@AztecWBB Wraps Up Non-Conference Slate with Two-Game Homestand

After an eight-day hiatus for final exams, San Diego State will close out the non-conference portion of its schedule with a pair of upcoming home games against Cal State Fullerton (Dec. 19) and San Diego Christian (Dec. 21) at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena. Saturday's clash with the Titans is slated for a 2 p.m. PT start, while Monday's first-ever meeting with the NAIA-affiliated Hawks is set to get underway at 6:30 p.m. Both contests will feature a live video stream available via the Mountain West Network on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling the play-by-play responsibilities.

The Aztecs will be looking to rekindle some momentum after suffering a 92-65 setback at Loyola Marymount in their last outing on Dec. 10. Prior to that defeat, SDSU won three of four games, including a 67-65 nail-biter at CSUN on Dec. 7 for its first road victory of the year.

The Aztecs will be facing their fifth and final Big West opponent of the regular season when CSUF invades "America's Finest City." SDSU has captured six straight against the Titans dating back to 1994, winning by an average margin of 31 points. However, the two sides have not engaged one another since Dec. 3, 2007, when the Aztecs emerged with a 76-45 triumph. The Scarlet and Black is 99-89 in program history against current members of the Big West, including a 19-17 spread against the Titans. SDSU and CSUF met twice a year from 1977-90 as conference rivals in the WCAA and PCAA/Big West.

Individually, the Aztecs are led by sophomore McKynzie Fort (Fontana, Calif.), who ranks fourth in the Mountain West in scoring (15.7 ppg) and fifth in steals (2.3/gm) while occupying the ninth spot in free-throw percentage (.633). In addition, fellow classmate Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.) climbed into the seventh position in three-pointers made (1.6/gm), while senior Deidra Smith (Aurora, Colo.) is tied for ninth in blocked shots (1.0/gm).

Following Monday's action, SDSU will break for the Christmas holiday before opening conference play on Wednesday, Dec. 30, with a road trip to Wyoming.

Scouting the Titans

After opening the year with two straight victories, Cal State Fullerton (2-9) has dropped nine in a row, including a 68-57 setback to Eastern Washington at home in its last outing on Dec. 13. Also among those losses was a tough 61-56 overtime defeat at home to Mountain West member Wyoming on Nov. 24. During their losing skid, the Titans have averaged just 54.6 points per game and have shot 35.1 percent from the field.

With just three upperclassmen on its active roster, CSUF has turned to freshman Michelle Berry for leadership this season. A native of Miami, Fla., Berry tops the squad with 15.1 points and 7.6 rebounds per game, while fellow classmate Dani Craig (11.0 ppg) and redshirt senior Karima Gabriel (10.3 ppg) have also posted double-digit scoring averages so far this year. Craig is the Titans' main three-point threat, draining 21 of 58 shots (36.2 percent) from beyond the arc, while junior Samantha Logan has connected on 20 of 64 attempts (31.3 percent) from long range. In addition, CSUF has received a boost from freshman Jade Vega (8.9 ppg), who leads the team in both assists (4.1/gm) and steals 1.8/gm).

Collectively, the Titans are shooting 36.6 percent from the field, including a 29.4 percent clip from three-point territory (65-221). As of Dec. 16, CSUF finds itself among the nation's leaders with 219 free throw attempts (21st) and 145 free throws made (29th). However, the resulting 66.2 free-throw percentage ranks just 225th in the country. Opponents have out-rebounded the Titans by 5.6 boards per game while maintaining a plus-2.5 turnover margin.

Cal State Fullerton and SDSU share three common opponents during their respective non-conference schedules this year. The Titans posted a 75-73 victory at Loyola Marymount in their second game of the season, while the Aztecs experienced a 92-65 loss to the Lions in their last outing on Dec. 10. In addition, both teams fell victim to San Diego, with SDSU dropping a 60-53 decision on Dec. 3, while CSUF came up short by a 53-44 count six days later on Dec. 9. In their final tune-up before Big West play, the Titans will face North Dakota State, whom the Aztecs dispatched by a 64-54 tally in the first game of the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic.

Aztec forward Aleiah Brandon and Titan guard Samantha Logan were prep teammates at Centennial High School in Corona, Calif., while SDSU guard McKynzie Fort and CSUF center Daeja Smith are both 2014 graduates of Etiwanda High.

