### No. 24 Aztecs Set to Host Season Kickoff Tournament this Weekend

The San Diego State softball team begins the third season of the Stacey Nuveman Deniz head coaching era this weekend when it plays host to the four-day, five-team, 12-game San Diego State Season Kickoff at SDSU Softball Stadium.

The SDSU Season Kickoff looks more like the toughest NCAA regional, featuring No. 3 (in last year's final RPI) Stanford, the No. 27 Aztecs, No. 28 Minnesota and No. 29 Kentucky, along with UC Santa Barbara. SDSU, which is ranked 24th in the preseason USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll and receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Poll, starts the season against Stanford at 5 p.m. PT Thursday, before meeting Minnesota at 5:30 p.m. PT Friday, and No. 25/rv Kentucky (4:30 p.m. PT) and UC Santa Barbara (7 p.m. PT) on Saturday.

San Diego State finished the 2023 campaign with a 39-17 record, advancing to the program's first super regional after capturing the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, and being ranked No. 18 in the final ESPN/USA Softball poll and 19th in the final USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll. The Aztecs, who were one win away from making the Women's College World Series, won the Mountain West tournament, the first held since 2006, with a perfect 3-0 record after finishing second in regular-season play. Last month, SDSU was picked to win the Mountain West with eight of the nine first-place votes and 64 points overall in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine coaches.

Additionally, Mac Barbara (.358, 13 HR, 45 RBI, 34 R, 9 2B) was named the MW preseason player of the year, while Allie Light (15-7, 1.90 ERA, 7 SV, .218 avg.) was chosen as the MW preseason pitcher of the year. They were joined on the pre-season all-MW team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker (.368, 6 HR, 40 RBI, 29 R) and Bella Espinoza (.393, 57 R, 30 SB).

Other returning starters for SDSU include Makena Brocki (.297, 1 HR, 33 RBI, 22 R, 13 2B, 5 3B), Macey Keester (.289, 1 HR, 21 RBI, 25 R, 15 SB), AJ Murphy (.280, 5 HR, 27 RBI, 19 R) and Jeweliana Perez (.246, 2 HR, 9 RBI).

**STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ**  
**HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON (16TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002**

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 78-33 (.703) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

**This Weekend's Information**

The Aztecs begin the 2024 campaign by hosting the San Diego State Season Kickoff. It is the third straight year SDSU has opened the season at home, but just the third time since 2007.

The four-day, five-team, 12-game tournament begins Thursday with one game, followed by four on Friday, five on Saturday and two on Sunday.

The weekend tournament looks more like the toughest NCAA regional, featuring No. 3 (in last year's final RPI) Stanford, No. 27 SDSU, No. 28 Minnesota and No. 29 Kentucky, along with UC Santa Barbara. Three of the five teams are nationally ranked in the preseason USA Today/NFCA poll, including No. 3 Stanford, No. 24 San Diego State and No. 25 Kentucky.

The Aztecs kick off the season against Stanford on Thursday, before meeting Minnesota on Friday, and Kentucky and UC Santa Barbara on Saturday.

**Aztec Softball Ranked 24th in USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll**

The San Diego State softball team is ranked 24th in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll, which was released Jan. 30. It is the third time the Aztecs have been ranked this preseason and first by a committee of coaches.

SDSU, which is also 23rd by D1 Softball and 25th by Softball America in the preseason rankings, garnered 97 points in the initial poll after finishing 19th in the final 2023 USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll. San Diego State is just ahead of No. 25 Kentucky (79), while No. 20 Northwestern (203), No. 21 Louisiana (189), No. 22 Baylor (173) and No. 23 South Carolina (129) each round out the top 25. Back-to-back national champion Oklahoma is first in the preseason poll with all 32 first-place votes and 800 votes total.

The Aztecs, who are scheduled to play three teams that made the 2023 Women's College World Series and 18 games overall against 15 teams who made the 2023 NCAA tournament, are set to play seven of the teams this year in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches poll, including No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 3 (tied) Stanford, No. 13 Utah, No. 14 LSU (twice), No. 15 Oregon, No. 18 Nebraska and No. 25 Kentucky.

The USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll is voted on by 32 NCAA Division I head coaches with one representing each of the DI conferences. San Diego State received 48 votes in the preseason ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, 36 behind No. 25 Northwestern and the most among the teams receiving votes. Others getting votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll were Kentucky (32), UCF (23), Arizona (10), Missouri (9), Wichita State (9), McNeese (8), Notre Dame (7), Arizona State (6), Liberty (6), Indiana (4), Miami (OH) (4), Minnesota (3), Mississippi State (3), Ole Miss (2), Central Arkansas (1), Michigan (1) and North Texas (1).

