### Aztecs Travel to Loaded Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Palm Springs Area

The San Diego State softball team hits the road for the first time of the season this weekend at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in the Palm Springs area.

The Aztecs (8-2), who are receiving votes in both major national polls, will play Cal State Fullerton (2:30 p.m. PT) and No. 18/18 Kentucky (5:30 p.m. PT) on Thursday, Brigham Young at 8 p.m. PT Friday, and Ohio State (3 p.m. PT) and No. 8/10 Washington (8 p.m. PT) on Saturday. SDSU's five opponents have combined for a 32-14-1 (.691) record so far this season and three - Cal State Fullerton (6-4), Kentucky (8-2) and Washington (9-2) - joined San Diego State in the 2022 NCAA tournament.

The Aztecs have been impressive in all three phases of the game, owning a .333 average (27th in NCAA out of 276 teams), 2.20 ERA (64th) and a .974 fielding percentage (63rd).

Jillian Celis leads the SDSU offense with a .419 average (13-for-31) to go along with two home runs, seven RBIs, six runs, four walks and a .472 on-base percentage, while Bella Espinoza is hitting an even .400 (14-for-35) with 10 runs and seven stolen bases. Macey Keester (.381, 4 R, 5 RBI) and Mac Barbara (.367, 2 HR, 11 RBI, 6 R, 6 BB, .472 OBP) are also batting over .350 for San Diego State.

Barbara was named the Mountain West Player of the Week on Tuesday after batting .533 (8-for-15) last weekend with a home run, six RBIs, four runs, a double, two walks, a .800 slugging percentage and a .588 on-base mark.

Four pitchers have logged between 14 and 19 innings for the Aztecs, including Dani Martinez (3-0, 0.86 ERA, 16.1 IP), Dee Dee Hernandez (2-0, 1.84 ERA, 2 SV, 19.0 IP), Sarah Lehman (2-0, 2.10 ERA, 16.2 IP) and Allie Light (1-2, 2.44 ERA, 3 SV, 14.1 IP).

Weather permitting, all five of SDSU's games will be broadcast on FloSoftball and can be purchased via pay-per-view.

**STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ**  
HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON (15TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 47-19 (.705) as head coach at San Diego State.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

### Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic Information

Riding the momentum of a second straight 4-1 weekend, the Aztecs head to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, California (Palm Springs area).

The Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic, formerly the Cathedral City Classic, is one of the largest and most competitive Division I softball tournaments outside of the NCAA tournament. This year's tourney features 30 teams, including five of the eight Women's College World Series teams from last year. The entire tournament is held at Big League Dreams park across five fields.

The tournament is named after Mary Nutter, who started the National Sports Clinics (NSC) more than 25 years ago to provide softball coaches at all levels access to the highest quality instruction. Nutter passed away from a heart attack on July 24, 2012, and the tournament was renamed in her honor for the 2013 edition.

Tournament passes are available for \$90, while single-day tickets for Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday are \$35 for adults, \$17 for seniors (65 or older) or students (U17), and \$10 for children between the age of 3-10.

The Aztecs play games against Cal State Fullerton (2:30 p.m. PT) and No. 18/18 Kentucky (5:30 p.m. PT) on Thursday, Brigham Young at 8 p.m. PT Friday, and Ohio State (3 p.m. PT) and No. 8/10 Washington (8 p.m. PT) on Saturday.

All five games will be broadcast live on FloSoftball (shortened link - <https://flosports.link/3LYK8dW>) and available via pay-per-view, and all are expected to have live stats.

### Mac Barbara Named Mountain West Player of the Week

San Diego State softball's Mac Barbara has been named the Mountain West Player of the Week, the league announced Tuesday. It is the second career weekly conference award for the Long Beach, California, native.

Barbara led the Aztecs to a 4-1 record last weekend with their only loss coming to No. 24/24 Oregon by a 6-4 score. SDSU beat a pair of 2022 NCAA tournament teams in Wichita State (3-2) and LMU (3-0), and also dispatched UC Riverside (7-4) and Utah Valley (6-1).

Barbara batted .533 (8-for-15) with a home run, six RBIs, four runs, a double, two walks, a .800 slugging percentage and a .588 on-base mark. Barbara, who had at least one hit in all five games and two apiece in the first three games, led San Diego State in batting average, hits, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs (tied), RBIs, home runs (tied), doubles (tied) and walks (tied). Additionally, Barbara was perfect in the field at first base and catcher in 36 chances.