Head coach Daron Park is in his third season at the helm of the Titan program and has compiled a 27-46 record since assuming the reins. Prior to his arrival on the Fullerton campus, Park served as associate head coach at USC during the 2012-13 season after spending the 2011-12 campaign as an assistant at California. His coaching résumé also includes stints as an assistant at Utah, Maryland and Louisiana Tech.

Stacie Terry has faced Cal State Fullerton just once during her coaching career as an assistant with UCLA in November 2008, when the Bruins posted a 78-62 triumph at home.

Notes With a 'W'

An SDSU victory over Cal State Fullerton on Saturday will mean:

- The Aztecs win their seventh straight game against the Titans and improve to 20-17 in the all-time series.
- SDSU defeats its second Big West opponent in a row and raises its record to 100-89 against current members of the conference.
- The Aztecs move to 37-19 in December games since 2006.
- SDSU evens its home record at 3-3 on the season.
- The Aztecs also move to 3-3 on the year in games following a loss.

Scouting the Hawks

Members of the Golden State Athletic Conference (GSAC), San Diego Christian has dropped three in a row, including a pair of tough losses to open league play. The Hawks were victimized by late layup in a 53-52 defeat to Biola at home on Dec. 5, before suffering a 65-62 setback at Arizona Christian in their last outing on Dec. 15. Prior to its showdown with San Diego State, SDC will square off against Simpson University in a non-conference clash at home on Saturday.

The Hawks' encounter with the Aztecs will count as an exhibition game in their 2015-16 schedule. SDC has played two exhibitions so far this year, falling to the University of San Diego 99-37 (Nov. 6) and UC Irvine 78-49 (Dec. 12). The Hawks will also play one more friendly at

the end of the month when they return to Phoenix to square off against Grand Canyon University on Dec. 30.

Through nine regular-season games, the Hawks have been paced by senior Berika Egberuare and junior Natalie Perales, who are both averaging 9.3 points per contest. In addition, Egberuare leads SDC in assists (1.8/gm) and is the team's most consistent free-throw shooter, connecting on 14 of 18 attempts (77.8 percent) from the charity stripe, while Perales tops the squad in steals (2.9/gm). The Hawks have also received a significant contribution from junior Alexa Arndt (7.9 ppg, 44.4 FG pct.), who is averaging a team-best 6.5 rebounds per outing.

As a team, SDC has been stingy on defense so far this year, allowing just 56.3 points per game and a 38.6 percent success rate on opponent field-goal attempts. However, the Hawks have struggled a bit offense, averaging just 56.8 points per contest while connecting on 37.2 percent of their shots from the floor, including a 30.5 clip from three-point range. SDC has drained just 32 of 105 attempts from beyond the arc for the season, with sophomore Anessa Wolfblack (9) and freshman Kaylie Fandino (8) combining for over half of those baskets. The Hawks have been outscored 271-244 in the second half of their games this year, including a 144-122 in the fourth quarter.

Head coach Irwin Jerry is in his third season at San Diego Christian, where he has amassed a 25-42 overall record. Jerry is a 2003 San Diego State alumnus, graduating with his bachelor's degree in kinesiology before receiving his master's in educational leadership from Point Loma Nazarene, the same alma mater as Aztec assistant coach Ciara Carl.

SDSU has faced just one GSAC team in program history, posting a 3-3 record in six meetings against Biola University. However, the Aztecs last faced the Eagles in November of 1983.

Rewind: Aztecs-Lions Recap

San Diego State was unable to keep pace with the hot shooting of Loyola Marymount in a 92-65 loss to the Lions at Gersten Pavilion in Los Angeles on Dec. 10. With the defeat, the Aztecs fall to 3-6 on the season, while LMU moves to 4-6 overall.

The Lions connected on 33 of 62 field-goal attempts (53.2 percent) and 10 of 23 tries from three-point range (43.5 percent), while SDSU was just 21-for-59 from the floor (35.6 percent), including a 5-for-19 clip (26.3 percent) from beyond the arc. LMU forged a 41-34 lead at halftime before outscoring the Aztecs 32-14 in a third-quarter barrage to break the game open.

In addition, SDSU was snake-bit by 20 turnovers as the Lions tallied 28 points off those miscues and maintained a 40-26 scoring advantage in the paint to win going away. The Aztecs were also out-rebounded by a 38-33 margin, including a 23-14 spread on the defensive glass.

Individually, SDSU was paced by sophomore McKynzie Fort, who tallied 15 points and a career-high nine rebounds, while senior Ahjalee Harvey and sophomore Lexy Thorderson totaled nine points each. Thorderson drained a trio of three-pointers and added two steals, while Harvey dished out a team-high four assists.

