#AztecWBB Set to Battle Air Force in Mountain West Opener

San Diego State opens its 16th year of Mountain West competition on Wednesday when it travels to the Front Range of the Rocky Mountains to battle Air Force in a New Year's Eve matinee beginning at noon MT/11 a.m. PT. A live audio stream will be available on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling play-by-play responsibilities. In addition, the Aztecs-Falcons clash will feature streaming video courtesy of the Mountain West Network.

SDSU will be looking to halt a four-game losing streak, its longest since dropping the first four contests of the 2013-14 campaign. The Aztecs are coming off a 64-54 defeat at UC Riverside in their last outing on Dec. 23, while Air Force has been idle since Dec. 20, when it fell to Abilene Christian on the road by an 80-44 tally.

Wednesday's encounter will mark the first time in five years that SDSU has opened MW play on the road. The Aztecs last ventured away from "America's Finest City" for a conference lid-lifter in 2010, when it recorded a 61-39 triumph at New Mexico. Overall, SDSU owns 4-5 record in MW openers at home and a 1-5 mark on the road.

The Aztecs have captured nine straight from the Falcons, which represents its longest current winning streak against MW opponents. SDSU holds a 30-6 lead in the all-time series, including a 13-4 ledger at the Academy. Last year, the Scarlet and Black notched its third consecutive win at Clune Arena, rallying from a seven-point deficit in the first half to claim a 77-66 decision. In addition, the Aztecs registered their largest margin of victory of the campaign with a 72-39 conquest at Viejas Arena before completing the season sweep with a 63-56 conquest in the first round of the MW tournament.

SDSU is 19-19 all-time in conference openers, posting a 5-4 mark in the Western Collegiate Conference (1976-85), a 2-3 record in the Big West (1985-90) and a 7-2 mark in the Western Athletic Conference (1990-99).

Entering the week, the Aztecs find themselves among the top half of the Mountain West in three-point field-goal percentage defense (2nd - (.284)), rebounding defense (3rd - (35.9/gm)) and rebounding margin (4th - (+3.1)). Individually, senior Khristina Hunter ranks ninth in both rebounding (6.7/gm) and blocked shots (0.8/gm).

Scouting the Falcons

Air Force (1-10) enters MW play having dropped 10 of 11 non-conference games, including an 80-44 defeat at Abilene Christian in its last game before the Christmas holiday on Dec. 20. The Falcons posted their lone victory of the year thus far with a 65-57 triumph over Omaha at home on Nov. 17.

Individually, senior Jimi Blagowsky leads Air Force with an average of 11.8 points, 2.9 assists and 1.5 steals per game. She is also the team's main three-point threat, connecting on 19 of 58 attempts from beyond the arc. In addition, fellow classmate Lindsey Lewis has surpassed the double-digit plateau in scoring with 10.2 points per contest, while junior Madeleine Philpot tops the squad in rebounds (4.5/gm) and has sank 23 of 26 free throws (88.5 percent).

As a team, the Falcons are shooting 31.7 percent from the field, including a 25.5 percent clip from three-point territory, and 64.7 percent from the charity stripe. For the season, opponents are outscoring Air Force by an average of 27.1 points per game while maintaining a plus-15.9 rebounding advantage.

Head coach Andrea Williams is in her fifth season at the Academy after serving a two-year stint as an assistant at South Florida.

With a Victory...

An SDSU win over Air Force on Wednesday will mean:

- The Aztecs extend their winning streak to 10 straight against the Falcons and increase their lead in the all-time series to 31-6.
- SDSU captures its fourth victory in a row at Clune Arena and seventh in its last eight trips to the Academy.
- The Aztecs snap a four-game losing streak and collect their first road win of the year.
- SDSU wins its fourth MW opener in the last seven years.
- The Aztecs improve to 20-19 all-time in conference lid-lifters.
- SDSU moves to 35-17 in December games since 2006.

SDSU's Last Visit to the Academy

Competing with just seven players for the second game in a row, San Diego State utilized a strong second half to dispatch a plucky Air Force squad, 77-66, at Clune Arena on Feb. 15, 2014.

The Aztecs overcame a seven-point deficit with strong interior play and clutch shooting to snap their two-game losing skid and extend their winning streak over the Falcons to eight in a row.

