AZTECS WIN CONFERENCE TOURNEY, ADVANCE TO NCAA REGIONALS

- ◆ San Diego State came back after an opening-game loss to Fresno State last Thursday (May 21) to win five straight games over the next three days and claim the title at the 2015 Mountain West Tournament held in Reno, Nev.
- ◆ With that championship came the league's automatic bid to the 2015 NCAA Regionals.
- ◆ The Aztecs were slotted into the Lake Elsinore Regional hosted by UC Santa Barbara at The Diamond, the home field of the Class A Lake Elsinore Storm.
- ◆ It marks San Diego State's fourth Regional appearance since 2009 when it played at UC Irvine.
- ◆ In 2013 the Aztecs advanced to the Los Angeles Regional at UCLA and last season played at Louisiana-Lafayette.
- ◆ This year's Regional appearance is the 12th in the history of the SDSU baseball program.

2015 NCAA REGIONAL

- ◆ San Diego State will open its Regional schedule with a contest against 13th-ranked UC Santa Barbara, on Friday, May 29 at 7:00 p.m. (PT).
- ◆ The Gauchos are the No. 1 seed at the Regional while the Aztecs are seeded fourth.
- ◆ The other two teams in the double elimination tourney are No. 2 seed USC and third-seeded Virginia. Those two schools will square off at 3:00 p.m. (PT) on Friday.
- ◆ The Aztecs' second game in the tourney is dependent upon its result and the results of Friday's opening contest between USC and Virginia.
- ◆ For the complete tournament schedule, see page 2 of this release.

RECORD VS. REGIONAL OPPONENTS

- ◆ San Diego State's record vs. UC Santa Barbara stands at 80-29-1 since the teams first met back in 1936. The Aztecs and Gauchos have not played each other since 2009 when they played home-and-home contests on back-to-back days with each winning on the other's field.
- ◆ SDSU's mark vs. USC over the years is 26-58-3. The last time the Aztecs and Trojans faced each other was in 2008 when San Diego State won a game in Los Angeles as well as the one in San Diego.
- ◆ The Aztecs' lone meeting with Virginia came at the 2009 NCAA Regional in Irvine where the Cavaliers emerged with a 5-1 victory.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ

- ◆ Mark Martinez is in his first season as head coach of the Aztecs although this is his 10th season as a member of the San Diego State staff. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
- ◆ Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs prior to the 2006 season and served for nine years under Head Coach Tony Gwynn. During that time he was promoted to the position of Associate Head Coach.
- ◆ Prior to his arrival at SDSU, Martinez was an assistant coach at the University of New Mexico for 17 seasons. During his time as a hitting and infield coach he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the nation, ranking among the top 11 in the nation in hitting his final four seasons.
- ◆ Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College in Grand Junction, Colo., from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.
- ◆ He graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

NCAA REGIONAL MEDIA COVERAGE

- ◆ All games during the 2015 NCAA Regionals will be televised on ESPN3. That channel is available only over the Internet on a computer or mobile device (mobile phone, tablet, etc.).
- ◆ All of SDSU's game will be broadcast on ESPN 1700 AM in San Diego with Chris Ello calling the action.
- ◆ A link for both the ESPN3 and radio broadcasts as well as live stats will also be available at www.GoAztecs.com.

2015 MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT

- ◆ San Diego State earned the Mountain West's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament by virtue of winning the conference tournament that was contested in Reno, Nev., last week (May 20-24).
- ◆ As the tourney's No. 2 seed, the Aztecs drew a first-day bye before losing their opening contest to Fresno State, 15-7 on Thursday (May 21).
- ◆ On Friday SDSU stayed alive by defeating Air Force, 8-2 in the loser's bracket then turning right around and downing tourney top- seed and regular season conference champ Nevada, 9-7.
- ◆ San Diego State then battled back for a pair of wins in Saturday's doubleheader, downing No. 3 seed Fresno State, 7-6, in 10 innings and besting New Mexico, 11-1, to set up a title game on Sunday vs. the Lobos.
- ◆ SDSU then captured the championship on Sunday with a 6-4 victory over New Mexico.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS

- ◆ Five Aztecs were named to the all-tournament team at last week's Mountain West Championship event.
- ◆ The group included catcher Seby Zavala, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie along with pitchers Mark Seyler and Jacob Erickson.
- ◆ Zavala was named the tournament MVP after hitting .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI and eight runs scored. He also had a 1.174 slugging percentage and a .536 on-base mark.

