Team Notes

- San Diego State snapped an eight-game losing streak against Arizona and earned its first win against the Wildcats since 1999.
- SDSU pitchers registered 16 total strikeouts, the team's highest total since striking out 16 against UC Riverside on Feb. 20, 2015.
- San Diego State has won four of its last five extra-inning games.
- SDSU has won four consecutive games against Pac-12 opponents.
- The SDSU bullpen so far in the 2018 season: 1.01 ERA, 3-1 record, 26.2 innings pitched, 19 hits allowed, three earned runs, five walks, 32 strikeouts, .194 opponent batting average.
- In the first five games of the season, SDSU pitching has recorded three games with 13 or more strikeouts. The last time SDSU has posted 13 or more strikeouts in three games over a five-game span was April 24 - May 1, 2009. During that run, current MLB pitchers Stephen Strasburg and Addison Reed combined for 17 strikeouts in a 4-3 win against TCU on April 24, 2009.
- San Diego State is outpitching its opponents .285 - .190 through the first five games of the season. SDSU has a 1.53 team ERA on the season while tagging opposing pitchers for a 5.36 ERA.
- SDSU's 4-1 start to the 2018 season is the team's best start through five games since starting 2015 season 5-0.
- Seven of the 10 pitchers SDSU has used this season are averaging nine strikeouts per nine innings pitched or more.

Player Notes

Jacob Erickson: 4.2 IP, 0 R, 7 K, 0 BB, 2 H

- Set a new career-high with seven strikeouts.
- Matched his career-high in strikeouts against the first five batters he faced, striking out each of the first five batters he faced.
- Recorded his longest outing since making a 7-inning start as a freshman in the Mountain West tournament against New Mexico on May 23, 2015.
- Has held opponents scoreless in 25 of his last 35 outings.

Jacob Maekawa: 1-for-3, R, BB

- Scored game-winning run on wild pitch in the top of the 10th inning.
- Made Sportscenter's Top 10 at No. 3 with diving play at second base in the top of the eighth inning.

Chase Calabuig: 1-for-4, 2B, 2 RBI

- Extended his hitting streak to 12 games and his on-base streak to 19 games. Also extended his on-base streak in home games to 24 games.
- Recorded his 22nd career game with multiple RBIs.
- Team is 17-6 in Calabuig's last 23 starts in right field.

David Hensley: 2-for-5, R

- Recorded his 44th career multi-hit game.
- Currently riding a five-game hitting streak, being one of two Aztec players (Calabuig) to have a hit in each of the first five games this season.

Jorge Fernandez: 1.2 IP, W, 3 K

- Struck out three of the six batters he faced.
- Has kept opponents scoreless in seven of his last 10 outings.