SDSU finished with a 51-26 rebounding advantage, including a 25-10 spread on the offensive glass, outscoring Air Force in the paint (44-26) and on second-chance points (27-9). In addition, the Aztecs shot 51.5 percent from the field (17-33) in the second period after connecting on just 36.1 percent of their field-goal attempts (13-36) in the first half.

Individually, SDSU was paced by senior Cierra Warren, who tallied a game-high 20 points on 9-of-12 shooting, while fellow classmate Daneisha Long notched her first career double-double with 18 points and a personal-best 11 rebounds. The Aztecs also received a solid 14-point, eight-rebound performance from junior Khristina Hunter, while junior Desi Culberson reached double figures for the first time this season with 10 points. Not to be outdone, sophomore Deidra Smith contributed valuable numbers as well with nine points and 11 rebounds.

The two sides witnessed seven lead changes and one tie during the first half as Air Force took a slim 35-33 advantage into the locker room following a three-pointer by Sarah Fotsch with 12 seconds left on the clock.

The Falcons increased the margin to seven after the break, capitalizing on six SDSU turnovers in the opening four minutes of the second half. After Madeleine Philpot sank two free throws with 16:15 remaining, Air Force enjoyed its biggest lead of the contest at 42-35. However, the Aztecs quickly regrouped following a timeout as Smith scored two straight baskets to spark a 20-6 run over the ensuing seven-and-a-half minutes.

SDSU misfired on its first eight attempts from three-point territory, until Long buried a triple at the 8:48 mark to give the visitors a seven-point cushion of their own at 55-48.

The Falcons would not go away quietly, however, as a Jimi Blagowsky trey punctuated a 13-4 spurt to put the host school up by a 61-59 count with 5:26 to go.

The Aztecs flashed their resolve at this juncture, with Long converting back-to-back layups to spark an 18-5 closing run. Air Force misfired on six of its last eight field-goal attempts and committed three turnovers, while SDSU drilled six of its final 10 shots from the floor and came up with three huge offensive rebounds during that stretch.

The Falcons were led by Camille Thompson's 16 points, followed by Kelly Lujan, who chipped in 14 points, while Blagowsky totaled 13 points and a game-high nine assists.

The Last Time Out: Aztecs-UCR

San Diego State closed out its non-conference schedule in disappointing fashion with a 64-54 road loss to UC Riverside on Dec. 23.

The Aztecs managed to trim a 13-point second-half deficit down to one on two occasions, but could not gain the upper hand, ultimately slipping to 3-8 on the season. Meanwhile, the Highlanders received a game-high 31 points from Brittany Crain to help raise their record to 7-4 overall.

Despite maintaining a 40-32 rebounding advantage, including a 31-24 edge on the defensive glass, the Aztecs were undone by turnovers once again, as UCR converted 20 Aztec miscues into 33 points. In addition, the Scarlet and Black sank just 7 of 13 free throws, while the Highlanders went 12-for-15 from the charity stripe.

Neither side shot the ball well, with SDSU draining 41.5 percent of its field-goal attempts (22-53), while UCR connected on 38.3 percent of its tries from the floor (23-60). However, Crain did most of the damage for the host school, finishing with an 11-for-18 clip, including four 3-pointers.

On the flip side, the Aztecs were paced by sophomore Ariell Bostick, who contributed 12 points and four assists, while fellow classmate Chloe Johnson tallied all 11 of her per points during SDSU's second-half surge. The Aztecs also received a boost from senior Kristina Hunter, who notched her sixth career double-double with 10 points and a game-high 10 rebounds to go with four assists of her own.

The first half witnessed three ties and three lead changes, with SDSU building a 21-17 advantage following a Bostick jumper at the 6:43 mark. However, the Aztecs quickly became mired in another prolonged funk, misfiring on its final five field goals of the period while committing five turnovers. In the interim, UCR received a pair of triples from Dynese Adams and Jaelyn Wilson, while Crain nailed two foul shots to highlight a 13-0 run, giving the contest its 30-21 score at intermission.

The Highlanders extended their lead to 13 in the opening two minutes of the second half on baskets by Wilson and Simone De-Coud before SDSU began its methodical ascent back into contention. The Aztecs narrowed the gap to six on twice over the ensuing -and-a-half minutes, including a 36-30 spread on a Hunter layup with 13:37 remaining. However, UCR soon reclaimed a double-digit lead at 41-30 following an Adams bucket and Crain's old fashioned three-point play.

