### @AztecWBB Welcomes Utah State for MW Home Opener

Winners of three straight, the San Diego State women's basketball team looks to keep the momentum rolling on Saturday when it entertains Utah State in its Mountain West home opener at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena. Game time is set for 2 p.m. PT. SDSU alumnus Chris Ello will handle the play-by-play responsibilities for a live video stream via the MW Network on GoAztecs.com.

Saturday's matchup will also feature a free T-shirt giveaway to the first 250 fans in attendance to go along with Bingo Day festivities. Spectators can pick up a bingo card upon entry and play throughout the game for a chance to win an autographed team basketball.

The Aztecs are coming off an inspiring 84-77 victory at Wyoming on Wednesday, sinking 9 of their final 10 free attempts after the Cowgirls trimmed a 12-point deficit down to three with 52 seconds left on the clock. Sophomore McKynzie Fort (Fontana, Calif.) led the SDSU charge with 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting, while senior Ahjaleé Harvey (Mountain View, Calif.) finished with a career-high 19 points of her own. Conversely, the Aggies have lost three in a row, including an 86-74 defeat at the hands of San José State in their conference opener.

SDSU and Utah State will play each other twice during the regular season after meeting just once in 2015. The Aztecs came away with a 70-59 triumph in Logan last year, draining 16 of 21 foul shots in the second half to keep the Aggies at bay. In addition, SDSU limited USU's leading scorer Funda Nakkasoglu, the eventual MW Freshman of the Year, to just eight points. With the win, the Aztecs raised their record to 5-1 in the all-time series. SDSU is 3-0 against the Aggies in San Diego, including a 132-64 conquest on Dec. 16, 1983, when the Scarlet and Black established a program record for most points in a single game.

The Aztecs are 6-10 all-time in MW home openers, dropping four out of their last five including a 56-44 setback to Fresno State a year ago. SDSU's lone victory during that stretch was a 61-46 conquest of former league member TCU on Jan. 11, 2012.

Individually, the Aztecs are led by Fort, who ranks fifth in the Mountain West in scoring (15.6 ppg) and eighth in steals (2.1/gm) while occupying the ninth position in free-throw percentage (.661). In addition, fellow sophomore Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.) shares the 10th spot in three-pointers made (1.4/gm), while junior Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.) is 12th in steals (1.8/gm).

Collectively, SDSU ranks among in the top half of the league in three-point field goal percentage defense (5th - .312) and turnover margin (T-5th - (+1.1/gm)). The Aztecs have outscored their last three opponents by an 84-66 margin in the paint.

Following Saturday's clash, San Diego State will hit the road for a mid-week encounter at San José State on Wednesday, Jan. 6. Game time in Silicon Valley is scheduled for 7 p.m. PT.

## Scouting the Aggies

Utah State (5-7, 0-1 MW) has dropped three straight, including an 86-74 setback to San José State in its conference opener at home on Wednesday night. The Aggies enjoyed a 35-31 lead at intermission before the Spartans exploded for 55 points in the second half, including 30 in the fourth quarter alone. USU was paced by sophomore Funda Nakkasoglu, who scored 22 points, including a 10-for-10 effort at the free-throw line, while senior Julianne Anchling (15 pts.) and freshman Rachel Brewster (12 pts.) reached double figures as well.

Nakkasoglu, who garnered MW Freshman of the Year accolades last season, leads the conference in scoring (20.5 ppg), highlighted by a career-high 37-point performance in a home victory over Pacific on Nov. 21. The 5-7 guard finds herself among the MW leaders in several additional categories, including assists (4th - 4.6/gm), free-throw percentage (4th - (.850)), three-pointers made (7th - 1.6/gm) and three-point field goal percentage (10th - (.352)). Nakkasoglu (19), Anchling (17) and Brewster (11) are the main threats from long range, combining for 47 of the team's 60 three-pointers.

The Aggies have also received a boost from senior Tijana Djukic (9.3 ppg), who ranks sixth in the conference in blocked shots (1.3/gm), seventh in rebounds (6.8/gm) and eighth in field-goal percentage (.511).

