## Aztecs Open 2005 Season With Doubleheader Against UC Riverside and Cal State Fullerton

• The No. 71 San Diego State women's tennis opens the 2005 season with a doubleheader against UC Riverside (0-0) and Cal State Fullerton (0-2) at Barnes Tennis Center on Saturday. The first half of the doubleheader, against UC Riverside, begins at 9 a.m., with the Cal State Fullerton match to follow at 3 p.m.

The Aztecs will try to win their 10th straight season opener when they face the Highlanders Saturday morning. The UC Riverside match marks the first time in three years that the Aztecs have not opened up against Long Beach State.

All-time versus member schools of the Big West Conference, SDSU is 60-5 with its five losses coming to UC Irvine.

## Mattera on the Mesa

• The 2005 season marks Peter Mattera's 24th season on Montezuma Mesa and his 12th as San Diego State's head coach. In his 11 seasons at the helm, Mattera has compiled a career record of 171-104 (.622) and has guided seven teams to the NCAA tournament. What is more impressive is that nine of his 11 squads have finished with an overall record of .500 or better.

## The Future is Now

• The Aztecs return five players from last year's 9-15 (4-3 MWC) team. Among the returners are 2004 MWC all-conference selection and 81st-ranked player, junior Dita Hauerlandova, and one half of last year's all-conference doubles team in senior Indra Erichsen. Also returning are juniors Andrea Hermansen and Sarah Sansom and sophomore Alesya Vidov. In addition to the five returners, this year's squad welcomes four freshmen - Carla Bell, Eliska Krausova, Sisse Nielsen and Nina Spaeth.

## Fall Wrap Up

• SDSU wrapped up the fall season with a strong showing at the SDSU Fall Tennis Classic in October. Hauerlandova reached the final of the singles-flight 'A' bracket and along with Erichsen, fell in the doubles bracket final.

At the Wilson/ITA Regionals at Barnes Tennis Center, Vidov defeated UC Riverside's Michelle Beyronneau, 6-2, 6-3, to advance to the round of 32.

In her second match, the sophomore downed the tournament's 9-16 seed from Arizona State, Joslynn Burkett, 6-0, 6-1.

In the round of 16, No. 7 seed Nicole Leimbach of

Southern California beat Vidov in straight sets 6-0, 6-2.

## Scouting the Highlanders

• UC Riverside is coming off a season in which it finished 10-11 overall and 3-4 in Big West Conference play.

The Highlanders are led by head coach Mark Henry and senior Michelle Beyronneau who finished the fall season with a record of 7-5.

## Scouting the Titans

• Cal State Fullerton heads into the San Diego State match having lost two straight to

open the season. The Titans dropped a 7-0 decision at Cal Poly in the Big West opener last Saturday and then fell to Santa Clara, 5-2, at San Luis Obispo the following day.

Cal State Fullerton is led by 16th-year head coach Bill Reynolds and its four seniors, Nicole Arias, Caroline Freeman, Carla Rocha and Ioana Sisoe.

## Series History vs. UC Riverside

• The 2005 lidlifter with the Highlanders marks the first meeting between the two schools. SDSU is 63-52 all-time against UC-member schools.

## Series History vs. Cal State Fullerton

• San Diego State heads into the match with the Titans with an all-time record of 18-0. The 18 victories is the fifth most versus any opponent in program history. The meeting is the first between the two schools in over 11 years.