SDSU finished the 2023 campaign with a 39-17 record, advancing to the program's first super regional after capturing the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, and being ranked No. 18 in the final ESPN/USA Softball poll and 19th in the final USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll. San Diego State, which was one win away from making the Women's College World Series, won the Mountain West tournament, the first held since 2006, with a perfect 3-0 record after finishing second in regular-season play.

**SDSU Picked to Win MW; Mac Barbara, Allie Light Named Preseason Players of the Year**

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West, while Mac Barbara (player) and Allie Light (pitcher) have been chosen as the league's preseason players of the year, the league announced Jan. 31.

Barbara and Light were joined on the 15-player preseason team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker and Bella Espinoza. This was the first time in MW history that preseason players of the year and a preseason all-conference team were announced.

The preseason poll, players of the year and all-conference team were voted on by the league's nine head coaches.

SDSU picked up 64 points, including eight of the nine first-place votes. Defending regular-season champion Boise State is second with 57 points and the other first-place vote, while Colorado State (46), Fresno State (41), Nevada (37), UNLV (28), Utah State (19), New Mexico (17) and San Jose State (15) round out the voting.

Barbara made her second straight MW first team last season after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. Barbara, who in just two seasons at SDSU ranks first in program history in on-base percentage (.481) and OPS percentage (1.221), second in slugging percentage (.740), third in batting average (.378), fifth in home runs (31), eighth in extra-base hits (56), tied for ninth in RBIs (106) and 10th in walks (67), batted .358 (57-for-159) a year ago with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 34 runs, nine doubles, a triple and 33 walks, while slugging .673 with a .469 on-base mark. Barbara, a two-time first-team All-NFCA West Region (2022-23) player, was even better in league play, hitting .459 (28-for-61) with eight home runs, 24 RBIs and 18 runs in 24 games, drawing 14 walks with a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base percentage.

Light, meanwhile, was named the MW Pitcher of the Year in 2023, while also making her first all-conference team (first team) and first appearance on the all-NFCA West Region (second team). A four-time MW Pitcher of the Week, including three straight weeks from March 28-April 11, Light was 15-7 with a 1.90 ERA and a school-record seven saves in 132 2/3 innings. She started 17 games and played in 40 overall, playing a part in six Aztec shutouts, and striking out 106 with 20 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .218 average. Light was even better in MW play, going 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average.

Decker made the most of her first season on The Mesa in 2023, batting .368 (56-for-152) with six home runs, 40 RBIs, 29 runs, four doubles and 26 walks, posting a .513 slugging percentage and an .462 on-base mark en route to becoming a second-team NFCA all-West Region pick and a second-team all-MW selection. Decker hit .386 (22-for-57) in MW play with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs and 12 walks, owning a .456 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base percentage. She was also named to the all-Mountain West Tournament team, batting a team-high .700 (7-for-10) with a home run, five RBIs and two runs. In nine postseason games overall (three in MW tournament, six in NCAA tournament), she hit .429 (12-for-28) with three homers, 13 RBIs and four runs, slugging .750 with a .467 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second straight all-MW team a year ago (first team in 2022, second team in 2023), leading SDSU in batting average (.393), runs (57), hits (75), stolen bases (30) and at-bats (191). Espinoza's 70 singles were a SDSU single-season record, and she also ranked second in single-season history in stolen bases (30), third in runs (57), tied for third in hits (75) and eighth in batting average (.393). In MW play, Espinoza batted .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs and 13 stolen bases and later made the all-MW Tournament Team after hitting .545 (6-for-11) with five runs and two stolen bases in just three games. She enters her third season ranked second all-time at San Diego State in batting average (.387), fifth in stolen base percentage (.865, min. 20 att., since 1983), tied for seventh in stolen bases (45) and eighth in on-base percentage (.422).

**Home Sweet Home**

San Diego State enters the 2024 campaign as one of the hottest teams on the road. The Aztecs finished 24-4 at SDSU Softball Stadium in 2023 for their highest home winning percentage (.857) in program history.

Additionally, SDSU closed the season with 13 consecutive home wins at SDSU Softball Stadium, tied for the eighth-longest streak in the country with Louisiana, McNeese and Southeast Missouri State.
