Big Notes

- San Diego State wins back-to-back overtime games for the first time since Dec. 21, 1993 vs. CSUN & Dec. 23, 1993 at Loyola Marymount.
- San Diego State plays in back-to-back overtime games for the first time since Feb. 12, 2005 vs. UNLV & Feb. 19, 2005 at Colorado State.
- Reese Waters was named the SoCal Showcase MVP; scored a career-high 24 points and grabbed seven rebounds.
- In its third neutral site game since the 2023 National Championship game (3-0), San Diego State improves to 32-14 under head coach Brian Dutcher, and has been the victor in 64 of its last 99 (64-31) games played on a neutral floor.
- Brian Dutcher improves to 7-2 in his last nine encounters with Pac-12 schools.

<u>Team Notes</u>

- San Diego State has won the first two of three regular-season meetings against Pac-12 schools this season (also: a 100-97 overtime-victory over Washington on Nov. 19) and will host Stanford on Dec. 21.
- Brian Dutcher moves to 7-6 against Pac-12 programs.
- San Diego State, under Brian Dutcher, moves to 35-9 in games played in November, and since the beginning of the 2010-11 season SDSU is 69-18 in the month.
- The Aztecs win their ninth straight Saturday game and improve to 99-44 in their last 143 games on the day.

- SDSU has won 17 straight games when wearing white uniforms, including its last three games on neutral court, and are now 69-7 in its last 76 games in its white kit.
- The Aztecs had a 39-34 lead at the half and have won 196 of their last 220 games (196-24) when leading at intermission.
- San Diego State moves to 49-25 under Brian Dutcher when its opponent scores first.
- SDSU improves to 394-15 in its last 409 games when leading with five minutes to play.
- The Aztecs move to 75-66 in its last 141 games in which it has been outrebounded.
- San Diego State moves to 42-40 since the start of the 1971-72 season in overtime games.
- San Diego State is now 57-7 since the start of the 2009-10 season when it attempts at least 30 free throws in a game.
- SDSU outscored California 15-8, in points off turnovers.
- San Diego State outscored California in bench points 17-11.
- San Diego State outscored the Golden Bears 10-4 in fast break points.

Series Notes

- San Diego State improves to 8-6 against California and has won five of the last seven meetings.
- SDSU has won each of its three neutral floor meetings versus California.

Game Flow

- San Diego State won the tip.
- Cal scored the first points of the game on a layup at 18:42.
- Reese Waters scored the Aztecs first points on a jumper at 17:57.
- Darrion Trammell's 3-pointer with 11:34 regulation go in the second half, was San Diego State's last bucket of regulation, but it made 11-of-12 from the line in the final 11:34 of regulation and overtime to secure the victory.
- San Diego State enjoyed its largest lead of the game, 12 points, with 9:24 to play in regulation.
- SDSU outscored California 13-4 in overtime and a combined 28-16 in overtime in its last two games, both wins.

Jaedon LeDee – 19 points, 6-13 FG, 7-10 FT, 7 rebounds, 2 assists, 1 steal, 1 block

Achieved his 25th career double-digit scoring game, 17th as an Aztec and his sixth straight to open the season... Has drawn 56 fouls in six games, an average of 9.3 per game... Set a career-high in minutes (42:22).

Reese Waters - 24 points, 6-11 FG, 2-3 3FG, 10-10 FT, 7 rebounds, 2 steals

Set a career-high with 24 points... His 10 free throws and 10 attempts are a career-best as are his seven rebounds... Scored in double figures for the sixth time this season and 22nd time in his career... Is the eighth Aztec to score at least 20 points in a game and be perfect from the line with a minimum of 10 free throw attempts in the Dutcher/Fisher era... Has scored in double figures in his last eight games including his last two games at Southern California.

Darrion Trammell – 9 points, 4-4 FT, 3 rebounds, 2 steals, 1 assist

Set season-highs in points, free throws and minutes (30:42)... Equaled his season-best in rebounds, free throw attempts and steals.