Unfazed, the Aztecs flashed their resiliency, unleashing a 12-3 blitz punctuated by Johnson's clutch 3-pointer, to pull within 43-42 by the 9:07 mark. After an exchange of baskets over the next min-

ute, SDSU had chances to take the lead on consecutive possessions, but came up empty on both times. Moments later, Crain and Annelise Ito drained jumpers sandwiched around a Bostick free throw to give UCR a 49-45 cushion with 5:52 left.

The Aztecs kept within striking distance as sophomore Aleiah Brandon hit a basket with the shot clock winding down, while Johnson connected from beyond the arc to answer another Crain triple, cutting the deficit to 52-50 with 3:54 remaining. However, SDSU never threatened again after squandering a chance to either tie or take the lead on its next trip down the court with a turnover.

Crain single-handedly made the Aztecs pay for their misfortune, burying a deep 3-pointer at the 2:36 mark before completing another and-one opportunity just over a minute later. Trailing 58-52, SDSU was forced to foul; however, UCR sank six of seven free throws down the stretch to seal the win.

In addition to Crain's heroics, the Highlanders received seven points and six assists from DeCoud, while Ito (8 points) and Adams (7 points) dished out five helpers apiece.

Noting the UCR Game

■ The Aztecs lost for the second time this season (2-2) after posting a better field-goal percentage than the opposition (.415-.383). In addition, SDSU fell for the fourth time (3-4) after grabbing more rebounds than its opponent (40-32).

■ Deidra Smith collected five boards to surpass the 200-rebound mark for her career.

■ Ariell Bostick has recorded at least one steal in seven straight games dating back to last year and in 19 of 26 career outings.

■ With her 11 points, Chloe Johnson finished with double-digit scoring totals in consecutive games for the first time in her career.

Welcome to the Club

Senior Khristina Hunter and junior Erimma Amarikwa each surpassed 500-point barrier for their careers earlier this season. Amarikwa achieved the milestone with a 15-point performance against Idaho State at the San Juan Shootout on Nov. 27, while Hunter accomplished the feat with a basket and a free throw at USD on Dec. 9. In addition, Hunter eclipsed the 400-rebound plateau with eight boards against the Toreros.

Elsewhere, senior Desi Culberson (430) is also on pace to reach 500 career points before the season ends, junior while Ahjalee Harvey recently notched her 100th field goal in an Aztec uniform.

Decembers to Remember

The Aztecs are a combined 34-17 during the month of December since 2006. Eight of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll, including a defeat to Washington (rv) on Dec. 18, following a pair of setbacks to No. 23 Texas A&M and North Carolina State (rv) last season. The Aztecs have also come up short in previous years against No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 14 Oklahoma State, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other nine defeats were against CSUN last Saturday, at USD on Dec. 9, vs. UCLA in 2013, at Washington in 2012, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opener of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam. Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 37 of those 51 December contests at home.

Fort Named Top MW Preseason Freshman; Aztecs Picked Seventh

San Diego State point guard McKynzie Fort was tabbed as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year in a combined vote of the league's 11 head coaches and select media members. on Oct. 14.

Fort is the fifth consecutive Aztec player to garner top MW preseason freshman accolades, following in the respective paths of Chloe Johnson, Deajanae Scurry and Desi Culberson, as well as Melissa Sweat, who received such distinction prior to the 2010-11 campaign.

Fort, who led the powerful Etiwanda High School program to the Southern Regional finals of the CIF playoffs as a senior last season, was a first-team all-state selection and Baseline League most valuable player honoree before earning all-area recognition by the *Los Angeles Times*.

As a team, SDSU was predicted to finish seventh in the preseason poll released by the conference office. SDSU earned 134

points from the panel, trailing UNLV (143 pts.) by just nine points for sixth place.

Defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 276 points, comfortably ahead of Boise State, which received four first-place votes and 241 points, while Wyoming was slotted for the third position with three first-place votes and 235 points.

This year marks the first time since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign that SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings.

