No. 24 Aztec Softball Welcomes Three Ranked Teams for 19th Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic This Weekend

The San Diego State softball team plays host to the 19th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic this weekend at SDSU Softball Stadium. The six-team Classic will feature four nationally ranked schools, including the Aztecs (2-2) who are tied for 24th in the latest USA Today/NFCA poll and receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll.

SDSU will be joined by No. 8/8 Stanford (4-1), No. 10/7 Washington (5-0), rv/No. 24 Long Beach State (2-2), rv/rv UC Santa Barbara (4-0) and Utah State (2-3). The six teams combined for a .611 (207-132) winning percentage a year ago with four NCAA appearances.

This year's Classic kicks off at 4:30 p.m. Thursday when Stanford and UC Santa Barbara meet and will conclude with a game between San Diego State and Long Beach State at 2 p.m. Sunday. The Aztecs will play five games total over the tournament, beginning Thursday with a contest against Utah State at 7 p.m. SDSU will then play Stanford on Friday (7 p.m.), two games on Saturday (UC Santa Barbara, 4:30 p.m. and Washington, 7 p.m.) and then the final meeting against Long Beach State (2 p.m. Sunday).

Last year, San Diego State outscored its opponents, 22-3, over a perfect five-game weekend to claim its first-ever Campbell/Cartier Classic title.

The tournament is named after Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, who lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program. To pay tribute to Campbell and Cartier, the SDSU softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability.

19th Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic Info

The San Diego State University Campbell/Cartier Classic is an annual event held in the memory of former Aztec softball players Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier. Campbell and Cartier lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program.

Campbell, a three-year starting catcher, was in her senior year. She had a .344 batting average, was an all-Western Athletic Conference selection and led the Aztecs in many offensive and defensive categories. She also set several single-season and career records and is among the top softball athletes to wear an SDSU uniform.

Cartier, a transfer pitcher from Hawai'i, had an excellent 1991 season at SDSU. She was emerging as a top pitcher and great hitter. Along with Campbell, Cartier was one of the strongest Aztecs in the weight room and possessed good leadership abilities and Division I playing experience.

To pay tribute to Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, the San Diego State softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability. The 2009 tournament will be the 19th annual classic.

Last Weekend With the Aztecs

The No. 25 San Diego State softball team had an up-and-down first weekend, going 2-2 at the Stacy Winsberg Memorial Tournament. The Aztecs took the first two games on Saturday with come-from-behind heroics, downing Pacific, 5-4, before dispatching Cal Poly, 4-3. However, SDSU dropped a pair of games on Sunday, falling to Cal Poly, 7-3, before dropping a close 6-2, nine-inning decision to No. 4 UCLA by a grand slam in the international tiebreaker. Senior All American Erin Floros batted a team-best .455 (5-for-11) for a team that collectively batted just .204 (23-for-113). Without her average, the team mark would have been .176 (18-for-102). Floros also led the team in hits (5), home runs (1), RBI (6), total bases (8), slugging percentage (.727), walks (3) and on-base percentage (.571), and was perfect in 20 fielding chances, while throwing out the only opposing attempted base stealer over the four games.

The Bruins' (3-1) Kaila Shull then took a 0-2 pitch deep over the centerfield fence to keep San Diego State winless in 47 games against UCLA ... SDSU appeared to take the lead in the top of the fifth when PR Stefanie Quichocho-Rosario scored from third on a sacrifice fly by 1B Monica Alnes ... However, UCLA appealed to the third base umpire Katrina Kershaw, who stated that Quichocho-Rosario left third early resulting in an automatic out ... The double play and subsequent flyout by 3B Christine Kulick ended an inning that started with bases loaded and no outs, thanks to a single by C Erin Floros and a pair of Bruin errors ... The game would remain scoreless through the regular seven innings until the international tiebreaker came into play in the beginning of the eighth frame ... San Diego State struck first with a pair of runs, the first came after RF Traci Wolf scored when Alnes reached on a Bruin fielding error and the second came when PR Katy Erickson scored on a Kulick single ... Andrea Harrison tied the game up for UCLA in the bottom of the inning with a two-run homer on a 2-2 pitch ... After the Aztecs failed to score in their top of the ninth, the Bruins' Shull ended the game with the grand slam ... RHP Bailey Micetich bounced back from a tough outing earlier in the day to toss five scoreless innings as the starter ... She allowed just four hits and a walk, while striking out one ... Beasley (1-1) took the loss after giving up six runs (four earned) on three hits and two walks (both intentional) over three innings of relief.