AZTEC ROTATION

- ◆ SDSU will continue with basically the same weekend rotation it has utilized the past nine weekends to start the NCAA Regional.
- ◆ Bubba Derby (7-4, 3.35) will be the Aztec starter on Friday evening.
- ◆ Mark Seyler (9-2, 2.80) is expected to start SDSU's game on Saturday.
- ◆ Most recently, Derby picked up a save in the championship game of the Mountain West Tournament, his first relief appearance of the season, while Seyler was not involved in the decision after starting that same contest.
- ◆ Seyler recorded his team-leading ninth win in the victory over Air Force last Friday (May 22).
- ◆ Marcus Reyes has been SDSU's No. 3 starter the past nine weeks and will likely get the nod if SDSU plays a third game although Cody Thompson is a possibility in that contest depending on the matchup.

ALL-CONFERENCE AZTECS

- ◆ San Diego State placed a total of seven players on the 2015 Mountain West All-Conference team including four first-team and three second-team selections.
- ◆ Members of the first team include third baseman Ty France and shortstop Danny Sheehan along with starting pitchers Bubba Derby and Mark Seyler.
- ◆ Second-team honorees include catcher Seby Zavala, outfielder Chase Calabuig and utility/designated hitter Steven Pallares.
- ◆ The seven selections are the most for SDSU since the 2005 season when it also had seven honorees.

DOING IT ALL (ALMOST)

- ◆ During the May 16 contest vs. St. Mary's, Steven Pallares was expected to play all nine positions in the field over the course of the game.
- ◆ He began the contest at catcher in the opening frame and then played one inning at first, second, shortstop, third and left field over the next five innings.
- ◆ Pallares was unable to complete his goal, however, as defensive requirements necessitated his playing first base over the final three frames.

FRANCE ROLLS ON

- ◆ Third baseman Ty France enters the NCAA Regional on a seven-game hitting streak during which he has posted three doubles, six RBI and seven runs scored.
- ◆ He has scored at least once in six of SDSU's last seven contests.
- ◆ He has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in 20 straight games.
- ◆ He was hit by pitch in the game against Air Force on Thursday (May 22) to bring his career total to 47. He is now the all-time Aztec career leader in that category.
- ◆ He has been hit by pitch 19 times this season to establish a new SDSU single-season record.
- ◆ He had an 11-game hitting streak (second-longest on the squad) come to an end in the contest vs. UCLA on Tuesday, March 24.
- ◆ During that streak he batted .432 (19-for-44) with a double, triple, 14 RBI and nine runs scored.

PALLARES STREAKING

- ◆ Senior Steven Pallares has hit safely in each of the last 18 games, the longest hitting streak by an Aztec in 2015.
- ◆ During that streak he has batted .354 (28-for-79) and recorded two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and 18 runs scored.
- ◆ He has reached base in each of the last 24 games.
- ◆ He hit his eighth home run of the season in the game vs. Fresno State last Thursday (May 21).
- ◆ Pallares tied the SDSU record for RBI in a game when he recorded eight during the win over Air Force on March 21.
- ◆ In that contest he had a two-run single, two-RBI double and a grand slam.
- ◆ In the win over Valparaiso on Feb. 14 he tossed 1.1 innings of shutout relief and was credited with the victory when the Aztecs rallied to win it.
- ◆ He has made a total of five relief appearances on the mound this season and has a 2.08 earned run average.

