consecutive seasons.
- San Diego State has advanced to postseason play each of the last six seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-11 NCAA).

Trends:

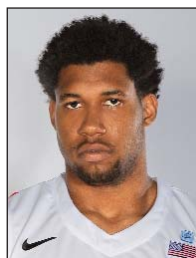
- SDSU has won 62 of the last 66 dating back to the 2006-07 season when scoring at least 71 points.

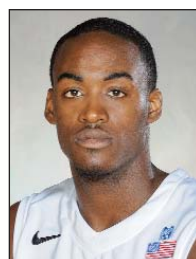

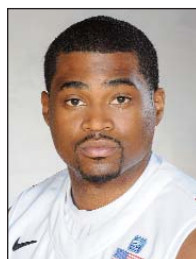