A Look at Utah State

Utah State is coming off a 2-3 weekend at a tournament in St. Georges, Utah. The Aggies' wins came against Northern Colorado (8-2) and Idaho State (6-2), while their losses came at the hands of Tennessee (11-3), Loyola Marymount (3-2) and Utah (10-0). Megan McDonald (not the former Aztec great who lettered at SDSU from 2005-08) batted .500 (6-for-12) for a team that hit just .214. Simone Hubbard hit three homer runs and drove in seven, while the trio of Stacy Ellingsworth (0-0, 2.00 ERA), Kate Greenough (1-1, 2.15 ERA) and Lindsey Benson (0-2, 12.35 ERA) combined for a 5.81 team ERA.

San Diego State leads the all-time series, 5-3, including a 4-0 shutout at the Campbell/Cartier Classic last Feb. 17. In that game, then freshman Samantha Beasley toss a complete game shutout with five strikeouts, while allowing just three hits and a walk. She led the team at the plate by going 2-for-2 with two doubles and a run scored.

Noting No. 8/8 Stanford

The No. 8/8 Stanford Cardinal went 4-1 last week in Tempe, Ariz., defeating McNeese State, 15-2, Texas Tech, 6-1, Kansas, 11-0, and Wagner, 12-0. Stanford's only loss was a 1-0 score to Oklahoma State. Rosey Neill (.500, 5 R, 6 H, 3 HR, 7 RBI) leads a team that is batting .367 and averaging 8.8 runs per game. Missy Penna has logged the majority of the innings in the circle for the Cardinal, posting a 3-1 record with a 0.61 ERA and 39 strikeouts in 23 innings.

The Aztecs lead the all-time series with Stanford, 10-8. In the last meeting between the two schools on March 10, 2007, the Cardinal came away with a 4-3 victory. In that game, current Aztecs Brittany Knudsen, Monica Alnes and Taryn Casillas all had hits for SDSU, which outthit Stanford, 9-6.

A Glance at UC Santa Barbara

UC Santa Barbara is one of two undefeated teams at the Campbell/Cartier Classic, after picking up four wins last weekend in Tempe, Ariz. The Gauchos' victories came against Oregon (4-2), Wichita State (8-5), McNeese State (9-2) and Wagner (7-0). Christine Ramos (.600, 3 R, 9 H, 3 SB) and Jessica Ziegler (.533, 4 R, 8 H) are each batting over .500 for .364-hitting UC Santa Barbara, which is receiving votes in both national polls, while Keilani Jennings has belted a team-best three homers and eight RBI. Krista Cobb is the team's top pitcher with a 2-0 mark and 0.00 ERA in nine innings. Opposing batters are hitting just .036 off Cobb.

SDSU leads the all-time series by a slim margin at 27-25. The Aztecs broke a recent string of losses against the Gauchos a year ago with a 4-1 victory at the 2008 edition of the Campbell/Cartier Classic. Then freshman Jen Wisneski led SDSU with a 2-for-3 day at the plate and a stolen base, while Brittany Knudsen and Erin Floros each picked up a hit.

Scouting No. 10/7 Washington

Washington is 5-0 heading into this weekend's tournament after a good weekend in St. Georges, Utah. The Huskies knocked off No. 12 Tennessee, 2-1, Brigham Young, 7-3, Southern Utah, 9-0, Loyola Marymount, 4-2, and Utah, 4-0. Ashley Charters (.429, 6 R, 2 SB) and Lauren Greer (.417, 2 2B, 4 RBI) lead the offense, while Danielle Lawrie (3-0, 0.64 ERA) has logged 22 innings in the circle.