On the flip side, LMU had four players finish in double figures, including Sophie Taylor, who led all scorers with 21 points, highlighted by a 7-for-7 effort at the free-throw line, while Cheyanne Wallace followed closely with 20 points of her own on 7-for-13 shooting. In addition, the Lions received an important contribution from Leslie Lopez-Wood, who notched 17 points, including a 5-for-6 performance from three-point territory, while Andee Velasco registered 12 points and a game-high six assists.

SDSU kept the deficit under 10 points throughout the first half, but still found itself on the wrong side of a 25-17 score following a layup by LMU's Bree Alford with 7:11 left before intermission. Stung, the Aztecs responded with a 9-3 spurt capped by a Thorderson triple at the 3:42 mark of the second quarter to narrow the gap to 28-26. However, SDSU was unable to grab the upper hand as the Lions closed the half with a 13-8 run, punctuated by a Taylor layup with two ticks on the clock, to take a 41-34 lead into the locker room.

LMU maintained the momentum after the break as Taylor converted an old-fashioned three-point play on its first possession, while Bianca Velasco and Lopez-Wood followed with unguarded treys shortly thereafter to effectively put the game out of reach at 55-38 with 5:24 remaining in the third quarter.

SDSU-LMU Postgame Notes

- The Aztecs posted their highest point-total (34) of the first half this year.
- The SDSU bench outscored the LMU reserves by a 28-27 tally. For the season, the Aztec bench has amassed 204 points (22.7/g).
- McKynzie Fort (15 points) reached double figures for the sixth game in a row and 27th time in her career.
- Fort also grabbed a personal-best nine rebounds.
- Ahjaleé Harvey finished with nine points, including a 5-for-6 effort at the foul line, to surpass the 500-point plateau for her career.
- Lexy Thorderson set a career-high with eight attempts from beyond the three-point arc.
- Deidra Smith played in her 70th consecutive game at SDSU.

Comeback Kids

In its last two victories over Wisconsin and CSUN, San Diego State fought itself off the ropes, rallying from an 11-point deficit in both contests. Against the Badgers on Nov. 29, the Aztecs found themselves on the wrong side of a 32-21 score with three minutes elapsed in the third quarter before uncorking a 23-7 run to grab a 44-39 advantage. SDSU also trailed with under 10 seconds remaining, but Ariell Bostick saved the day with a late layup to send the game into overtime. The following week against the Matadors, the Aztecs overcame a 41-30 deficit at the 8:22 mark of the third period with a 12-0 run to climb back into contention. After six ties and four lead changes, CSUN went back in front 65-63 with 17 seconds to go. However, Lexy Thorderson tallied the go-ahead basket on a three-pointer with 9.4 seconds left, while Bostick added a late free throw to seal the win.

Take It to the Bank

With their victory over CSUN on Dec. 7, the Aztecs have now won 46 in a row and improved to 76-1 since the 2012-13 campaign when leading with five minutes remaining in the game. Against the Matadors, McKynzie Fort sank one of two free throws with 5:09 left on the clock to break a 57-57 deadlock. Although CSUN reclaimed the lead with under a minute to go, Lexy Thorderson's trey with 9.4 seconds remaining helped keep the SDSU streak intact.

The last time the Aztecs wound up losing a game after leading at the five-minute mark of the second half occurred in a heart-breaking 59-58 at Washington in December of 2012.

Nothin' Like Home Cookin'

Despite its modest 2-3 home record to start the season, SDSU has claimed 45 of its last 62 games on Montezuma Mesa and has gone 77-31 (.713) at Steve Fisher Court since the start of the 2008-09 campaign. The Aztecs have finished with a winning record at home in eight of the last nine years.

Decembers to Remember

The Aztecs are a combined 36-19 during the month of December since 2006. Eight of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll, including a defeat to Washington (rv) in 2014 following a pair of setbacks to No. 23 Texas A&M and North Carolina State (rv) the year before in 2013. The Aztecs have also come up short in previous seasons against No. 2 UConn (2007), No. 7 Texas A&M (2010), No. 14 Oklahoma State (2012), No. 17 George Washington (2006) and USC (rv - 2010). Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 38 of those 53 December contests at home.

Fort Tabled MW Player of the Week

McKynzie Fort was named Mountain West Women's Basketball Player of the Week for her stellar performances in three games from Nov. 23-29, as announced by the league office. With her award, the Aztec sophomore garnered weekly conference accolades for the first time in her career and first for SDSU this season.