THORNTON THRIVING AT THE PLATE

- ◆ Spencer Thornton was SDSU's top hitter for average at last week's conference tournament when he batted .458 (11-for-24) over the six games.
- ◆ He had a personal season-best 10-game hitting streak stopped in the series finale vs. St. Mary's on Saturday, May 16.
- ◆ During the streak he went 15-for-35 (.429) with three doubles, five RBI and 11 runs scored.
- ◆ He also walked nine times for a .568 on-base percentage over that span.
- ◆ In the May 14 win over St. Mary's he tied his career bests with three hits and three runs scored while setting career highs with two doubles and three base on balls.
- ◆ He has not committed an error in the outfield this season (62 chances in 43 games in the field).

CALABUIG CONSISTENT

- ◆ Freshman outfielder Chase Calabuig had a streak of having reached base safely (hit, walk or hit by pitch) in 32 straight games come to an end in the May 15 game vs. St. Mary's.
- ◆ It is the longest such streak by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ He tied an SDSU record with three sacrifice bunts in the championship game of the Mountain West Tournament vs. New Mexico last Sunday (May 24).

- ◆ Calabuig had a career-high three hits in the series finale at New Mexico on March 8 and tied that with three hits at UNLV on March 29 and vs. UC Irvine on April 14.
- ◆ Calabuig has committed only one error (on March 28) this season on 100 chances in the outfield.
- ◆ He has also made one appearance on the mound this season, tossing a third of an inning of relief in the game vs. Valparaiso on Feb. 15.

SHEEHAN SOLID AT SHORT

- ◆ Danny Sheehan was one of 47 players nationwide on the inaugural watch list for the 2015 Brooks Wallace Shortstop of the Year Award. He is the lone player from the Mountain West on the list.
- ◆ During last week's six games at the Mountain West Tournament he hit .423 (11-for-26) with three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- ◆ His three homers came in consecutive games vs. Air Force, Nevada and Fresno State.
- ◆ He comes into the NCAA Regional on a nine-game hitting streak.
- ◆ He had a career-high four hits in the win at Long Beach State on March 10 and also tied his career best at the time with three RBI, a mark he matched on March 27 at UNLV as well as in the contest vs. Nevada on April 27.
- ◆ He stole his ninth base on May 1 vs. UNLV. He was caught for the only time this season on April 12 at San Jose State.

ZAVALA POWERS UP

- ◆ Junior catcher Seby Zavala enters the week on a six-game hitting streak from last week's conference tournament.
- ◆ He had his team-leading 17th multiple-RBI game of the season with three in the win over New Mexico last Saturday (May 23).
- ◆ He hit his team-leading 14th home run in that contest as well.
- ◆ He has reached base safely in each of the last 14 games.
- ◆ He tied a career high with four hits in the contest at San Jose State April 10.
- ◆ He had a personal season-best seven-game hitting streak come to an end in the series finale vs. San Jose State on Feb. 28.
- ◆ His five RBI in the game at New Mexico on March 7 was a career best.

- ◆ Backup catcher Hunter Stratton connected for his first collegiate home run on Thursday (May 14) vs. St. Mary's.
- ◆ It was a two-run shot in the eighth inning over the right field fence at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ Not only was it his first career homer, it was also Stratton's first collegiate hit.
- ◆ Prior to that game he had appeared in nine contests (one start) and had gone 0-for-7 at the plate.