Last season, SDSU picked up its first victory over Washington in 12 chances in a thrilling 9-5 game in 12 innings in the

Judy Garman Classic in Fullerton, Calif. Tonye McCorkle had two hits and drove in two runs, while Jen Wisneski had two RBI.

A Look at rv/24 Long Beach State

Long Beach State, which is ranked No. 24 in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll and receiving votes in the USA Today/NFCA poll, bring its 2-2 record into this weekend's tournament. The 49ers' wins last weekend at the Cathedral City Classic in Palm Springs came against Liberty (5-2) and Wisconsin (7-0), while their losses came to Southern Illinois (7-1) and Georgia (10-6). Danielle Linke (.533, 8 H, 3 RBI) and Brianna Goad (.455, 5 H, 2 R) lead the offense, while returning All-American Brooke Turner is 1-1 with a 4.72 ERA in 13 1/3 innings.

Long Beach State has the best of the all-time series, leading SDSU, 46-22. Last year, the 49ers knocked off the Aztecs, 1-0, in a rare loss by San Diego State at SDSU Softball Stadium on March 15. The Aztecs managed just three hits against Turner, including a double by Jen Wisneski and a single by Tonye McCorkle.

SDSU Softball Ties for First in 2009 MWC Preseason Poll

The defending and four-time Mountain West Conference champion San Diego State softball team was picked to finish in a tie for first in 2009 in a preseason poll voted on by the league's coaches on Jan. 28.

The Aztecs, who went 15-5 last season in MWC play to claim their second regular season championship in three seasons, and Brigham Young each picked up 23 points, including three first-place votes apiece. SDSU and BYU were followed by UNLV (15 points), Utah (14), Colorado State (10) and New Mexico (5), respectively.

San Diego State, which is ranked No. 25 in the USA Today/NFCA preseason poll and receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, return eight starters from a year ago, including two-time all-league performer and 2006 All-American Erin Floros (San Diego/Mt. Carmel HS). Other former all-conference selections who will add to the mix in the 2009 campaign include Monica Alnes (Rancho Palos Verdes, Calif./Peninsula HS) (2006), Brittany Knudsen (San Diego/Escondido HS) (2007) and Lindsey Marquez (Tustin, Calif./Lutheran HS) (2007).

Last season, the Aztecs set school records in 11 categories, including wins (44) and win percentage (.721, 44-17), en route to their fourth NCAA appearance.

Aztecs Tied for 24th in Latest USA Today/NFCA Poll

After going 2-2 at the competitive Stacy Winsberg Memorial Tournament last weekend at UCLA, San Diego State moved up to a tie for 24th in the latest USA Today/NFCA national poll.

SDSU, which was 25th in the preseason poll, dropped from 99 points to 48 points to tie with 4-0 Southern Illinois. The two teams are 28 points behind 23rd-ranked North Carolina (76 points) and just one point ahead of Mississippi State (47 points).

Last season, San Diego State was ranked in each of the final 13 weeks of the poll, including a high of 21st.

SDSU is also receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll. This week the Aztecs dropped to five points, which ties them with Florida State for 38th, 27 points from No. 25 Kansas. Creighton (3), Florida Atlantic (3), Texas (3), Auburn (2) and Oregon (2) all sit below San Diego State.

A Look Back at '08: SDSU Wins Campbell/Cartier For First Time in 18-year History

The Aztecs will look to defend their first-ever Campbell/Cartier Classic title which they won last season. It won't be easy as the last team to win back-to-back Classic titles is Stanford, which took home the plaque in 2000 and again in 2001.

Last year, SDSU went 5-0 for its first Classic title in the 18-year history of the event. The 5-0 weekend was a huge improvement from the year before where San Diego State went 1-4 to finish last of six teams.