Noting the Newcomers

In addition to McKynzie Fort, the Aztecs' highly touted freshman class includes two other former prep stars in Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.), both of whom could play significant roles in SDSU's fortunes this season. Greenhouse was a first-team all-CIF selection after leading Canyon Springs High to the Division I state championship as a senior in 2013-14. She also collected the Inland Empire League's most valuable player award and received first-team all-conference recognition for the fourth straight year.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered numerous postseason accolades at Rock Canyon High, where she finished her prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer. A nominee for the McDonald's All-America team, Thorderson led the state of Colorado in 3-point field goals made as a senior, earning second-team class 5A all-state distinction.

SDSU also solidified its depth for the 2015-16 season after junior Kym Ellison (Georgia Tech) and sophomore Geena Gomez (St. Joseph's) transferred to The Mesa in the summer of 2014. The two players will not be eligible to compete this season due to NCAA rules, but will serve as valuable assets to the team in practice.

2013-14 Rewind

After winning a program-record 27 games and capturing its second straight Mountain West regular-season championship, San Diego State faced a year of transition during the 2013-14 campaign. Not only did the Aztecs have to adjust to a brand new coaching staff, but they were also forced to overcome the loss of four senior starters who accounted for 64 percent of the team's scoring from the previous year. With five newcomers on board, growing pains were certainly inevitable. However, SDSU flashed its resiliency throughout the season, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and tying for sixth in the MW standings with a 9-9 mark. Below are some additional obstacles the Aztecs endured last year:

- SDSU had to replace two starters, Erimma Amarikwa and Ahjalee Harvey, who were lost for the year after suffering injuries during the non-conference schedule. As a result, the Aztecs employed 10 different starting lineups last season compared to just three in 2012-13.
- In addition, SDSU was faced with a difficult schedule featuring nine games against teams that advanced to postseason competition, including four squads that finished among the AP Top 25: South Carolina, Texas A&M, North Carolina State and USC.
- SDSU dropped four very close games during the non-conference slate by an average of three points in losses to Sacramento State, USC, San Diego and UCLA.

Despite these tribulations, the gritty Aztecs found success on the court during the 2013-14 campaign. Below are a few of the accomplishments of last year's squad:

- SDSU led the Mountain West as team in rebounding margin (+7.6) and rebounding defense (33.1/game).
- The Aztecs also ranked second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.419) and offensive rebounds (15.3/game).
- SDSU averaged over 40 rebounds per contest (40.6) for the third straight season, representing its longest stretch since a six-year span from 1984-89.
- The Aztecs handed two-time defending MW tournament champion Fresno State its only home loss in conference play with a 70-69 upset on a late basket by Danesha Long. Coupled with a win at Fresno in 2013, SDSU is the only MW team to defeat the Bulldogs twice on the road in the past two

years.

- The Aztecs topped the 80-point barrier in back-to-back conference games for the first time since joining the Mountain West after scoring 88 points in consecutive home victories over San José State and Utah State.
- Elsewhere, Stacie Terry tied for the second-highest victory total (13) ever by a first-year SDSU head coach in program history.

2014-15 By the Numbers

With a new season already underway, below are a few trends to watch for the remainder of the 2014-15 campaign:

- SDSU has claimed 37 of its last 50 home games and has gone 69-25 (.742) on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 65 Mountain West victories in the last six seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU is 65-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including its victory over UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 7. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heartbreaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.
- SDSU is 34-17 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with eight of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last seven years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
- For the second straight season, SDSU will play 18 conference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing San José State (home) and Utah State (away) just once.

SDSU Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a ceremonial groundbreaking for the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center, the men's and women's basketball performance center, on Aug. 27. The JAM Center is scheduled to be completed by August 2015 and in time for the start of the 2015-16 campaign.

SDSU President Dr. Elliot Hirshman, men's hoops head coach Steve Fisher and Jeff Jacobs spoke before a selected group of invited guests, which included Steve and Lisa Altman, and Jim and Susan Morris, as well as members of both the Aztec men's and women's basketball programs. The master of ceremonies for the event was the voice of San Diego State men's basketball, Ted Leitner.

Preliminary site work started in July where the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center will be located, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project is \$14.5 million, of which \$12.5 million in private funding has been raised. No state funds will be used to construct this building.

The project was designed by JGJ Architecture and is being built by The Hunt Construction Group.

STACIE TERRY

Head Coach Second Season UT Arlington (1998)

San Diego native Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players - forward Erimma Amarikwa, a preseason all-Mountain West selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey - to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games with teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 mark in the MW.

Under Terry's guidance, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense, while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in the last six years to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and

earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