DERBY ON THE MOUND

- ◆ Junior right-hander Bubba Derby picked up his first save of the season in the championship game of the conference tournament vs. New Mexico on May 24.
- ◆ It was his first relief appearance of the year after making 15 starts.
- ◆ He had recorded his third win in three outings on May 14 vs. St. Mary's.
- ◆ In his previous start at Air Force (May 8) he recorded 10 strikeouts, his fifth double-digit strikeout effort of the season.
- ◆ He leads the Mountain West with 122 strikeouts in his 94 innings of work.
- ◆ His season total of 122 strikeouts ties for third on the SDSU single-season list and his career total of 266 also ranks fourth all-time for an Aztec hurler.
- ◆ He made his debut at the DH position in the final two games vs. UNLV (May 2-3) and registered his first collegiate hit, a single through the right side on Sunday, May 3.

HELDMAN PROVIDES RELIEF

- ◆ Junior right-handed reliever Brian Heldman appeared in five of SDSU's six game at the Mountain West Tournament last week.
- ◆ His 35 appearances in 2015 rank eighth in NCAA Division I this week and sixth on the SDSU single-season list.
- ◆ His three wins came in relief vs. Valparaiso, Loyola Marymount and UC Irvine over the first three weeks of the season.
- ◆ His longest stint came vs. CSU Northridge on April 21 when he tossed 3.2 innings allowing two hits and striking out a season-high three batters.
- ◆ He recorded his first save as an Aztec in the win over New Mexico on April 4 when he came on to get the final two outs in the ninth with runners at first and second in SDSU's 4-3 win.

- ◆ Freshman second baseman Alan Trejo hit .333 (6-for-18) during the Mountain West Tournament last week.
- ◆ He connected for his first home run of the year in the win over New Mexico on Saturday (May 23).
- ◆ His three RBI in that contest was his Aztec career best.

ERICKSON EFFECTIVE

- ◆ Lefty Jacob Erickson made his first start of the season in last Saturday's (May 23) game vs. New Mexico at the conference tournament.
- ◆ In that contest he allowed a run in the first inning then tossed six shutout frames in the Aztecs' 11-1 seven-inning win (10-run rule in effect).
- ◆ He allowed the Lobos just three hits and three walks while striking out three.
- ◆ He has allowed only one hit with a strikeout in his last five relief appearances.
- ◆ He picked up the win over No. 19 UC Irvine on Tuesday (April 14) despite throwing just one pitch.
- ◆ He came on in the top of the ninth with the score tied and UCI having runners at first and third with two out.
- ◆ His first pitch was a fly ball to center for the third out, and when SDSU rallied to win in the bottom of the inning he was awarded the victory.
- ◆ Erickson surrendered his only walk in his 30 relief appearances covering 21.2 innings in the game vs. Long Beach State on April 6.

SEYLER DELIVERS

- ◆ Junior right-hander Mark Seyler picked up his team-leading ninth win of the year on May 22 vs. Air Force at the Mountain West Tournament.
- ◆ In that contest he tossed seven innings allowing two runs on seven hits.
- ◆ He was not involved in the decision in each of his prior three starts.
- ◆ He came back on one day's rest to start the championship game vs. New Mexico on Sunday (May 24).
- ◆ Against the Lobos he went 4.1 innings allowing two runs on seven hits and was not involved in the decision.
- ◆ His 78 strikeouts rank third in the Mountain West entering the weekend while his 2.80 earned run average is third.

SAYLOR SAVES

- ◆ CJ Saylor recorded his 11th save in SDSU's win over UNLV on May 1.
- ◆ He ranks second in the Mountain West in saves entering the week.
- ◆ He notched a pair of saves on the same day after saving both games in the twin bill vs. San Jose State on Feb. 27.

BROWN ON A ROLL

- ◆ Sophomore first baseman Andrew Brown hit .348 (8-for-23) at last week's conference tourney.
- ◆ Included in those numbers was his first home run of the season
- ◆ He had a personal-best nine-game hitting streak end on May 1 vs. UNLV. During that streak he went 17-for-38 (.447) with four doubles, a triple, eight RBI and three runs scored.
- ◆ His 17 doubles ties for the team lead.
- ◆ He matched his career high with four hits in the contest at Fresno State on Saturday, April 25.
- ◆ He recorded four hits on two other occasions this season (at UC Riverside Feb. 22 and at San Jose State April 10).