Fort averaged 17.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 3.3 steals, helping the Aztecs to a 2-1 record during that stretch. The 5-9 guard was the team's top scorer in all three games, connecting on 66.7 percent of her shots on 24 of 36 field-goal attempts, all inside the three-point arc.

After recording 16 points on 8-of-13 shooting and four rebounds in a tough road loss to Washington on Nov. 23, Fort almost single-hand-

edly propelled the Scarlet and Black to a 64-54 triumph over North Dakota State in the opener of the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic last Friday, posting a game-high 20 points and a personal-best five steals. Against the Bison, the Etiwanda High alumna drained a collegiate-high 10 field goals on 12 tries (83.3 pct) and matched her season best with four rebounds.

Not to be outdone, Fort capped off her brilliant week with a 16-point, 4-steal effort in the Aztecs' thrilling 63-57 overtime victory over Wisconsin on Sunday, sinking 6 of 11 attempts from the floor to go with four clutch free throws. Against the Badgers, she converted two critical and-one opportunities, including one to punctuate a timely 23-7 run that erased an 11-point deficit in the second half.

For the season, Fort is averaging a team-high 15.8 points per game on 47.1 percent shooting and leads SDSU with 20 steals. She now has six double-digit scoring performances this year and 26 for her career.

In addition, Fort set a career high with 25 points against UC Riverside in the Aztecs' home opener on Nov. 16, and established collegiate bests in three-pointers made (2), field-goal attempts (17), free throws (11) and free throw attempts (12).

@AztecWBB Picked Sixth in MW Preseason Poll

San Diego State has been predicted to finish sixth the Mountain West preseason poll released on Oct. 28 by the league office. The voting panel consisted of the MW's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the conference.

The Aztecs, who placed seventh in the MW standings during the 2014-15 campaign, earned 135 points from the panel, trailing fifth-place UNLV (132) by just three points while topping seventh-place Wyoming (125) by 10 points.

Two-time defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat once again after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 237 points, just ahead of New Mexico, which garnered seven first-place votes and 221 points, while 2015 MW tournament champion Boise State followed closely in the third spot with six first-place votes and 215 points.

With the league's forecast, SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings in back-to-back years for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 campaigns. The Aztecs completed conference play where they were projected last season, landing in the seventh spot with an 8-10 record.

Back Again

San Diego State returns three starters from a year ago, featuring sophomore McKynzie Fort, along with seniors Ahjaleé Harvey and Deidra Smith. A 5-9 guard, Fort earned Mountain West all-freshman honors last spring after finishing third among conference rookies with 10.9 points per game in league play while averaging 3.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists. In addition, Harvey made a successful recovery from a knee injury that sidelined her for the final 22 games of the 2013-14 campaign with 25 starts in 29 appearances last season. The 5-6 point guard was SDSU's top ball-handler and main three-point threat in 2014-15, dishing out 2.3 assists per contest to go with 21 triples. Meanwhile, Smith has played in all 62 games for the Aztecs the past two years following her transfer from Boston College. The tallest member on the squad as a 6-2 forward, Smith is the team's top returning rebounder after averaging 3.5 caroms last season.

Third-year head coach Stacie Terry and staff welcome back four additional letterwinners, including juniors Ariell Bostick and Aleiah Brandon and sophomores Cheyenne Greenhouse and Lexy Thorderson. Fellow classmate Allison Brown, who made seven spot appearances last season, also finds herself in the mix once again.

Noting the Newcomers

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, four players will be wearing a Scarlet and Black uniform for the first time during the 2015-16 campaign. Guard Kymberly Ellison (Columbus, Ga.) practiced with the squad last year, but did not compete after transferring from Georgia Tech, while fellow backcourt mate Geena Gomez (Huntington Beach, Calif.) utilized her redshirt season as well following her transfer from St. Joseph's (Pa.).

With the departure of forwards Erimma Amarikwa, Khristina Hunter and Desi Culberson, who accounted for 43 percent of SDSU's rebounding total and 38 percent of the team's scoring offense from a year ago, a pair of newcomers look to gain significant experience on the frontline this season. Junior Kylie Herd (Phoenix, Ariz.) received second-team All-America recognition and was named the Arizona JC player of the year as a sophomore last year at Mesa Community College, following a solid freshman campaign

Not to be outdone, freshman Arantxa Gómez (Valencia, Spain) brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after sharpening her skills as a six-year member on the Spanish club circuit, including an MVP performance in U18 regional competition last April.

