Gameday Tidbits

- Today's game will tipoff at 1:05 p.m. PT.
- **The game between UNLV and San Diego State is the only game today between two top-25 teams.**
- For the second consecutive season, San Diego State forward **Tim Shelton** has written and performed a song about the Aztec basketball team. A 66-second version of the 3:10 song will be played as the intro video prior to the announcement of the San Diego State starting lineup. This year's song, entitled "Aztec Motto," is making its debut today.
- Former San Diego State wide receiver **J.R. Tolver** is scheduled to lead the SDSU student section in the pregame "I Believe" chant. Tolver was a member of the Aztec Football team from 1998-2002.
- San Diego State postgame interviews will take place on the mezzanine level room of Viejas Arena (credential required). UNLV postgame interviews will take place outside their locker room in the North corridor.

Tapley Among National Leaders

- San Diego State junior guard **Chase Tapley** moved up to third in the country in three-point field-goal percentage in the latest NCAA Ratings (through Thursday's games).
- Tapley is shooting 50.0 percent from beyond the arc, having made 43-of-86 attempts from beyond the arc. The 43 makes are a career-high, surpassing his sophomore campaign effort of 41.
- Tapley has a three-point field goal in 15 consecutive games and multiple treys in 10 consecutive outings.

12,414

- Saturday's San Diego State-UNLV game is sold out. The official attendance for the game is 12,414.
- This is the fifth home sellout of the season and the 15th time in the last 23 home games.
- It is the 26th sellout in Viejas Arena history.

Winning Streaks At Stake On Saturday

- San Diego State has won 21 consecutive games against the current configuration of the Mountain West Conference.
- San Diego State has won 19 consecutive home games against the current configuration of the Mountain West Conference.
- San Diego State has won seven consecutive games.
- San Diego State has won seven consecutive games when wearing white uniforms.
- San Diego State has won six consecutive home games.
- San Diego State has won six consecutive games played on Saturdays.
- San Diego State has won a school-record five straight games against UNLV.
- San Diego State has won four straight conference openers.
- San Diego State has won three consecutive games played in January.
- San Diego State has won two straight games against teams ranked in the AP Top 25 at game time. The Aztecs have never won three straight games against nationally ranked opponents.