As a team, USU is currently second in the MW in scoring offense with 72.3 points per game. The Aggies also occupy the third spot in both field-goal percentage (.406) and free-throw percentage (.724), while their three-point field goal clip (.305) is fourth. However, USU has had trouble on defense this season, allowing 73.8 points per contest, which ranks 10th in the league entering the weekend.

The Aggies boast five international players on their roster, including Nakkasoglu and Brewster (Australia), Anchling (France), Djukic (Serbia) and junior Angelica de Paulo (Brazil).

Head coach Jerry Finkbeiner is in his fourth season at the helm of the Aggie program after spending 16 years at Oral Roberts. He also coached for six seasons at his alma mater Southern Nazarene in Bethany, Okla. Finkbeiner collected his 500th career victory vs. SJSU at home on Jan. 4, 2014.

### Notes With a 'W'

An SDSU victory over Utah State on Saturday will mean:

- The Aztecs post their first four-game winning streak in head coach Stacie Terry's tenure and improve to 7-6 on the season.
- SDSU captures its first Mountain West home opener since beating TCU on Jan. 11, 2012.
- The Aztecs start 2-0 in conference play for the first time since 2012. The Scarlet and Black won their first seven that season before falling on the road to TCU.
- SDSU raises its record to 6-1 vs. the Aggies all-time and 4-0 in San Diego.
- The Aztecs move to 2-0 in Saturday games this season.

### Aztecs-Aggies: The Last Time We Met

Balanced scoring, timely free-throw shooting and an opportunistic defense were all on display as San Diego State pulled away for a 70-59 victory over Utah State in a Mountain West game at Dee Glen Smith Spectrum on Jan. 31, 2015.

The Aztecs had three players finish with double-digit scoring totals, led by junior Erimma Amarikwa, who tallied a game-high 17 points, highlighted by a career-best nine free throws. Freshman McKynzie Fort also got into the act with 15 points on 6-for-12 shooting, while senior Kristina Hunter chipped 11 points of her own to help snap SDSU's two-game losing streak.

Despite a 43-38 rebounding deficiency, the Aztecs scored 22 points off 20 Aggie turnovers and sank 20 of 26 free throws, including a 16-for-21 clip in the second half.

After the two teams witnessed six lead changes and four ties to start the game, SDSU went ahead to stay 25-22, following two Fort free throws and a Hunter layup with 2:26 left in the first half. USU (6-15, 3-6 MW) quickly cut the margin to one on a basket by Funda Nakkasoglu, but a clutch three-pointer by sophomore Aleiah Brandon on the Aztecs' next possession ignited an 8-4 spurt to give the visitors a 33-28 advantage at intermission.

Following the break, SDSU maintained the momentum with a 14-6 surge in a span of 6:35 to open a 13-point bulge at 47-34. Junior Ahjaleé Harvey came up huge during the run, burying her first three-point-er in 11 games, while Amarikwa drained four foul shots. In the interim,

the Aggies dug themselves a hole, misfiring on six of eight shots from the floor while committing three turnovers.

However, USU methodically crawled back into contention as two free throws by Julianne Anchling capped a 12-2 outburst that trimmed the Aztec lead to 49-46 with 7:31 remaining.

With the tide turning in the Aggies' favor, SDSU promptly righted the ship as Amarikwa scored six consecutive points to spark a decisive 16-6 blitz over the next five minutes that restored the Aztecs' double-digit advantage at 65-52 by the 2:08 mark. Fort connected on two key baskets during the run, while senior Desi Culberson added a pair of free throws to put the Scarlet and Black in complete control.

USU trimmed the deficit to single digits at 67-59 on a triple by Franny Vaalu, but only 1:22 remained on the clock. Fort then added a layup and a free throw down the stretch to provide the contest its final outcome.

### Rewind: SDSU-Wyoming Recap

San Diego State employed timely runs, a strong interior presence and ultimately some clutch free-throw shooting to register an 84-77 triumph over Wyoming on Wednesday in the Mountain West opener for both schools at Arena-Auditorium.

The Aztecs (6-6, 1-0 MW) connected on a season-best 51.7 percent of their field-goal attempts (31-60) and committed just seven turnovers to even their overall record and help snap the Cowgirls' (7-4, 0-1 MW) four-game winning streak.