Listen Live

For the 15th consecutive year, Aztec women's basketball fans will have an opportunity to listen to live play-by-play of regular-season games over the internet at www.goaztecs.com.

SDSU alumnus Chris Ello begins his ninth season of calling the action and is a familiar voice in the San Diego area. In addition to his responsibilities with the Aztec women's basketball squad, Ello is a member of the football broadcast team as a sideline reporter for the school's flagship station, The Mighty 1090 AM.

Ello started his career in sports talk radio in San Diego on XTRA Sports 690 in the summer of 1994. He has accumulated a wealth of experience doing play-by-play for a variety of sports at every level, including stints with the SDSU football (1985), baseball (1998-99) and men's basketball (2006-07) squads.

From 1996-2006, Ello was the voice of the San Diego Gulls hockey team and has called the action for the San Diego Sockers (indoor soccer), San Diego Spirit (outdoor soccer), San Diego Wildcards (CBA) and San Diego Riptide (arena football). He also has experience broadcasting high school CIF football and basketball games since 2000.

For the third straight year, nearly all regular-season Aztec home contests in 2015-16 will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

NCAA Rule Changes at a Glance

Game Format

- Beginning with the 2015-16 campaign, NCAA women's basketball games will be played in four 10-minute quarters.
- Teams will now reach the bonus and shoot two free throws on the fifth team foul in each quarter. Previously, teams reached a one-and-one bonus on the seventh team foul of each half and reached the double bonus (two shots) on the 10th team foul.
- In the four-quarter format, team fouls reset to zero at the start of each quarter. However, if a team reaches the bonus in the fourth quarter, that team would remain in the bonus during any additional overtime periods.

Advancing the Ball

- Teams will be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a timeout immediately after a made basket in the last 59.9 seconds of the fourth quarter and any overtime periods.
- Teams will also be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a rebound or a change of possession. In these scenarios, the ball would be inbounded at the 28-foot mark on the side of the court where the scorer's table is located.

10-Second Backcourt Exceptions

- For the upcoming season, a team will not receive a new 10-second backcourt count when a throw-in results from the following situations:

- The ball is deflected out of bounds by the defense.
- There is a held ball and the possession arrow favors the offensive team.
- A technical foul is called on the offensive team while the ball is in its backcourt.

Post Defense

- Defenders will be allowed to place a forearm or an open hand with a bend in the elbow on an offensive post player with the ball whose back is to the basket.

Bands and Amplified Music

- In an effort to improve the overall fan experience, bands or amplified music may be played during any dead-ball situation during a women's basketball game. Previously, rules allowed music to be played only during timeouts and intermission.

SDSU Holds Grand-Opening Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a grand-opening ceremony for the 23,500-square foot Jeff Jacobs JAM Center on Sunday, Aug. 23. The event marked the official opening of the Aztecs' on-campus basketball performance center, which broke ground almost a year to the date on Aug. 27, 2014.

Speaking before the ceremonial ribbon cutting was SDSU president Elliot Hirshman, men's basketball head coach Steve Fisher and women's hoops senior guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Preliminary site work started in July 2014, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film room, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project was \$15 million.

The project was designed by JCJ Architecture and was built by The Hunt Construction Group.

San Diego native Stacie Terry enters her third year at the helm of the Aztec women's basketball team after she was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 15, 2013.

Despite a 12-19 record and an 8-10 mark in the Mountain West, Terry's squad still showed dramatic improvement on defense last season, finishing second in the conference and 34th nationally in opponent three-point field goal percentage, compared to 2014 when SDSU ranked last in the league and near the bottom of Division I in that statistic.

In addition, the Aztecs were fourth in scoring defense during MW play a year ago, allowing nearly 10 points per game fewer than the previous campaign and topped the conference in rebounding defense for the second straight season.

Under Terry's watch, forward Erimma Amarikwa capped off her collegiate career with honorable mention all-MW accolades, while guard McKynzie Fort gave SDSU's its second consecutive all-conference freshman honoree.

Terry's charges also made tremendous strides in the classroom, with the squad posting the highest collective GPA in program history during the fall of 2014, while five Aztecs landed a spot on the MW all-academic team, the most since 2001-02.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players to injuries prior to conference play, Amarikwa, who was a preseason all-MW selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games against teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 ledger in the MW.

With Terry at the controls, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in a six-year span to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA

tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN Hoop-Gurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