Long Beach State's four championships are the most followed by UCLA with three. Cal State Northridge, Sacramento State and Stanford each have won two, while the Aztecs, California, Pacific and Washington have one apiece. Long Beach State, Stanford, Washington and the host Aztecs are all apart of this year's Campbell/Cartier Classic.

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

With its 5-4, come-from-behind victory over Pacific on Saturday, San Diego State has now won nine consecutive season-opening games and 12 of 13 under head coach Kathy Van Wyk's tenure. Van Wyk's only setback in a lid-lifter is Feb. 5, 2000 against Illinois-Chicago by a 5-3 score. Over the 13 years, Van Wyk teams have outscored its opponents, 75-26, or 5.77-2.00 per game.

Since records were first kept in 1980, SDSU is 21-9 (.700) in its opening games.

E-E-E-E-Flo

It may be only a week into the season, but senior All-American Erin Floros is already letting the collegiate softball world know that she is going out swinging.

Floros, who battled back for a solid 2008 after missing most of the 2007 campaign with a torn ACL, is coming off a terrific first weekend at the Stacy Winsberg Memorial Tournament. Floros batted a team-best .455 (5-for-11) for a team that collectively batted just .204 (23-for-113). To put that in perspective, without her average, the team mark would have been

.176 (18-for-102). Floros also led the team in hits (5), home runs (1), RBI (6), total bases (8), slugging percentage (.727), walks (3) and on-base percentage (.571). Floros had the game-winning hits in each of SDSU's two wins, while her six RBI were half the team's total of 12 for the weekend. She also was perfect in 20 fielding chances, while throwing out the only opposing attempted base stealer over the four games. Floros was also the only Aztec to record a hit in every game.

On Saturday, Floros went 2-for-3 against Pacific with the eventual game-winning two-run single in the sixth inning. She also had the game-winning walkoff single in the team's next game against Cal Poly, a 4-3 come-from-behind victory. On Sunday, Floros had a three-run homer against the Mustangs, which accounted for all of SDSU's runs in its 7-3 loss. Later on in the night, Floros recorded one of the Aztecs' two hits in their 6-2 loss in nine innings at fourth-ranked UCLA.

Floros, who was left off the initial USA Softball Player of the Year Watch List, is tied for first in the Mountain West with a perfect fielding percentage, and is tied for fifth in RBI (6), tied for sixth in batting average (.455) and on-base percentage (.571) and seventh in slugging percentage (.727).

Floros is one of five Aztecs to start all five games this season. In fact, Floros has started the last 65 games, the second-longest streak on the team (Brittany Knudsen - 103). SDSU is 46-19 (.708) over that 65-game streak. Over her career, Floros has started 139 of the 140 games she has appeared in, the highest percentage (99.3) of starts to games played on the squad.

Among the program career leaders, Floros is ranked second in fielding percentage (.991), third in on-base percentage (.407), fourth in slugging percentage (.452) and OPS percentage (.859), tied for fourth in batting average (.328), fifth in putouts (690), sixth in fielding chances (798), tied for sixth in home runs (9) and times hit by a pitch (7), seventh in RBI (77), tied for seventh in sacrifice flies (3), ninth in doubles (21) and tied for 10th in extra-base hits (31).

Bailing the Team Out

Like any freshmen, there will be some growing pains for a Division I softball player and SDSU right-hander Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.) is no exception.

Through the first weekend, Micetich is 1-1 with a team-low 3.27 ERA. She also leads the team in games started (3), innings pitched (15.0) and lowest opponents batting average (.262). Pretty good numbers, right? Well those numbers would be even better had it not been for two bad innings.

Against Pacific on Feb. 7, where Micetich became the first SDSU freshman to start (and win) an opener this decade, she overcame a sluggish start in the circle to settle down and pick up her first career win. After giving up three runs in the first, all off a three-run home run by the Tigers' Nicole Matson, Micetich allowed just one hit and a walk the rest of the way. For the game, Micetich gave up four runs (three earned) on four hits and a walk over five innings, while striking out two.