Despite a slight 35-33 rebounding deficiency, SDSU outscored Wyoming 44-34 in the paint and tallied 17 points off 13 Cowgirl turnovers to win for the third time in its last four trips to Laramie. In addition, the Aztecs drained 18 of 25 foul shots, including a 9-for-10 performance in the final 1:03 to seal the victory.

Individually, SDSU was led by sophomore McKynzie Fort, who scored 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting to go with five rebounds, while senior Ahjaleé Harvey established a career-best with 19 points, highlighted by a pair of triples. The Aztec cause was also advanced by sophomore Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.), who tossed in 13 points of her own, while junior Ariell Bostick tied for game-high honors with 10 rebounds.

SDSU persevered despite a heroic effort from Wyoming freshman Marta Gomez, who led all scorers with 27 points on 10-of-15 shooting, including a 6-for-10 clip from beyond the arc. In addition, the Cowgirls received double-doubles from sophomore Natalie Baker (19 points, 10 rebounds) and senior Marquelle Dent (10 points, 11 assists), while sophomore Liv Roberts reached double figures as well with 13 points. However, Wyoming got little help from its reserves as the Aztecs owned a sizable 28-6 advantage in bench scoring.

The Cowgirls raced to a 15-4 lead by the 5:21 mark of the opening period after sinking their first three shots from downtown. SDSU quickly regrouped at this juncture, unleashing a 15-0 blitz over the remainder of the quarter to vault in front for good. Greenhouse notched six straight points to ignite the run, while Fort added a pair of jumpers to give the visitors a 19-15 edge.

Wyoming kept things close through the first five minutes of the second stanza, narrowing the gap to 27-24 after another Gomez hoop. Moments later, the Aztecs responded with an 11-2 spurt to build a 38-26 bulge by the 2:30 mark of the quarter. Harvey buried two treys during the run, while sophomore Lexy Thorderson added another three-ball to give the Scarlet and Black its largest cushion of the half. However, the Cowgirls managed to trim the margin to single digits just before intermission at 40-33 on a Roberts jumper, followed quickly by a Dent layup.

Despite baskets by Harvey and Bostick on consecutive possessions early in the third quarter, momentum was clearly on Wyoming's side as Gomez drilled a three-pointer, while Baker soon followed with a layup to punctuate a 9-4 surge that tightened the score at 44-42 with 7:24 left in the period. As was the case the entire game, however, SDSU withstood the challenge, fashioning a crucial 16-6 run over the ensuing six minutes to reclaim a double-digit advantage at 60-48. Sophomore Geena Gomez scored five straight points during the outburst, while Fort converted an and-one opportunity as the Aztecs seemed primed to break the game open.

Wyoming received a boost from Skyler Snodgrass, who promptly nailed a triple to close out the scoring in the third quarter, but SDSU extended the margin back to 12 at 66-54 by the 6:26 mark of the fourth period following a pair of Fort free throws and a layup by Greenhouse. The Cowgirls threw one last scare at the Aztecs, engineering an 18-9 blitz over a span of 5:34 that cut the deficit to 75-72 with 52 seconds remaining. Marta Gomez scored eight points during that stretch, including a pair of treys, while Dent capped the run with a layup.

However, Wyoming was out of timeouts and was forced to foul to stop the clock. SDSU, which entered the night shooting 61.2 percent from the free-throw line, came up huge down the stretch, sinking 9 of their final 10 attempts from the charity stripe to put the game on ice.

### SDSU-Wyoming Postgame Notes

- The Aztecs won their MW opener for the second year in a row and fifth time in the last eight seasons.
- SDSU captured its third victory in its last four visits to Laramie after dropping 12 straight at Arena-Auditorium from 2000-11.