NATIONAL WATCH LISTS

- ◆ Three members of the SDSU baseball team appeared on the watch lists for a trio of national awards this season.
- ◆ Danny Sheehan was among the original 45 nominees for the Brooks Wallace Shortstop of the Year award presented by the College Baseball Hall of Fame (CBHOF).
- ◆ That list was pared to 25 players last week and Sheehan remains in the running. He was the only shortstop in the Mountain West to appear on the original watch list.
- ◆ Bubba Derby was among the nominees for the CBHOF National Pitcher of the Year award when that list came out last month.
- ◆ In addition, CJ Saylor was on the watch list for the Stopper of the Year honor presented by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

- ◆ Two Aztecs recorded the first home runs of their college careers during the weekend series at UNLV March 27-29.
- ◆ Junior shortstop Danny Sheehan hit his first home run in the opener on Friday, March 27, a three-run shot in the second inning that gave SDSU a 5-1 lead.
- ◆ Freshman Justin Wylie hit his initial four-bagger in the second game of the series (March 28), a solo shot that provided SDSU's final run in the 7-6 win.
- ◆ Frosh Hunter Stratton had his first career home on Thursday, May 14, vs. St. Mary's.

LIKE NIGHT AND DAY

- ◆ SDSU has proven to be more effective on the road this season than at home.
- ◆ The team’s record at home finished at 19-15 while its away ledger (including neutral sites) stands at 21-6 entering the NCAA Regional.
- ◆ At home SDSU is hitting .280 with a 4.24 earned run average compared to a .307 average and 3.85 ERA away from Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ The Aztecs’ stats in day games vs. night games is comparable in hitting with an ERA advantage in night contests.
- ◆ The team is hitting .299 with a 4.75 earned run average in day contests and .285 with a 3.28 ERA in night games.

- ◆ SDSU’s longest hitting streak entering the NCAA Regional belongs to Steven Pallares at 18 games.
- ◆ That is longest streak by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ The Aztecs’ second-longest streak this season is 11 games by Ty France earlier in the year.
- ◆ Pallares has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in 24 straight games.
- ◆ Chase Calabuig had reached base safely in 32 consecutive contests up until the May 15 game vs. St. Mary’s.
- ◆ Seby Zavala and Andrew Brown both had streaks of 18 consecutive games reaching base come to an end on March 14 vs. Texas Tech.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

- ◆ Junior third baseman Ty France received 2015 preseason All-America honors from several sources.
- ◆ He was accorded first-team honors by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers and *D1Baseball.com*.
- ◆ He was also named a third team preseason All-American by *Collegiate Baseball*.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- ◆ Third baseman Ty France and pitcher Bubba Derby were tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league’s coaches.
- ◆ France was the team’s leading returning hitter from 2014 (.356, 18 2B, 6 HR, 45 RBI).
- ◆ Derby led the Aztec pitching staff with an 8-4 record and 3.08 earned run average last season.

AZTECS PICKED SECOND

- ◆ San Diego State was picked to finish second behind New Mexico in the Mountain West Conference preseason baseball poll.
- ◆ In a vote of the seven MWC head coaches, the Aztecs received no first-place votes, but tallied 28 points to place behind the Lobos. UNLV picked up two first-place votes while Nevada and Fresno State received one apiece.

- ◆ The Red Raiders came into the contest hitting .304 as a team, but Derby did not allow a runner to advance past second base and they had no more than one base runner in any inning.
- ◆ Derby was also named the Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK III

- ◆ San Diego State sophomore Marcus Reyes was named the Mountain West Pitcher of the Week for games played through Sunday, March 22, 2015.
- ◆ It was the first MW weekly honor for the Aztec lefty who joins teammates CJ Saylor and Bubba Derby in capturing the award this season.
- ◆ Reyes earned two wins in two starts that week for San Diego State to help it go 4-0 to improve to 19-5 overall and 7-2 in conference play.
- ◆ On Tuesday, March 17, he threw 5.2 innings in a 2-1 victory at LMU. In that contest he allowed just four hits, three walks and one unearned run.