Barbara was 2-for-3 in a 3-2 Aztec win over Wichita State on Thursday. She then went 2-for-3 with an RBI and a run in a 7-4 win over UC Riverside on Friday and 2-for-3 with an RBI in SDSU's 3-0 victory over LMU on Friday night. Barbara had a two-run home run against No. 24/24 Oregon in a 6-4 San Diego State loss on Saturday before going 1-for-1 with two RBIs, two runs, a double and a walk in a 6-1 Aztec win over Utah Valley in the nightcap.

On the season, Barbara is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with two home runs, 11 RBIs, six runs, a double and six walks, slugging .600 with a .472 on-base percentage.

In the USA Today/NFCA poll released on Feb. 21, the Aztecs have 10 points, the 28th most in the poll and highest "ranking" of the season. The 12 votes are 33rd most in the poll. Baylor is 25th in the poll with 90 points. Those receiving votes include Arizona State (82), Michigan (14), SDSU (10), North Texas (9), Texas A&M (7), Louisiana (6), Wichita State (4), Cal State Fullerton (2), Brigham Young (1), Charlotte (1) and Mississippi State (1).

UCLA is the top team in the poll with 797 points and 29 of the 32 first-place votes, followed by two-time defending champion Oklahoma with 759 and three first-place votes.

In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25, meanwhile, San Diego State has seven points for the 30th most, also its highest "ranking" of the year. No. 25 UCF has 63 points, while the receiving votes group also includes Texas A&M (54), Louisiana (33), Arizona State (19), Brigham Young (17), Mississippi State (6), Cal State Fullerton (4), Louisville (3), North Texas (2), Charlotte (2) and California (1).

UCLA is also the favorite in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 with 625 points and all 25 first-place votes. A full list of the top 25 polls are on the right column of page 3.

**Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters**

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980.

Following a 5-4 victory over CSUN on Feb. 9, the Aztecs improved to 33-11 (.750) in lid-lifters in recorded program history.

SDSU has won 10 of its last 11 season openers, 21 of its last 23 and 24 of its last 27.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 27 season-openers came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 27 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 154-85, or 5.7-3.1 per game in lid-lifters.

SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over USD on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on a opening day since 2008.

**Aztecs Picked Second in MW Preseason Poll**

The defending Mountain West champion San Diego State softball team was picked to finish second in the MW in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Feb. 2. The Aztecs have won a MW-record eight regular-season titles entering the 2023 season.

The Aztecs received 60 votes and four first-place votes, and finished just one point behind projected league winner Boise State's 61 and five first-place votes. UNLV finished third in the preseason voting with 48 points, while Colorado State was picked fourth with 36 points. Fresno State, Nevada and San Jose State finished fifth with 25 points. Rounding out the poll was New Mexico (23) in eighth and Utah State (21) in ninth.

Last year, San Diego State finished the 2022 season with a 39-16 record (.709), the second-best record in program history, before falling to No. 8/5 Arizona State, 8-4, in the NCAA Tempe Regional final. San Diego State also captured its league-record eighth MW title with a 20-4 conference record.

The Aztecs begin their 2023 season under second-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz with the SDSU season kickoff Feb. 9-12.

**Mac Barbara Named to USA Softball Player of the Year Watch List**

San Diego State sophomore Mac Barbara (Long Beach, Calif.) has been named to the 2023 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List, USA Softball announced on Jan. 25. Barbara is one of 50 players on the list.

Barbara becomes the fourth Aztec to be named to the watch list joining Aztec greats such as Erin Floros (2007), Hayley Miles (2013 and 2014), and Jenavee Peres (2017 and 2018). Additionally, head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz won Collegiate Player of the Year during her playing days in 2002 while at UCLA.

Barbara is the only representative from the Mountain West on the list of 50 student-athletes.

In 2022 Barbara was named a third-team NFCA All-American, first-team all-NFCA West Region selection, the Mountain West Player of the Year, and was a finalist for the Schutt Sports/NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year as a redshirt freshman. During the 2022 campaign she batted .395 (68-for-172) with 18 home runs, 61 RBIs, 32 runs, 14 doubles and a triple for a .802 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base mark. Barbara, who reached base safely in 40 consecutive games from Feb. 17-May 6, which was the longest streak in the country in 2022 and set a program record, finished the season tied for 14th in the country in RBIs (61), 16th in total bases (138), 26th in slugging percentage (.802) and tied for 28th in home runs (18).

Among the Aztec single-season leaders, Barbara ranked second in RBIs (61) in 2022, third in total bases (138), tied for third in home runs (18) and extra-base hits (33), fourth in on-base percentage (.493), slugging percentage (.802) and OPS percentage (1.295), tied for fourth in walks (34), tied for sixth in doubles (14), seventh in batting average (.395) and eighth in hits (68).