- The Aztecs' 84 points were their most in 51 all-time meetings with the Cowgirls, eclipsing the old mark of 83 set at home on Jan. 23, 1992, when both schools were members of the Western Athletic Conference.
- With its result, SDSU also finished with its highest scoring total in a Mountain West game since amassing 88 points in back-to-back home games against Utah State and San José State in January 2014.
- San Diego State won its 49th straight and improved to 79-1 since the 2012-13 campaign when leading with five minutes to go in the game.
- The Aztecs finished with a season-low seven turnovers. SDSU is now 4-1 on the year when posting fewer miscues than the opposition.
- The Aztec bench outscored the Cowgirl reserves by a 28-6 tally. For the season, the SDSU bench has amassed 283 points (23.6/g).
- McKynzie Fort led the Aztecs in scoring for the ninth time this season and notched her fourth game with 20 points or more.
- With her career-high 10 rebounds, Ariell Bostick became the first SDSU player to reach double figures in boards since Erimma Amarikwa accomplished the feat last year at home against Boise State on Feb. 7, 2015.
- Deidra Smith played in her 73rd consecutive game for the Aztecs.

## Take It to the Bank

With their victory over Wyoming on Dec. 30, the Aztecs have now won 49 in a row and improved to 79-1 since the 2012-13 campaign when leading with five minutes remaining in the game. The SDSU streak was in serious jeopardy at CSUN on Dec. 7 after the Matadors inched in front by a 66-65 margin with 20 seconds remaining. However, Lexy Thorderson's trey with 9.4 seconds to go saved the day for the Scarlet and Black.

The last time the Aztecs wound up losing a game after leading at the five-minute mark of the second half occurred in a heart-breaking 59-58 at Washington in December of 2012.

## Comeback Kids

In three victories over Wisconsin, CSUN and Wyoming, San Diego State fought itself off the ropes, rallying from an 11-point deficit in each contest. Against the Badgers on Nov. 29, the Aztecs found themselves on the wrong side of a 32-21 score with three minutes elapsed in the third quarter before uncorking a 23-7 run to grab a 44-39 advantage. SDSU also trailed with under 10 seconds remaining, but Ariell Bostick saved the day with a late layup to send the game into overtime. The following week against the Matadors, the Aztecs overcame a 41-30 deficit at the 8:22 mark of the third period with a 12-0 run to climb back into contention. After six ties and four lead changes, CSUN went back in front 65-63 with 17 seconds to go. However, Lexy Thorderson tallied the go-ahead basket on a three-pointer with 9.4 seconds left, while Bostick added a late free throw to seal the win. In the MW opener against the Cowgirls on Dec. 30, SDSU trailed 15-4 with 5:21 elapsed in the first quarter before reeling off 15 unanswered points to take the lead for good.

## Nothin' Like Home Cookin'

Despite its modest 3-3 home record to start the season, SDSU has claimed 46 of its last 63 games on Montezuma Mesa and has gone 78-31 (.716) at Steve Fisher Court since the start of the 2008-09 campaign. The Aztecs have finished with a winning record at home in eight of the last nine years.

## Spreading the Wealth

A total of 10 Aztecs have scored in double digits at least once this season, while five have accomplished the feat on two or more occasions. That is especially notable since there are only 12 players on the active roster. In addition, SDSU has had five games this season in which three players scored in double figures (UC Riverside, Wisconsin, CSUN, San Diego Christian and Wyoming).

## Fort Tabbed MW Player of the Week

McKynzie Fort was named Mountain West Women's Basketball Player of the Week for her stellar performances in three games from Nov. 23-29, as announced by the league office. With her award, the Aztec sophomore garnered weekly conference accolades for the first time in her career and first for SDSU this season.

Fort averaged 17.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 3.3 steals, helping the Aztecs to a 2-1 record during that stretch. The 5-9 guard was the team's top scorer in all three games, connecting on 66.7 percent of her shots on 24 of 36 field-goal attempts, all inside the arc.

After recording 16 points on 8-of-13 shooting and four rebounds in a tough road loss to Washington on Nov. 23, Fort almost single-handedly propelled the Scarlet and Black to a 64-54 triumph over North Dakota State in the opener of the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic last Friday, posting a game-high 20 points and a personal-best five steals. Against the Bison, the Etiwanda High alumna drained a collegiate-high 10 field goals on 12 tries (83.3 pct) and matched her season best with four rebounds.

Not to be outdone, Fort capped off her brilliant week with a 16-point, 4-steal effort in the Aztecs' thrilling 63-57 overtime victory over Wisconsin on Sunday, sinking 6 of 11 attempts from the floor to go with four clutch free throws. Against the Badgers, she converted two critical and-one opportunities, including one to punctuate a timely 23-7 run that erased an 11-point deficit in the second half.