The following day in a loss to Cal Poly, Micetich took the loss after allowing five runs (four earned), four coming in the third, on eight hits over five innings. She struck out a career-high four batters without issuing a walk. Micetich bounced back from the tough outing later on in the night against fourth-ranked UCLA. She tossed five scoreless innings as the starter, allowing just four hits and a walk, while striking out one.

Take away the first inning of her first collegiate game against Pacific on Feb. 7 and the fourth inning versus the Mustangs on Feb. 8, and Micetich has a perfect 0.00 ERA in 15.0 innings.

Micetich has been even better this year has the game as gone on. Micetich, who has pitched five innings each in her three appearances, has a 5.44 ERA and a .270 opponents batting average in the first three innings and a 0.00 ERA and .250 average in the final two innings.

Micetich has brought the pitch count down in each of her outings as well, despite arguably pitching against better competition in each of her games (Pacific-->Cal Poly-->UCLA). She threw 79 pitches (15.8 pitches per inning; 60 for strikes and a 75.9 strike-to-ball ratio) in her first game, 72 (14.4 pitches per inning; 54 for strikes and a 75.0 percent strike-to-ball ratio) in her second outing and 71 (14.2 pitches per inning; 46 for strikes and a 64.8 percent strike-to-ball ratio) in her final game.

Aztec Softball Signs Four to National Letters of Intent

The San Diego State softball team signed four newcomers to National Letters of Intent, which was announced by 13th-year head coach Kathy Van Wyk on Dec. 19. The talented players, who will join SDSU in the fall of 2009, include Tanya Holguin (Sacramento, Calif./Woodland HS), Patrice Jackson (Kansas City, Mo./Archbishop O'Hara HS), Kamerin May (Norco, Calif./Santiago HS) and Kristin May (Norco, Calif./Santiago HS).

"We are extremely excited about this year's recruiting class," Van Wyk said. "All four signees have the ability to be immediate impact players. We added to our pitching depth and picked up some very strong hitters as well."

Holguin, a three-time all-Tri-County League selection, lettered three years at Inderkum High as a third baseman and a pitcher. Holguin, who will play at Woodland HS in the 2009 spring season, was also named to the Sacramento Bee All-Metro team for the past three years. Last year, Holguin batted .385 with three home runs, 19 RBI and 17 stolen bases.

Jackson, the lone recruit from outside the state of California, wrapped up a fine career in the fall when she was selected to the Missouri all-State Class 3 First Team, all-Region 4 First Team and all-Metro Missouri Softball First Team, each for the third consecutive season. In 102 career games at Archbishop O'Hara, Jackson batted .517 with 24 home runs and 140 RBI, while owning an impressive 71.3 on-base percentage and 89.5 slugging percentage.

Rounding out the recruiting class are twin sisters Kamerin and Kristin May, who both excelled at Santiago High in Norco, Calif., and for the Corona Angles 18 Gold club team. Kamerin, a pitcher and first baseman, comes to The Mesa as one of the top talents in recent memory. After her 2008 junior season, she garnered first-team EA Sports All-American honors after posting a 26-5 record in the circle with a 0.73 ERA, 311 strikeouts and 17 shutouts. She also batted .400 with six home runs and 30 RBI. A scholar-athlete, Kamerin has gone 71-15 with 856 strikeouts over her three years of high school.

Kristin, who plays catcher and third base, has a three-year average of over .350, with seven homers and 61 RBI. She has earned first-team all-Mountain Valley League honors the past three seasons, while leading Santiago HS to two league titles. A scholar-athlete, Kristin has been named to the Press Enterprise all-Riverside County team as an honorable-mention selection each of the past three years. In addition, Kristin was selected to a second-team all-CIF-SS Division I pick after her 2007 sophomore campaign.

The four newcomers will be called upon to replace current seniors Taryn Casillas, Erin Floros, Christine Kulick, Tonye McCorkle and Dani Sidoti, all who have been starters over their time at SDSU.