- ◆ Junior right-hander Mark Seyler was named the Mountain West Pitcher of the Week for games played through Sunday, April 26.
- ◆ On Saturday, April 25, at Fresno State, Seyler threw seven complete innings to earn the win in the Aztecs' 15-3 victory over the Bulldogs.
- ◆ He struck out four batters and walked two while allowing one run and three hits, all singles. He departed the contest with a 15-1 lead.
- ◆ Fresno State hit just .125 against Seyler in the game and he also helped himself with a pair of assists in the field.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK V

- ◆ Sophomore Cody Thompson was named Mountain West Baseball Pitcher of the Week for games played through Sunday, May 10, 2015. It was the first MW weekly accolade for the sophomore right-hander from Northridge, Calif.
- ◆ Thompson recorded a pair of wins while tossing 13 scoreless innings and holding batters to a .119 average over his two appearances that week.
- ◆ He threw a complete game in a 3-0 shutout victory at San Diego on May 5 and picked up his second win of the week on May 10 in a 2-1 SDSU victory in extra innings at Air Force.
- ◆ Against the Toreros, Thompson, a sophomore right-hander from Northridge, Calif. (Bishop Alemany HS), gave up four hits, three of which were singles, walked one batter and struck out four. He held USD, which came into the contest with a .300 team batting mark, to a .138 batting average.

- ◆ On Sunday Thompson took the mound to start the bottom of the seventh inning of Game 2 at Air Force after the game was delayed on Saturday due to weather after the top of the seventh inning. The Aztecs were down 1-0 when Thompson entered the contest and he allowed just one hit, walked one batter and struck out four to finish the 10-inning game. He retired nine batters in a row from the eighth to the 10th inning.
- ◆ For the week Thompson allowed no runs on five hits with two walks and eight strikeouts. On the defensive side, he made two putouts and two assists over the 13 innings of work.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Steven Pallares was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in the Aztecs' four contests from Feb. 24-28. It was the first weekly honor for Pallares in his career.
- ◆ A senior from Corona, Calif. (Santiago HS), Pallares led San Diego State to a 4-0 record that week that included a 5-4 extra-inning win against cross-town rival San Diego and a three-game sweep of San José State.
- ◆ For the week he posted a batting average of .526 (10-for-19) with four runs scored, five RBI, four doubles and two walks.
- ◆ Pallares was also named the Madness Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ Five different SDSU pitchers won the conference Pitcher of the Week award this season (Derby, Reyes, Saylor, Seyler and Thompson).
- ◆ Ty France has had multiple hits in almost half of SDSU's games this season (26 of 61).
- ◆ Freshman Brody Westmoreland hit a grand slam in the contest at Fresno State on Saturday (April 25). It was the second by an Aztec this season with Steven Pallares accomplishing the feat vs. Air Force on March 21.
- ◆ Reserve sophomore second baseman Ryan Alvarez recorded his first collegiate hit, an RBI single in his first at bat at UC Riverside on Saturday (Feb. 21).
- ◆ Danny Sheehan is the lone Aztec to have started and played the same position (shortstop) in all 61 games this season.
- ◆ Pitcher Calvin Munson is also a linebacker for the SDSU football team and was the squad's leading tackler during the 2014 season.
- ◆ The 22 runs scored by the Aztecs in their win over Valparaiso on Feb. 13 were their most runs in a game since defeating Air Force, 31-0, on April 22, 2007.
- ◆ Danny Sheehan has stolen nine bases this season after totaling only four the previous two years.
- ◆ SDSU is 34-1 when leading after six innings, 31-1 after seven and 33-0 when leading after eight innings.