In addition, Fort received MW Player of the Week honors from the website CollegeSportsMadness.com after her exceptional effort vs. Cal State Fullerton on Dec. 19. Against the Titans, Fort recorded the second-best scoring output of her career with a game-high 22 points, including 14 in the second half as the Scarlet and Black pulled away for the victory. The 5-9 guard matched her collegiate best with 10 field goals on 14 attempts (71.4 percent) and posted three rebounds, three steals and two assists to help SDSU pull away for the win.

For the season, Fort is averaging a team-high 15.1 points per game on 48.9 percent shooting and leads SDSU with 24 steals. She now has eight double-digit scoring performances this year and 28 for her career.

Earlier this year, Fort set a career high with 25 points against UC Riverside in the Aztecs' home opener on Nov. 16, and established collegiate bests in three-pointers made (2), field-goal attempts (17), free throws (11) and free throw attempts (12).

## @AztecWBB Picked Sixth in MW Preseason Poll

San Diego State has been predicted to finish sixth the Mountain West preseason poll released on Oct. 28 by the league office. The voting panel consisted of the MW's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the conference.

The Aztecs, who placed seventh in the MW standings during the 2014-15 campaign, earned 135 points from the panel, trailing fifth-place UNLV (132) by just three points while topping seventh-place Wyoming (125) by 10 points.

Two-time defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat once again after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 237 points, just ahead of New Mexico, which garnered seven first-place votes and 221 points, while 2015 MW tournament champion Boise State followed closely in the third spot with six first-place votes and 215 points.

With the league's forecast, SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings in back-to-back years for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 campaigns. The Aztecs completed conference play where they were projected last season, landing in the seventh spot with an 8-10 record.

## Back Again

San Diego State returns three starters from a year ago, featuring sophomore McKynzie Fort, along with seniors Ahjalee Harvey and Deidra Smith. A 5-9 guard, Fort earned Mountain West all-freshman honors last spring after finishing third among conference rookies with 10.9 points per game in league play while averaging 3.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists. In addition, Harvey made a successful recovery from a knee injury that sidelined her for the final 22 games of the 2013-14 campaign with 25 starts in 29 appearances last season. The 5-6 point guard was SDSU's top ball-handler and main three-point threat in 2014-15, dishing out 2.3 assists per contest to go with 21 triples. Meanwhile, Smith has played in all 62 games for the Aztecs the past two years following her transfer from Boston College. The tallest member on the squad as a 6-2 forward, Smith is the team's top returning rebounder after averaging 3.5 caroms last season.

Third-year head coach Stacie Terry and staff welcome back four additional letterwinners, including juniors Ariell Bostick and Aleiah Brandon and sophomores Cheyenne Greenhouse and Lexy Thorderson. Fellow classmate Allison Brown, who made seven spot appearances last season, also finds herself in the mix once again.

## Noting the Newcomers

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, four players will be wearing a Scarlet and Black uniform for the first time during the 2015-16 campaign. Guard Kymberly Ellison (Columbus, Ga.) practiced with the squad last year, but did not compete after transferring from Georgia Tech, while fellow backcourt mate Geena Gomez (Huntington Beach, Calif.) utilized her

redshirt season as well following her transfer from St. Joseph's (Pa.).

With the departure of forwards Erimma Amarikwa, Kristina Hunter and Desi Culbertson, who accounted for 43 percent of SDSU's rebounding total and 38 percent of the team's scoring offense from a year ago, a pair of newcomers look to gain significant experience on the frontline this season. Junior Kylie Herd (Phoenix, Ariz.) received second-team All-America recognition and was named the Arizona JC player of the year as a sophomore last year at Mesa Community College, following a solid freshman campaign when she helped the Thunderbirds to the NJCAA Division II national championship. Not to be outdone, freshman Arantxa Gómez (Valencia, Spain) brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after sharpening her skills as a six-year member on the Spanish club circuit, including an MVP performance in U18 regional competition last April.

