Fan Code of Conduct

San Diego State Athletics and SDCCU Stadium are committed to serving our fans by striving to provide a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable experience for all fans on game day. We ask fans to join us in creating a positive game day experience by adhering to the following:

- Enjoy the game day experience free from obscene or abusive language, gestures or behavior
- Fans respect others by sitting in the seat location as indicated on their ticket
- Fans not adhering to the Fan Code of Conduct provisions will be subject to ejections without
 refund, revocation of season tickets, and may also be subject to arrest and prosecution. The
 following do not comply with the established Fan Code of Conduct
 - Verbal or physical confrontation, including abusive or profane behavior
 - o Attempting to enter the field area or other restricted areas of SDCCU Stadium
 - Improper resale of tickets
 - Interfering with or failure to comply with security procedures, emergency procedures, or requests from staff regarding stadium operations.
- Intoxicated fans in and around SDCCU Stadium will be denied entry or will be subject to arrest or ejection from the stadium.
- If someone is interfering with your enjoyment of the game, please notify stadium ushers or security personnel of the problem immediately.

Permitted Items inside SDCCU Stadium

• Food in a small plastic bag and factory-sealed plastic water bottles ½ liter, and/or 17 ounces or less (limit two per person)

Prohibited Items inside SDCCU Stadium

- Noisemakers
- Weapons
- Alcoholic Beverages
- Glass, metal or hard plastic containers, and bags larger than 12" x 6" x 12"
- Frozen Beverage bottles
- Hard or soft sided coolers of any size
- Boxes or wrapped packages of any size
- Animals (other than service animals required because of a disability)
- Balls, toys or sports equipment
- Laser pointers
- Helium balloons
- Poles or sticks
- Umbrellas
- Unauthorized cameras with lenses longer than 3.5 inches, interchangeable or telephoto lenses, video cameras, monopods or tripods
- Skates, skateboards, scooters or bicycles