SDSU alumnus Chris Ello begins his ninth season of calling the action and is a familiar voice in the San Diego area. In addition to his responsibilities with the Aztec women's basketball squad, Ello is a member of the football broadcast team as a sideline reporter for the school's flagship station, The Mighty 1090 AM.

Ello started his career in sports talk radio in San Diego on XTRA Sports 690 in the summer of 1994. He has accumulated a wealth of experience doing play-by-play for a variety of sports at every level, including stints with the SDSU football (1985), baseball (1998-99) and men's basketball (2006-07) squads.

From 1996-2006, Ello was the voice of the San Diego Gulls hockey team and has called the action for the San Diego Sockers (indoor soccer), San Diego Spirit (outdoor soccer), San Diego Wildcards (CBA) and San Diego Riptide (arena football). He also has experience broadcasting high school CIF football and basketball games since 2000.

For the third straight year, nearly all regular-season Aztec home contests in 2015-16 will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

### NCAA Rule Changes at a Glance

#### Game Format

- Beginning with the 2015-16 campaign, NCAA women's basketball games will be played in four 10-minute quarters.
- Teams will now reach the bonus and shoot two free throws on the fifth team foul in each quarter. Previously, teams reached a one-and-one bonus on the seventh team foul of each half and reached the double bonus (two shots) on the 10th team foul.
- In the four-quarter format, team fouls reset to zero at the start of each quarter. However, if a team reaches the bonus in the fourth quarter, that team would remain in the bonus during any additional overtime periods.

#### Advancing the Ball

- Teams will be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a timeout immediately after a made basket in the last 59.9 seconds of the fourth quarter and any overtime periods.
- Teams will also be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a rebound or a change of possession. In these scenarios, the ball would be inbounded at the 28-foot mark on the side of the court where the scorer's table is located.

### 10-Second Backcourt Exceptions

- For the upcoming season, a team will not receive a new 10-second backcourt count when a throw-in results from the following situations:
  - The ball is deflected out of bounds by the defense.
  - There is a held ball and the possession arrow favors the offensive team.
  - A technical foul is called on the offensive team while the ball is in its backcourt.

### Post Defense

- Defenders will be allowed to place a forearm or an open hand with a bend in the elbow on an offensive post player with the ball whose back is to the basket.

### Bands and Amplified Music

- In an effort to improve the overall fan experience, bands or amplified music may be played during any dead-ball situation during a women's basketball game. Previously, rules allowed music to be played only during timeouts and intermission.

### SDSU Holds Grand-Opening Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a grand-opening ceremony for the 23,500-square foot Jeff Jacobs JAM Center on Sunday, Aug. 23. The event marked the official opening of the Aztecs' on-campus basketball performance center, which broke ground almost a year to the date on Aug. 27, 2014.

Speaking before the ceremonial ribbon cutting was SDSU president Elliot Hirshman, men's basketball head coach Steve Fisher and women's hoops senior guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Preliminary site work started in July 2014, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film room, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project was \$15 million.

The project was designed by JCJ Architecture and was built by The Hunt Construction Group.

San Diego native Stacie Terry enters her third year at the helm of the Aztec women's basketball team after she was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 15, 2013.

Despite a 12-19 record and an 8-10 mark in the Mountain West, Terry's squad still showed dramatic improvement on defense last season, finishing second in the conference and 34th nationally in opponent three-point field goal percentage, compared to 2014 when SDSU ranked last in the league and near the bottom of Division I in that statistic.

In addition, the Aztecs were fourth in scoring defense during MW play a year ago, allowing nearly 10 points per game fewer than the previous campaign and topped the conference in rebounding defense for the second straight season.

Under Terry's watch, forward Erimma Amarikwa capped off her collegiate career with honorable mention all-MW accolades, while guard McKynzie Fort gave SDSU's its second consecutive all-conference freshman honoree.

Terry's charges also made tremendous strides in the classroom, with the squad posting the highest collective GPA in program history during the fall of 2014, while five Aztecs landed a spot on the MW all-academic team, the most since 2001-02.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players to injuries prior to conference play, Amarikwa, who was a preseason all-MW selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games against teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 ledger in the MW.

With Terry at the controls, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in a six-year span to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA

tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN Hoop-Gurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
